Dear Mr. Jenssen:

I represent the Massachusetts Division of Insurance ("Division") with regard to the above captioned investigation.

The Division has reviewed information pertaining to your company's business entity insurance producer license lapse for an extended period of time. The Division alleges that The Jenssen Agency, Inc. ("JAI") wrote, placed, renewed and/or negotiated policies during a period of time when the firm's license was not active. The Division alleges that JAI committed violations of M.G.L. c. 175, § 175 by acting as an insurance producer without being licensed. The penalty for each and every violation of M.G.L. c. 175, § 175 is a fine of not more than \$100. Each violation of M.G.L. c. 175, § 175 is also a violation of M.G.L. c. 175, § 162R(a)(2), the penalty of which is a fine of no more than \$1,000 and/or license suspension, probation or revocation.

Under the extenuating circumstances you have brought to our attention, the Division proposes to settle this matter without a fine if JAI agrees to cease and desist from the above-alleged conduct. This will be a reportable administrative action. If these terms are acceptable kindly sign the letter below and return to me. The firm's business entity producer license remains active and in good standing.

Although this correspondence does not constitute the required statutory notice of a public hearing, if this matter is not resolved by December 22, 2015, the Division intends to file an Order to Show Cause.
