Pursuant to Chapter 240 of the Acts and Resolves of 2012, the Massachusetts  
Juvenile Court and the Office of the Commissioner of Probation are pleased to  
submit a periodic report regarding Child Requiring Assistance cases filed between  
January 1, 2019 and December 31, 2019. The report includes the Office of the  
Commissioner of Probation's annual report.

The data contained in this report was compiled from MassCourts, which is the Trial  
Court case management system, and date entry reports completed by probation  
officers when cases were dismissed. It provides insight into the children who are the  
subject of the cases, the types of applications filed, and the services provided to  
children and their families.

Together with the information in this report, additional data from probation and the  
Juvenile Court regarding Child Requiring Assistance cases may be accessed through

The Statewide Analysis of 2019 Child  
Requiring Assistance (CRA) Terminations:  
Submitted Pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 119  
Section 39E to 39I



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### **Abstract**

Youth may be supervised by Probation due to a delinquency and/or status offense. Status offenders, who are habitually truant from school, repeatedly fail to obey school rules, frequently run away from home, continually fail to obey his or her parent or legal guardian, and/or children subjected to sexual exploitation are deemed Child Requiring Assistance (CRA) cases, as defined in M.G.L. Chapter 119 Section 21. In these cases, applicants – parents, guardians, school officials or police – request help from the Court to manage the oftentimes-complex needs of the youth. Once an application is accepted, the youth is able to receive services. Upon the completion of each CRA, a probation officer completes a termination profile of the case that documents critical information, including a youth's demographics, their circumstances and whether any assistance was provided or referred. The following report is a summary of the 4,462 Children Requiring Assistance (CRA) cases that terminated between January 1, 2019 and December 31, 2019.

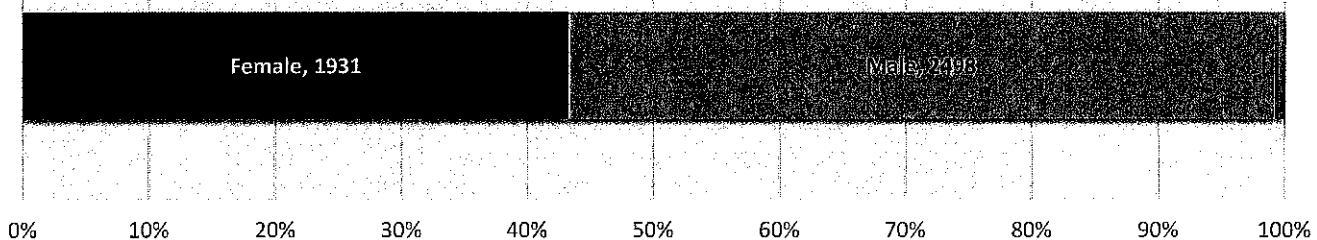


## Demographics

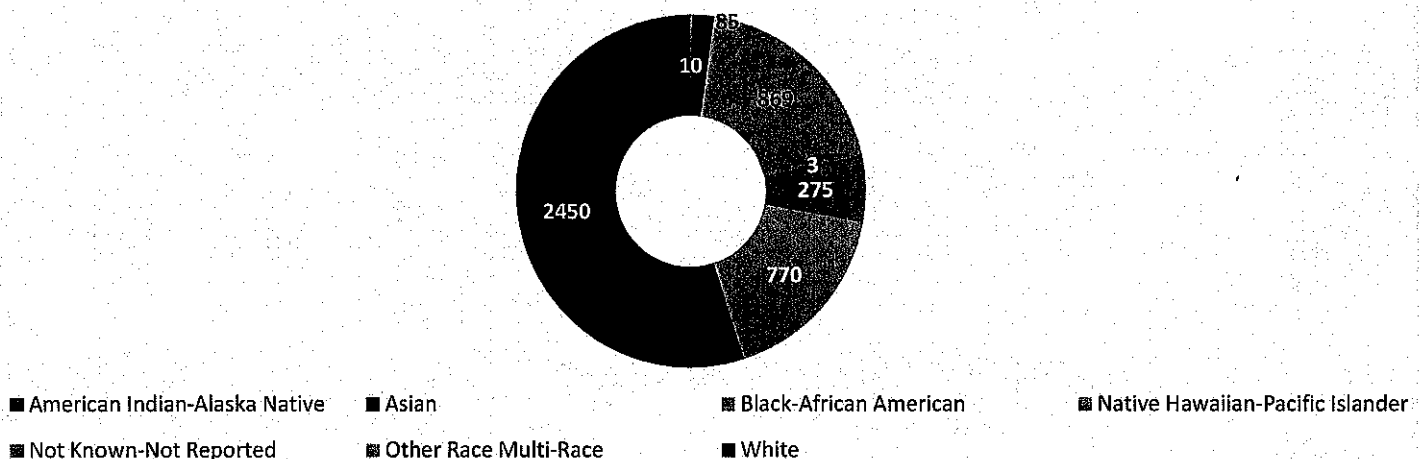
In the 2019 calendar year, there were 4,462 Child Requiring Assistance (CRA) cases terminated. This figure is eleven percent lower than the previous year (n= 5,013).

