

To the Pooling Administrator,

AT&T Wireless submitted a request for two thousands-blocks in order to accomodate a new service launch. NeuStar denied AT&T Wireless' request on the grounds that AT&T Wireless had not met the months-to-exhaust requirements. AT&T Wireless requested a waiver from the Department.

AT&T Wireless needs the numbers to accomodate a new service launch. Based on confidential and proprietary information submitted as part of its waiver request, AT&T Wireless has demonstrated that it cannot feasibly launch a new service with its existing inventory, and has demonstrated that this inability does not result from AT&T Wireless having utilized its numbering resources in an imprudent manner.

Therefore, the Department directs NeuStar to assign two thousands-blocks in the Springfield rate center to AT&T Wireless.
