

# Massachusetts Civil Service Commission 2014 Calendar Year Statistics

#### **Highlights**

- The Commission received 244 discipline, layoff and bypass appeals in CY14 and closed out 269.
- The case inventory of these appeals as of December 31, 2014 is 123, 25 less than last year.
- 23 appeals have been pending before the Commission for more than 12 months as of December 31, 2014, 19 less than last year.








## 2014 Bypass and Related Appeals Seeking Relief: 130 Decisions