A child requiring assistance can be no younger than six and no older than 18 at the time of a CRA filing, and this was reflected in the CY 2019 data, where the age of CRA applicants ranged from six to 18 years old. Like CY 2018, the average age of a CRA youth was approximately 15 years old. Of the terminated CRA cases, 43% were female, 56% were male and an additional .4 percent (n=20) were other. Gender was not known in thirteen cases.

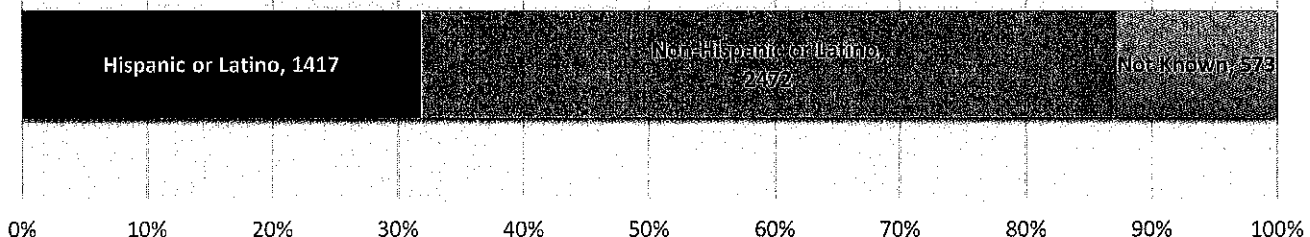
**Gender of CRA Terminated Youth: CY 2019**

