Updates to the Online Vacancy Ledger System

In an effort to further preserve our portfolio by integrating capital and operating data, DHCD has made improvements within the Online Vacancy System to enhance consistency with the information we are collecting and efficiency to analyze the data. Free entry fields to identify units have been replaced with drop down lists, populated with the identifiers in the Capital Planning System (CPS). By using the established CPS unit identifiers, we anticipate it will be easier for housing authorities and DHCD to:

- Create links between vacancies and waiver requests to component data in CPS and to planned capital projects in the Capital Inventory Management System (CIMS);
- Set unit data (i.e. address, unit number, bedroom count) allowing for consistency across multiple systems, such as CPS;
- · Identify duplicative vacancy entries to provide an accurate count of vacant units at any given time; and,
- Analyze the data for turnover trends with specific units.

A sheet providing a quick glance at the changes is included and the User Guide available through the Online System has been updated.


DHCD continues to rely on local housing authorities to provide precise and timely information regarding vacancies and placements. It is important that we are able to truly represent the work you are doing, the effectiveness you exhibit, and to understand the nature and pace of unit turnover. We depend on accurate information contained within the online ledger and our access to this data to analyze trends and provide information to address portfolio needs across the Commonwealth. Consequently, DHCD may access the data within the online vacancy ledger as well as the quarterly reports.




Online Vacancy Ledger System Update - Unit Identifiers


In the Capital Planning System, each housing authority portfolio has been broken out by development, facility and unit.



This same coding has been carried over to the Online Vacancy Ledger System.



Development, facility unit, number of bedrooms and unit condition are required to save the record. You will receive a pop up error message if a drop down field is not selected.



All other data entry fields remain the same.
