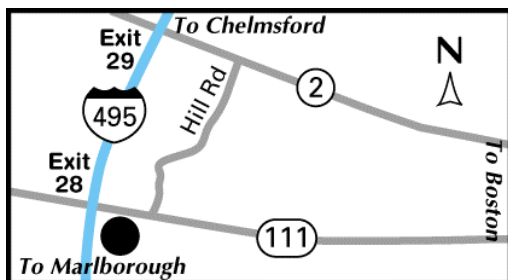

From the South: I-495 North to Exit 28 onto Route 111 East. Take a left off the ramp, go 600 feet and take a right onto Adams Place.



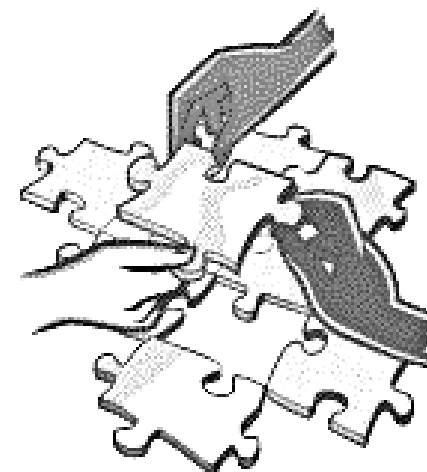