**Ethnicity of CRA Terminated Youth: CY 2019**

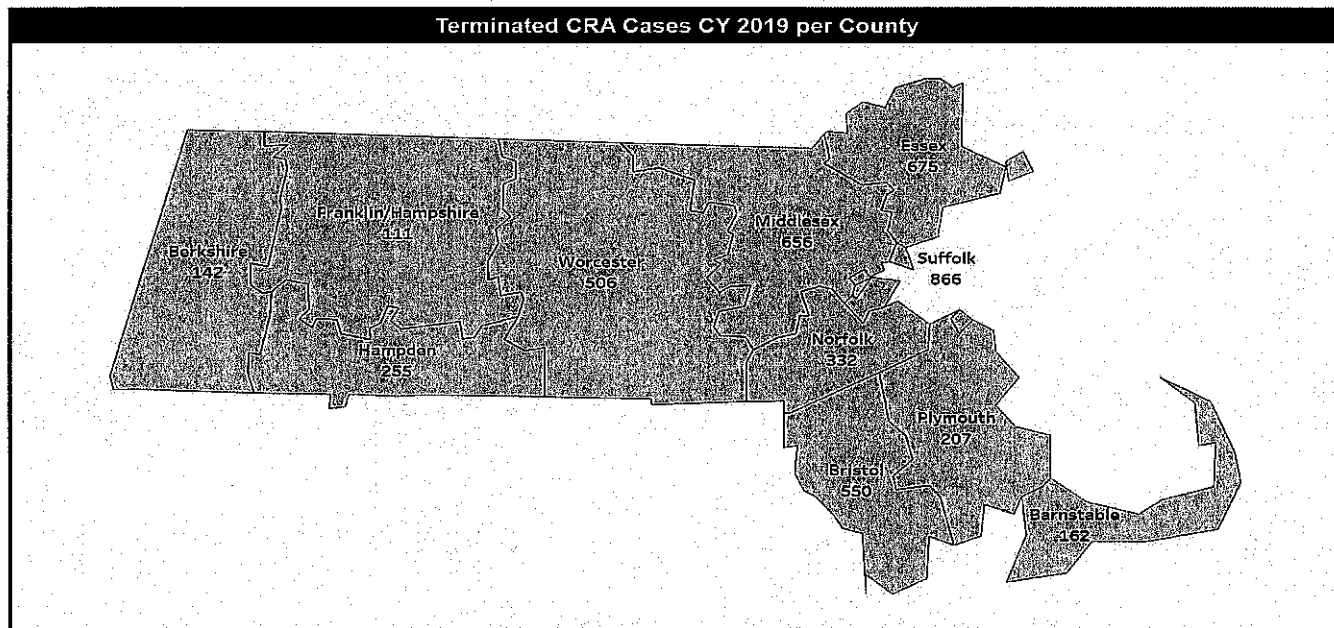




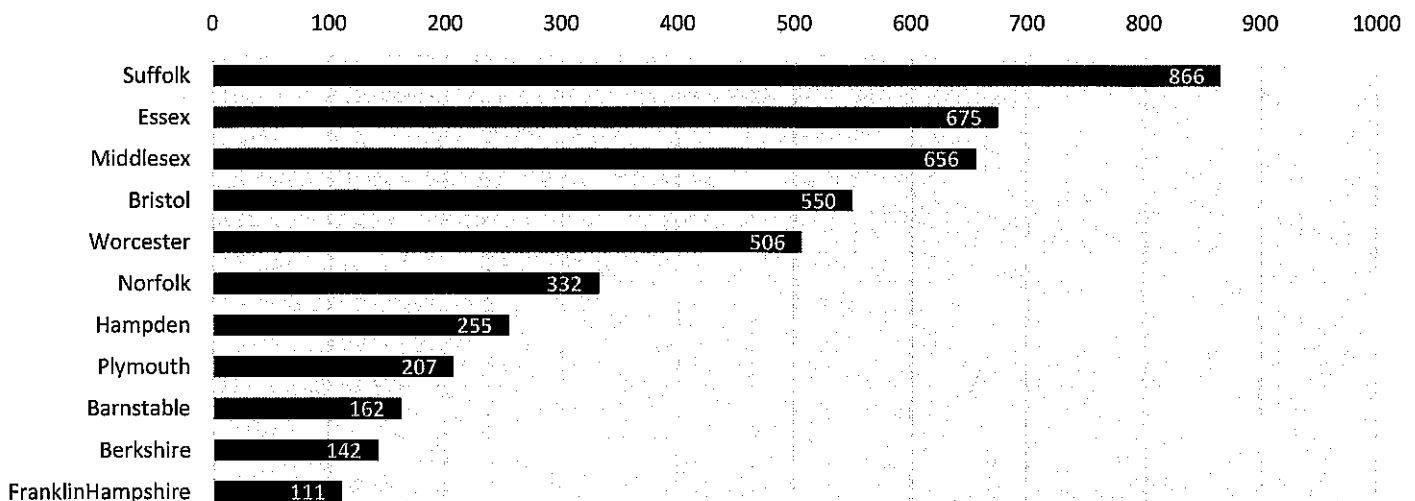
In CY 2019, CRA termination summaries changed their race and ethnicity field from one combined category, to two separate categories, in order to maintain consistency with other reporting methods. As can be observed from the charts, a CRA youth is more likely to be White (55%) and Non-Hispanic (55.4%)

## County of CRA Application

CRA cases are filed in every county in the Commonwealth, with the Suffolk (19.4%), Essex (15.1%) and Middlesex (14.7%) accounting for roughly half of all CRA cases. These three counties were responsible for half of the CRA cases last year as well.



