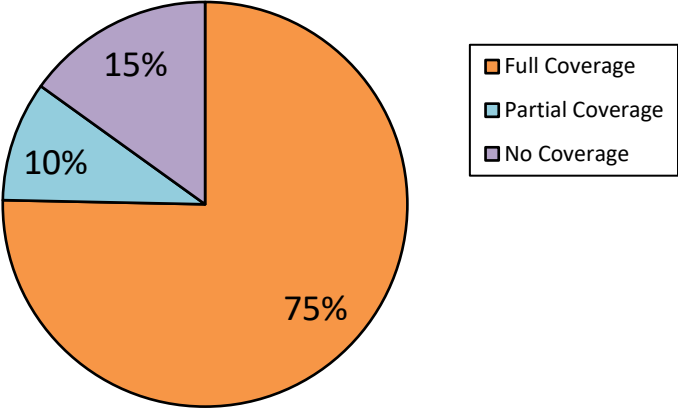

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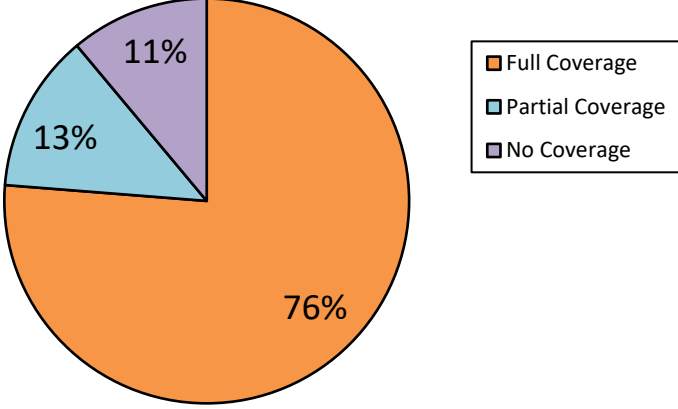

Mandated Benefits for which more than 10% of Self-Insured Accounts provided "No Coverage" for the mandate

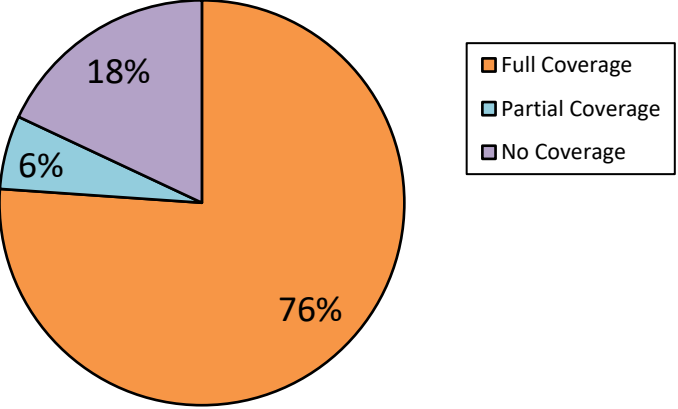
Autism Spectrum Disorder Treatment



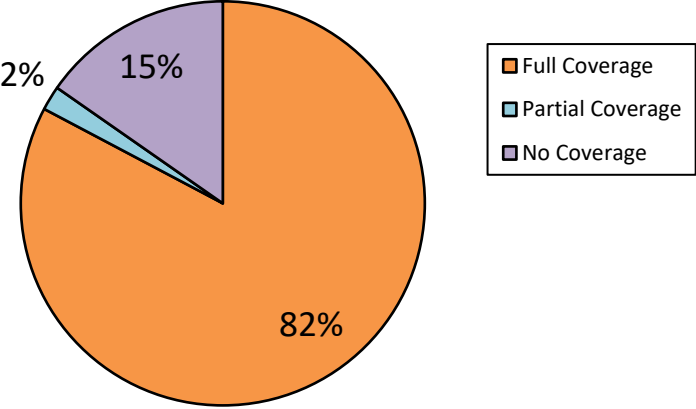
Early Intervention Services



Hearing Aids for Children

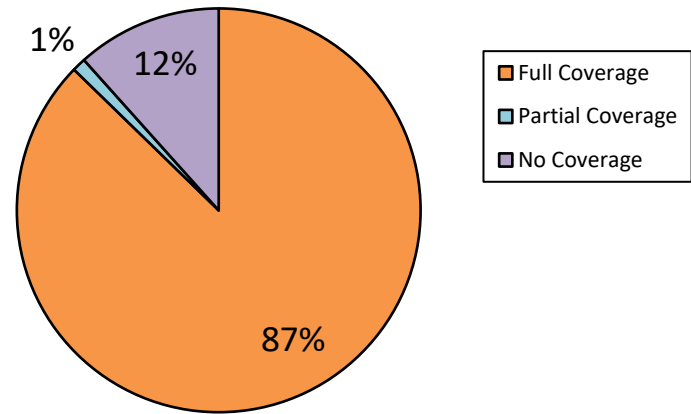


HIV Associated Lipodystrophy Treatment

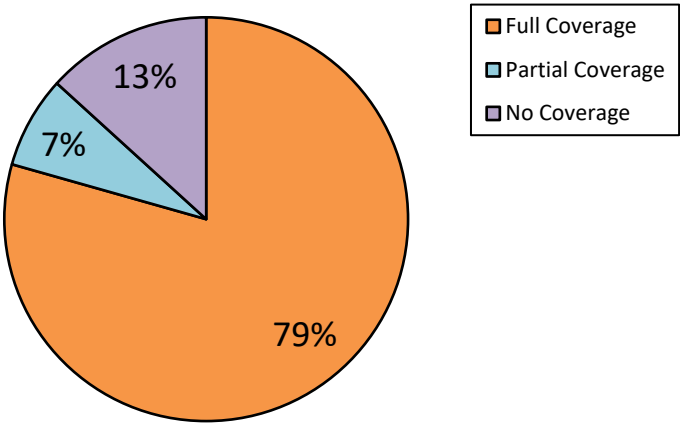

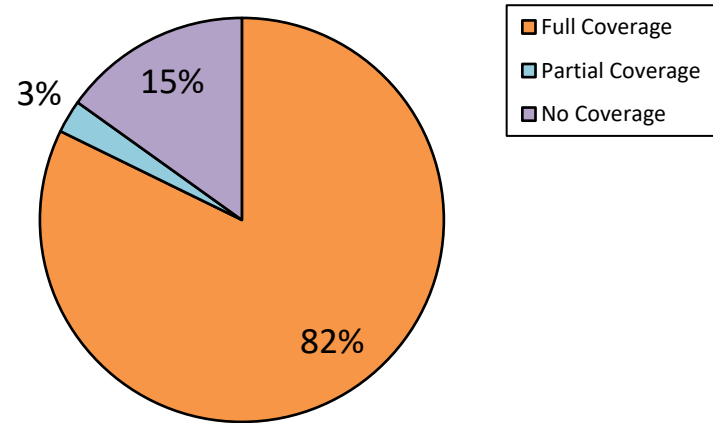
Hypodermic Syringes or Needles
