Dear Commissioner Gladstone:

The attached 2019 Annual Report of the Designer Selection Board is filed in accordance with Chapter 7C, Section 56. This Annual Report lists all finalists selected by the Board during this period including a summary of the actions taken and a description of other relevant activities. Twenty-five meetings were held during this period. In addition, the Board conducted extensive interviews with semi-finalists, and new or reorganized, design firms and participated in conferences and other activities.

The "Executive Narrative" outlines the Board's accomplishments, actions, and other developments which have had an impact on the conduct of our business. The office staff spent considerable time responding to questions from architects, engineers, and municipalities on designer selection procedures and specific inquiries on Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance (DCAMM) and charter school projects, past, present and future.

This Board's responsibility as the central administering body for selection of all designers for vertical building construction projects throughout the Commonwealth necessitated direct involvement in review and approval of the designer selection procedures for certain public agencies, including Mass. Technology Collaborative; Mass. Convention Center Authority; Massport; Department of Housing and Community Development.

The Board had a busy and productive year. A large amount of time and effort was spent streamlining efforts, culminating with the initial rollout of the new Autocene online portal. It is hoped that as progress is made on this and future versions, most of our operations and documentation will be searchable and viewable online. We trust our involvement in expediting the selection of designers will be beneficial to the Commonwealth in providing the necessary supplementary support needed for DCAMM's workload. We would be remiss if we did not mention the great efforts put forth by Deputy Commissioner Liz Minnis and her team to develop a fantastic working relationship with the DSB and staff for the benefit of the Commonwealth.

The Designer Selection Board's ultimate goal is to improve the efficiency and cost of operation of all of the Commonwealth's buildings which can only be achieved through the best quality design. Our efforts were eminently supported by the DSB office staff. The staff has always endeavored to provide a timely and effective response to the needs of the Board and have given the highest priority to expediting the processing of new requests for designer selection.

In compliance with the General Laws and past practices, this Report will be distributed to the State House library and various architectural and engineering organizations and be uploaded to the DSB website and available to the public. This document constitutes the Designer Selection Board's Forty-Ninth Annual Report.

EXECUTIVE NARRATIVE

EXECUTIVE NARRATIVE

This year was very busy for the Designer Selection Board. We processed an average of one hundred thirty-nine (139) projects during the years 2014-2018, while in 2019 the Board acted on forty-three (43) projects. In addition, there were three (3) projects that were carried over for action during our 2020 schedule.

The procedures employed to select finalists for each project were in accordance with Chapter 7C of the Massachusetts General Laws, and were tailored to maintaining the goals of the Board, namely to:

- (a) ensure that the commonwealth receives the highest quality design services for all its building projects;
- (b) provide for increased confidence in the procedures followed in the procurement of design and design related services;
- (c) promote consistency in the methods of procurement of design and design related services;
- (d) foster effective broad-based participation in public work within the design professions; and
- (e) provide safeguards for the maintenance of the integrity of the system for the procurement of designers' services within the commonwealth.

DISTRIBUTION OF DESIGNER SELECTION ACTIVITY

During the 2019 calendar year, there was no one major area of concentration in the designer selection workload; rather, there was a variation of types of projects. (See Recommendations and Appointments tab)

OTHER SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

I EXEMPTION FROM THE JURISDICTION OF THE DESIGNER SELECTION BOARD

In accordance with Chapter 7C, Section 46 of the General Laws, this Board is authorized to approve Designer Selection Procedures for certain public agencies i.e. the Mass. Convention Center Authority; Mass. Technology Collaborative; Massachusetts Port Authority; Department of Housing and Community Development; Massachusetts School Building Authority. Upon approval of such procedures, the respective agency is empowered to perform its own designer selections for two years. If they do not meet with the Board's approval, (specified in writing) they are prohibited from selecting any Designer firms until they have the Boards approval.