## 2019 CRA Terminations By County

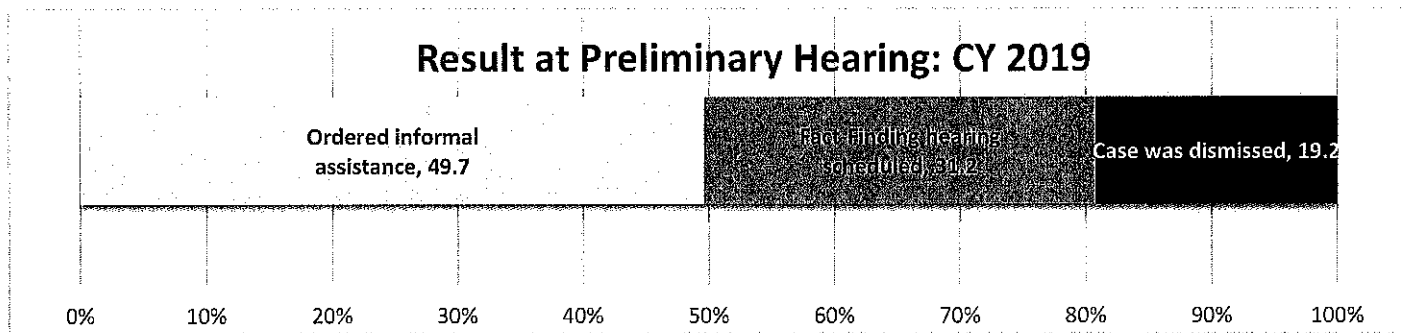




### CRA Process

Adults with different roles and responsibilities may apply for a CRA petition. The most common applicant was a parent, legal guardian or custodian (58.7%), followed by a school (40%), police (.6%) or other (.7%). The CRA petition is filed at the Clerk's Office. It is the Clerk's role, prior to submitting the CRA petition, to inform the applicant of any Family Resource Center that may be in the area. Family Resource Centers (FRCs) are community-based, culturally competent programs that provide a variety of services to children and families, without requiring court involvement. In 2019, it was reported that at least 8% of CRA youth were referred to an FRC prior to their current case. If the applicant prefers to go forward with the filing, as opposed to using an FRC, the Court may accept the petition and later hold a Preliminary Hearing.

At the Preliminary Hearing, all information about the case is gathered and it is the Court's opportunity to hear from the parents, the child and Probation. At the Preliminary Hearing, the court can do one of three things: it can decline the application if no probable cause is found (19.2% in 2019), it can decline the application and order informal assistance (49.7%), or it can accept the application and schedule a fact-finding hearing (31.2%).



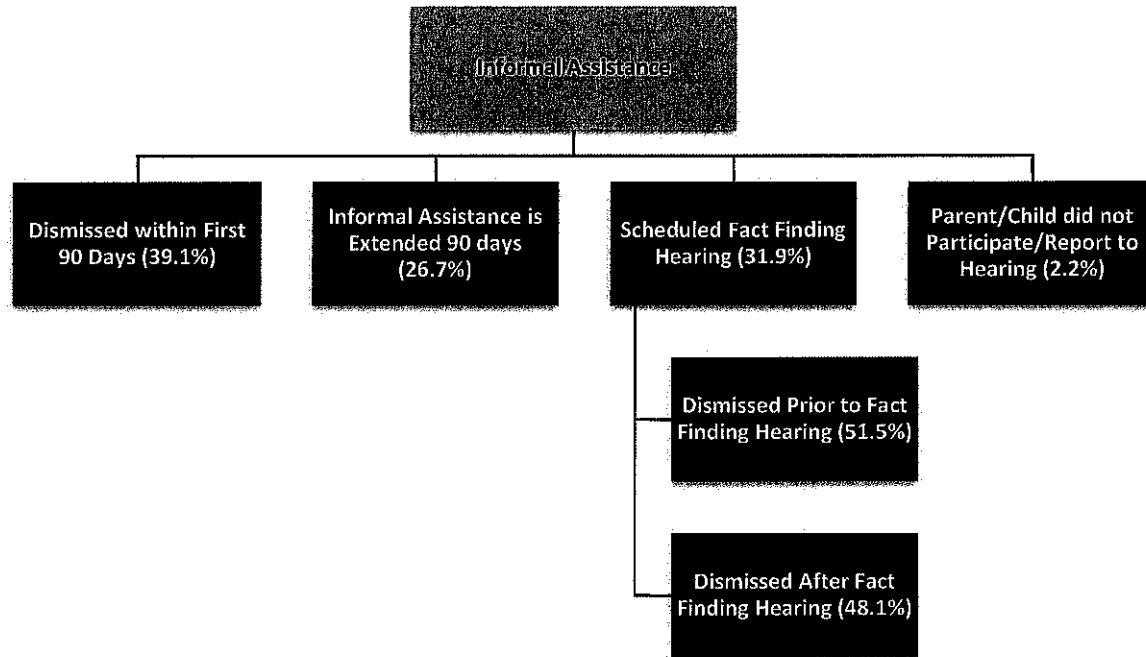
A dismissal means that the case is over, no further action is taken and the record is expunged.

If informal assistance is ordered, the child works with Probation to receive help and sometimes, outside referrals for additional services. Three things can likely happen once a child starts meeting with Probation for informal assistance. Within the first 90 days, the judge may dismiss the case (39.1%), they may extend informal assistance an extra 90 days (26.7%) or schedule a Fact-Finding Hearing (31.9%). Of those cases scheduled for a Fact-Finding Hearing, 51.5% were dismissed prior to the hearing.





