<sup>1</sup> Information reported by HMOs as of the end of the first quarter of 2009 based upon the Massachusetts Division of Insurance's "Guidelines for Reporting Membership & Utilization Statistics - Version 5.0" that instructs HMOs to exclude members for whom the HMO did not bear any financial risk. Beginning January 1, 2004, membership reflects those persons enrolled only in closed network plans; so-called "dual certificate option" plan (POS) members and insured preferred provider plan members are not included in this report.

<sup>2</sup> Includes all members enrolled in the HMO in which reimbursement is provided pursuant to Title XIX of the Federal Social Security Act as defined in the Massachusetts Division of Insurance's "Guidelines for Reporting Membership & Utilization Statistics - Version 5.0."