During 2019 the Board reviewed Designer Selection Procedures for the following public agencies, with the dispositions shown:

A. Massachusetts School Building Authority (MSBA)

On January 9, 2019, the Board discussed a two-year exemption to MSBA. A motion was made by Beth McDougal to wait for legal advice on the MSBA exemption, seconded by Ken Wexler.

The MSBA responded to the Board and is not required to come before the Board for an exemption.

B. Department of Housing & Community Development (DHCD)

On July 10, 2019, the Board voted to grant a two-year exemption to DHCD expiring on July 31, 2021.

II OTHER ISSUES

A. <u>Request of Extended Services for Study & Design Services for Architectural and Engineering</u> <u>Renovations & Repairs – Reference Project: DYS Connelly Center "Field of Dream" – Gienapp</u> <u>Architects, LLC</u>

On September 25, 2019, the Board reviewed the above request from Department of Youth Services (DYS) and voted to exercise its authority to approve the extension of services with Gienapp Architects, LLC.

B. <u>Request for Extended Services for Study & Design for General Building Renovations, Repairs &</u> <u>Upgrades at Framingham State University – Crocker Interior Repairs - HMFH Architects, Inc.</u>

On December 4, 2019, the Board reviewed the above request from Framingham State University and voted to allow HMFH Architects, Inc. to continue work on a multi-phase renovation to Crocker Hall Building at Framingham State University.

III OVERSIGHT

While the Designer Selection Board has always been an independent agency overseen by the Secretary of Administration and Finance, its HR services, budgeting, and legal services have come from DCAMM. During this year, the Designer Selection Board was elevated to its own full agency, with all services provided by Administration and Finance and the Executive Director reporting as an agency head to the Secretary. There are bi-monthly agency head meetings, occasionally with the Governor and Lt. Governor.

The Executive Director is now required to provide weekly and quarterly reports to the Secretary, along with annual metrics that include progress reports. The focus of the first annual metric has been the continued streamlining and implementation of the online portal.

During this year, the Executive Director has been in constant touch with Jordan Maynard, Director of Boards and Commissions in the Office of the Governor in order to replace certain members of the Designer Selection Board.

Many thanks to the selfless volunteers of the DSB who donate many hours of their time and expertise in service to the Commonwealth.

Prospective candidates for these pro-bono positions as architects, engineers and public members are invited to contact the Executive Director directly for information on making application.

B. BOARD ACTIVITIES

During 2019 the Board continued its streamlining and modernization process with the initial rollout of its new online portal by Autocene (formerly Formverse). These are some of the features of the first version of the new system:

Architects, Engineers & Sub-consultant Database (all users)

Allows prime firms and sub-consultants to register within the system and to develop a public profile with references, public experience, diversity characteristics, evaluations, etc. This replaces current Master File Brochure.

Evaluations and References (all users)

Up until now, there has not been an effective way for agencies to provide state-mandated evaluations to the DSB. With this system, once firms are registered, agencies and municipalities can enter the evaluations which will then be viewable for all users of the system. For subconsultants and prime firms that may not have any evaluations within the system, we are giving them the option to provide references that will be entered in the system.

Project Listings (initially only DCAMM and Charter Schools)

All public notices of new DCAMM and charter school projects that come in front of the DSB will be entered into the system. Public notices from 2014 through 2019 have already been entered.

Online Applications (initially only DCAMM and Charter Schools)

Once the system is fully rolled out in the spring, design firms will be able to respond to listed public notices and complete the entire application online.

Online File access and Searches (all users)

Registered users of all types can complete the firm reports, view all activity for a project or a particular firm, review submitted evaluations and references.

Discussion: DSB Operational Issues – March 6, 2019

Identification of Executive Committee(s): scheduling – The Board had a discussion and there will be no Executive Committee (s) set up for scheduling issues. This will be discussed by the entire Board.

The Board requested that Claire Hester post on the Boardbook the following: Board Membership Term Dates, the Operational Issues, the Weekly Updates from the Executive Director every Friday.

