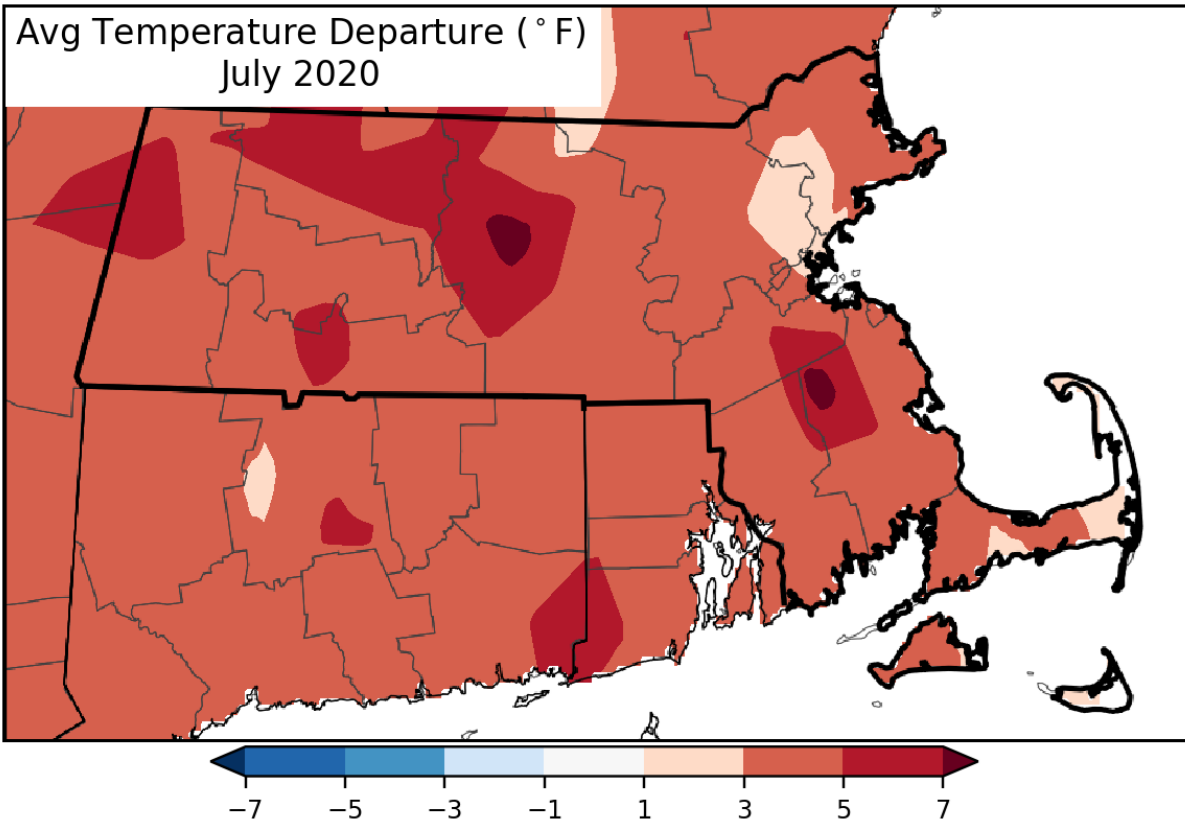
July 2020 Rainfall

Temperature Departure from Normal



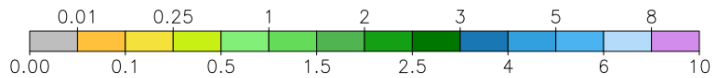
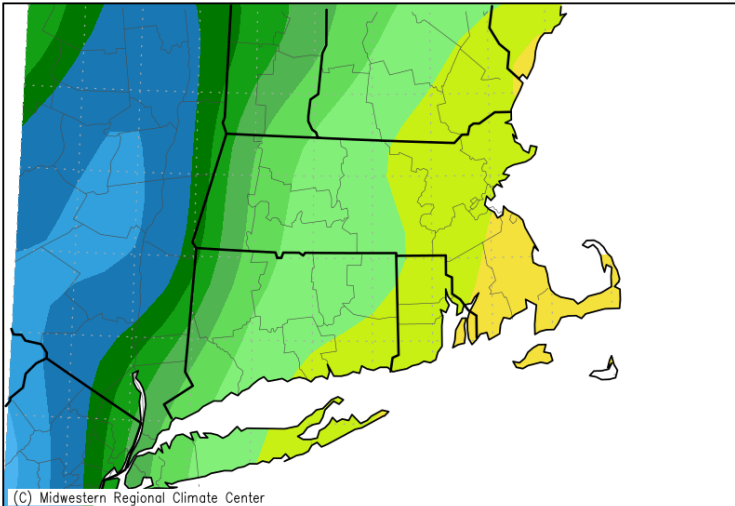
State-wide Specifics

- Record Hottest July: 75.0 deg F from 2013