## Statewide Analysis of the 2019 CRA Terminations



When a youth's case is continued to a Fact-Finding Hearing, either at the Preliminary Hearing or while the youth is under informal assistance, the judge will most likely either dismiss the case or find that the child requires assistance and schedule a conference and disposition hearing. At the disposition hearing, a probationer officer will prepare a written report on the case. It is also an opportunity for all parties involved in the case to provide information to the court. At the hearing, the judge will decide what steps to take to help the child. These may include medical, educational and/or mental health services. The judge may also decide to place the child in the care of a relative or DCF. Of those CRA youth terminated in CY 2019 who were scheduled a fact-finding hearing, 26% were in the custody of DCF. This is over twenty percentage points higher than other results at the preliminary hearing (case dismissed, 8.9%; informal assistance, 6.7%).

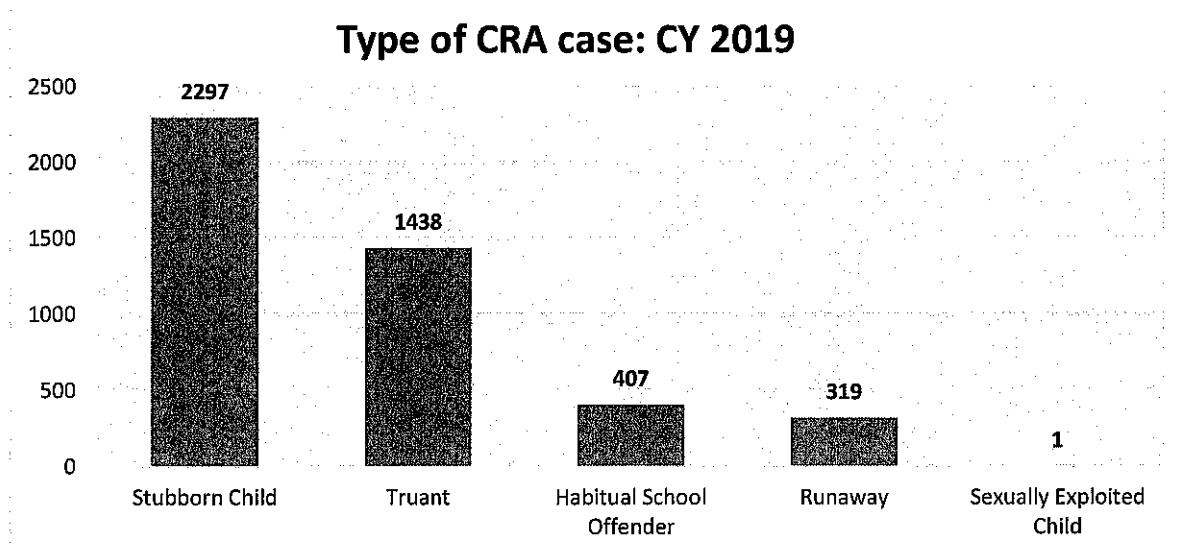
How the Court and Probation decide to help the child largely depends on the type of CRA case and the needs of the child. The next section will describe the different types of CRA cases and the services offered to the youth.