Discussion: DSB Operational Issues – July 24, 2019

Review process and determine timeline to elect new chair and vice-chair for the Board

A motion was proposed by Jessica Tsymbal that the Board nominates and elects a Chair and Vice Chair 2 months prior to their term ending, seconded by Jacquelin Yessian. Motion was approved unanimously.

A motion was proposed by Jessica Tsymbal that the Vice Chair becomes the Chair once the existing Chair term ends. The new Chair will serve for the remainder of their term, seconded by Beth McDougal. Jacquelin Yessian opposed. Motion was approved.

• Election for Vice-Chair

Rebecca Sherer was elected to replace Beth McDougal as Vice-Chairwoman. On a motion by Beth McDougal, seconded by Virginia Greiman. Motion was approved unanimously.

Board Membership

A motion was proposed by Rebecca Sherer that the terms of refurbishing general membership a milestone is to be put on the agenda six months prior to their term ending, seconded by Beth McDougal. Motion was approved unanimously.

• Remote Participation

A motion was proposed by Jessica Tsymbal that allows remote participation of Board Members such as a monitor, microphones, camera and technology needed for the equipment to work properly. Next month the Executive Director will present to the Board the proposed equipment and technology used for the remote participation for members, seconded by Beth McDougal. Motion was approved unanimously.

• Timeline for Autocene (formerly Formverse)

A motion was proposed by Jessica Tysmbal that Autocene attend the next meeting on August 7, 2019 in person and give a demonstration of the ongoing electronic DSB Disclosure form (also known as the Master File Brochure) and application form, seconded by Gregory Brown. Janice Bergeron abstained. Motion was approved.

• Transparency Communication

DSB business should not be discussed through private conversations and emails with staff and members. Any DSB issues or concerns should go through the Chair and Vice Chair to be placed on agenda at the next available meeting.

A motion was proposed by Rebecca Sherer that all communication related to the board to governance be placed in the agenda and recorded in the meeting minutes, seconded by Beth McDougal. Motion was approved unanimously.

• Approved Board Policies

All approved Board Member Policies will be uploaded onto the electronic Boardbook for current and upcoming members.

Discussion: DSB Operational Issues – November 6, 2019

Rebecca Sherer added to the list of board business tasks. She will update with the Executive Director and post on Boardbook and discuss at future meetings.

Discussion: DSB Operational Issues – November 20, 2019

- Interior Designer Discussion A motion was made by Martha Blakey Smith to modify the language in the DSB advertisements when an interior designer is required as a consultant that under the project experience section, an interior designer is required to show certain interior designer experience required in the description of the project, seconded by Gregory Brown. Motion was approved unanimously.
- Autocene (formerly Formverse) Discussion Bill Perkins updated the Board on the status of Autocene. Bill stated that the DSB is trying to get more firms to register on the system. Claire Hester and Roberto Melendez have uploaded 6 years of public notices and provided a summary of each project to Autocene. Bill said that our biggest challenge is getting firms feedback from firms and members. The DSB is trying to focus on getting more firms and public agencies to register. DCAMM cannot do the evaluations until firms start registering. Regarding the application form: Jessica Tsymbal and some of the Board would like to see the resumes for one person per page (not 2 as we have now). Jessica will share her comments on the application and Claire will upload onto the Boardbook; everyone can review it and make comments. The Board requested to have 2

architectural firms fill out an application to test the system (an old advertisement that have been submitted in the past). Charles Redmon and Jessica Tsymbal requested that it be 2 architectural firms to perform the test. Rebecca Sherer recommended Cannon Design and Jones Architecture. The Board will continue to discuss at future meetings and set a date for a roll out of online application. Charles Redmon wants BSA to be notified of the online application system.

Interviews with Designer Firms

From time to time, as the schedule will allow, the Board devotes meeting time to the interviewing of those design firms which are newly organized, which may have experienced major management changes, or desire to present their credentials to the Board. The Board has committed to accelerate the rate of interviews.
