### CPR Program Awards

#### **Town of Brewster**

##### Design and permitting of stormwater improvements at Paines Creek Road

Award: \$ 20,142

This project involved the design and permitting for stormwater improvements in the Paines Creek Road, south of the Route 28 intersection. This is the final site identified in the earlier assessment that requires design and permitting for stormwater improvements at this location.

#### **Town of Provincetown**

##### Construction of Stormwater BMPs for West End Parking Lot

Award: \$ 116,419

This project constructs stormwater BMPs at an existing outfall to Provincetown Harbor, based on a design funded by a previous CPR grant. The project will store and infiltrate the first 0.5 inch of rainfall.

#### **Town of Duxbury**

##### Crescent Street BMP Construction

Award: \$ 120,515

This project installs BMPs at three additional locations on Crescent Street to mitigate discharges to Kingston Bay. This area, called the “Nook,” has an important shellfish resource. This project will complete the town’s multi-year efforts to treat all discharges to Duxbury Bay and should allow the opening of shellfish beds.

#### **Town of Oak Bluffs**

##### Design, permitting, and construction of stormwater BMPs at East Chop Drive

Award: \$ 102,924

This project designs, permits, and constructs a stormwater management treatment system to manage roadway runoff from a 55 acre drainage area through a modified rain garden/gravel wetland system. The project will protect shellfish resources in Oak Bluffs Harbor.
