RE: Amendment of Circular Letter # 13-5-590 (Screening for Critical Congenital Heart

Disease in Infants)

The purpose of this letter is to clarify the above referenced guidance regarding screening for Critical Congenital Heart Disease (CCHD) in newborns using pulse oximetry, previously circulated to Maternity Hospitals and Birthing Centers. Specifically, the CCHD Pulse Oximetry Screening and Reporting Factsheet and Algorithm have been amended to clarify that "newborn nursery" includes both well-newborn nurseries (Level IA and IB) and special care nurseries (Level IIA and IIB). An amended Factsheet and Algorithm is attached.