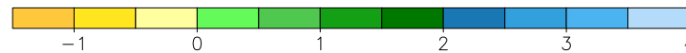
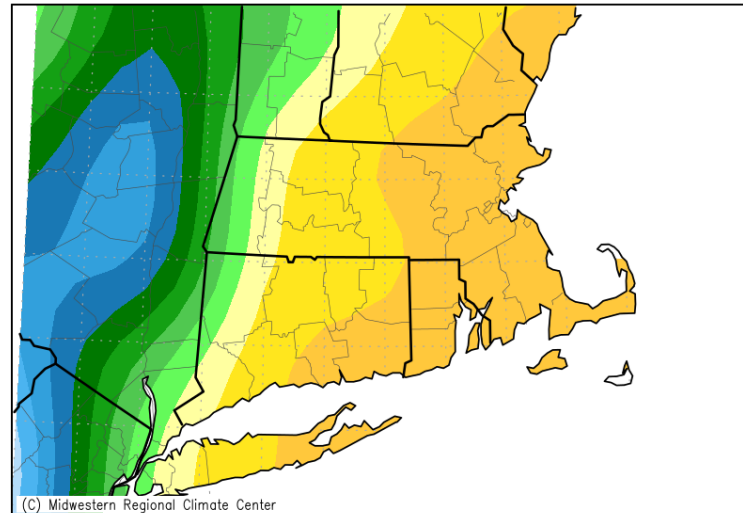
August 1-11 Month-to-date

August 1, 2020 to August 11, 2020



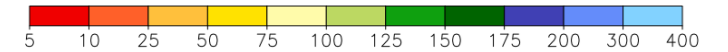
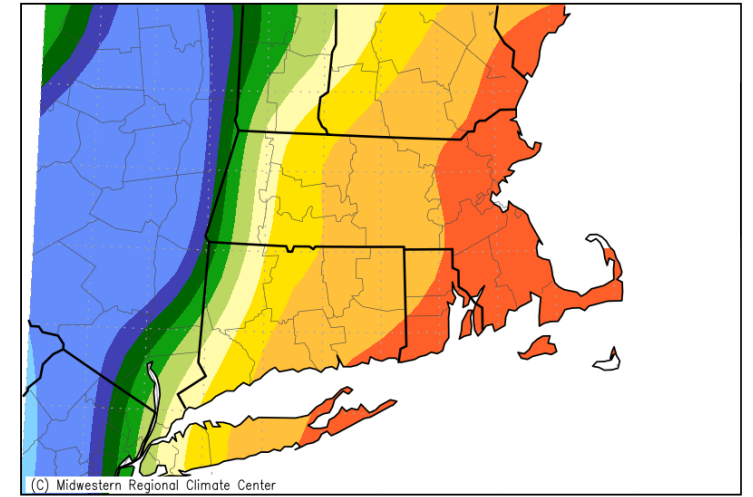

