1) Delete Section 2.04(e) paragraph 4 sentence 4 *Beginning: (With respect to) and Ending: (shall be used.)

Replace with proposed language:

"With respect to paint, paint materials, body materials and related materials, if the formula of dollars times hours is not accepted by a registered repair shop or licensed appraiser, then a published manual or other documentation shall be used unless otherwise negotiated between the parties."

Workers' Compensation/Liability Insurance

The Board discussed correspondence submitted by Robert Virta of Virta's garage re: its' business practice of not allowing individuals who are independently employed or employed by another, who refuse to provide proof of insurance. The Board determined that a shop does not have the right to deny access to its premises to an independent appraiser for not providing a copy of workers' comp. /liability insurance.