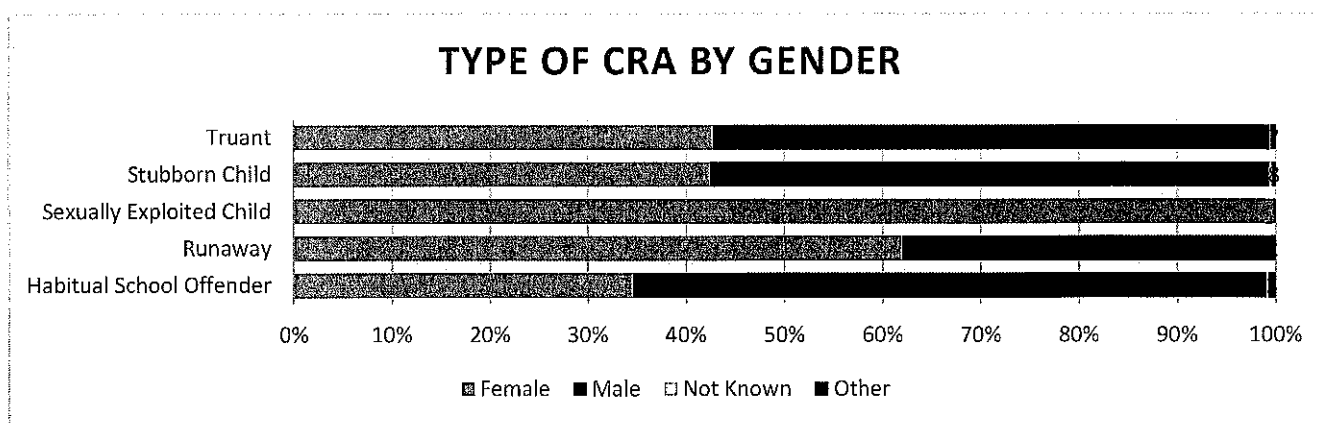
### Type of CRA Case

There are five types of CRA cases. The most common type of CRA is a Stubborn Child (51.5%), followed by Truants (32.2%), School Offenders (9.1%), Runaways (7.1%) and Sexually Exploited Children (.0%, n=1). This breakdown in CRA type is consistent with previous years.



Commonly, there are different demographics associated with each CRA type. As can be observed, Runaways are more likely to be female, while Habitual School Offenders tend to be younger.

### **Stubborn Child**

A Stubborn Child is a child who repeatedly fails to obey reasonable home rules, thereby interfering with the parents' ability to care for the child. Stubborn children often suffer from substance use disorders and mental health issues. This case is the most common type of CRA with 2,297 terminated cases in 2019. Stubborn children are more likely to be male (56.8%)<sup>1</sup>, while 18.6% have had a previous delinquency (versus 13.7% statewide). In CY 2019, the mean age of a stubborn child was 15.3. Almost all CRA applicants were parents, legal guardians or custodians (n=2,267, 98.7%). Most stubborn children were in the custody of their parents.

### **Truants**

When a child willfully fails to attend school for more than eight days in a quarter, the youth may be determined to be a truant. In CY 2019, the mean age of a truant was 14.2. Truants were more likely to be male (56.5%). Unlike stubborn children, the most prevalent applicant in truant cases was the school (96.4%). Truants, compared to all other CRA types, are least likely to have a previous delinquency (6.3%) Most truants were in the custody of their parents (83.7%).

A high percentage of truants were ordered to informal assistance (60.6%). Logically, the main goal when assisting truants is for the child to attend school. This is accomplished through the CRA agreement, in which the child agrees to attend school daily. The probation officer then regularly contacts the school to keep informed of the youth's attendance, and refers the youth to outside services if necessary. Below are the services referred to truants who terminated in 2019.

### Runaways

A runaway is as a child who repeatedly runs away from the home of a parent, legal guardian or custodian. Typically, in a CRA runaway case, the goal of the probation officer is the safe return of the child. When a CRA runaway petition is filed, the judge may issue a warrant of protective custody, which orders a law enforcement officer to pick up the child and bring them to court for a hearing. When the youth appears in court, the judge will hold a preliminary hearing to decide what to do in regards to the case.

Runaway cases are unique in that the youth is typically older than other CRA youth and are more likely to be female (62.1%). In CY 2019, the mean age of a runaway was 15.9.

Compared to other CRA types, runaways are also more likely to be in the custody of DCF.

## Statewide Analysis of the 2019 CRA Terminations

Runaways are the CRA type most likely to be dismissed at the Preliminary Hearing (38.6% vs 19.2% for all other CRA types) and least likely to receive any type of informal assistance by Probation (19.4% vs. 49.7% of remaining CRA types).

Of all CRA types, Runaways are the least likely to be referred to an outside service. Below is a list of services.

### Habitual School Offender

A child is a Habitual School Offender if they repeatedly fail to obey school rules. Generally, the child's school is the applicant in these cases (94.6%). School offenders are the youngest of all CRA types (mean age 13.8), have the highest percentage of male youth (64.4%) and, along with truants (60.6%) were more likely to be ordered to informal assistance (60.7%) than other CRA types. Interestingly, school offenders are the second least likely CRA type to have a previous delinquency, perhaps because the average age is so young. Below is the list of services referred to school offenders.

### Sexually Exploited Children

The CRA type with the historically lowest number of petitions are sexually exploited children. In CY 2019 there was only one case. In 2018 there were six cases and in 2017 there were only three

**Insurance Status.** Another variable that is collected on the CRA termination profile is the insurance status of the youth. Seventy percent of all youth (n=3,139) reported having some type of insurance, with 2,597 (82.7%) receiving MassHealth, 481 (15.3%) receiving private and additional 61 (1.9%) who did not disclose their insurance type. In addition, insurance status was not known or reported for 1,314 youth and nine youth (.2%) reported to be uninsured.
