MEMORANDUM

TO: LOCAL HOUSING AUTHORITIES ADMINISTERING STATE-AIDED PUBLIC HOUSING

AND/OR STATE RENTAL ASSISTANCE

FROM: OFFICE OF THE CHIEF COUNSEL SUBJECT: MANDATORY DATA REPORTING

DATE: JULY 29, 2011

As you are aware, local housing authorities administering state-aided public housing and/or state rental assistance must annually report data required by the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) pursuant to Chapter 334 of the Acts of 2006 (the "Act") and the regulations at 760 CMR 61.00. We remind you that annual reporting is to reflect occupancy statistics existing as of July 31 of the current calendar year, to be submitted to DHCD by September 30 of the same year. LHAs must submit this year's data by **September 30, 2011**.

As reporting is required annually, LHAs MUST submit 2011 reports even if reporting occurred in prior years. Furthermore, LHAs that administer state-aided public housing and state rental assistance (mobile or project-based) programs must submit annual reports for each program.

Instructions for collecting and reporting data are found in DHCD's 2011 User Guide and Directives on Data Collection and Reporting for state-aided public housing and for state rental assistance. Data **must** be submitted through the 2011 version spreadsheets available online. DHCD's User Guide and 2011 spreadsheets for reporting on state-aided public housing and state mobile and project-based rental assistance are available at http://www.mass.gov/dhcd (search under "LHA Data Collection."). The spreadsheets are password protected. To access the spreadsheets online, the password is "2011." Please ensure that the password protection is maintained and has not been removed from the spreadsheets prior to submitting them.