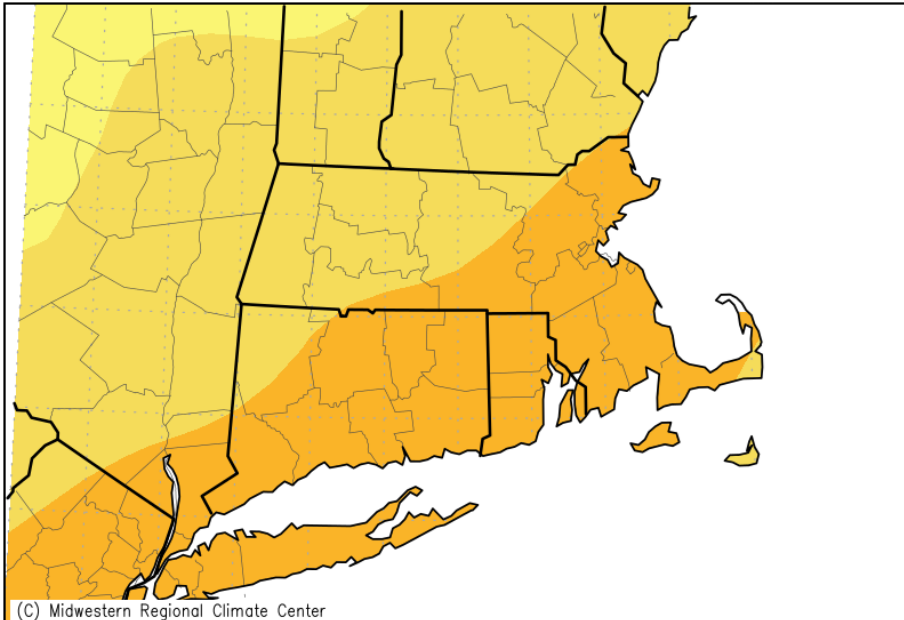
Accumulated Precipitation: Percent of Mean

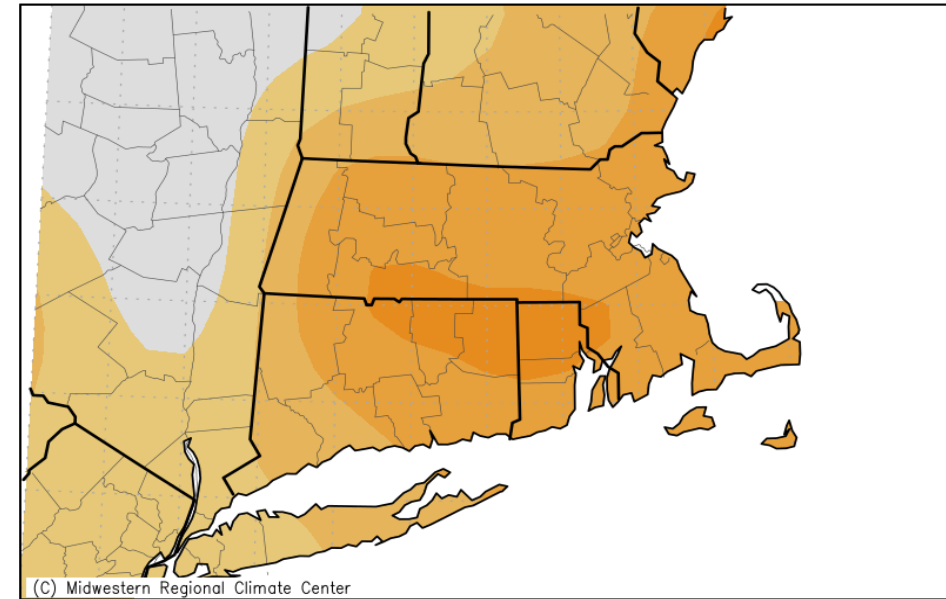
August 1-11 Temperatures

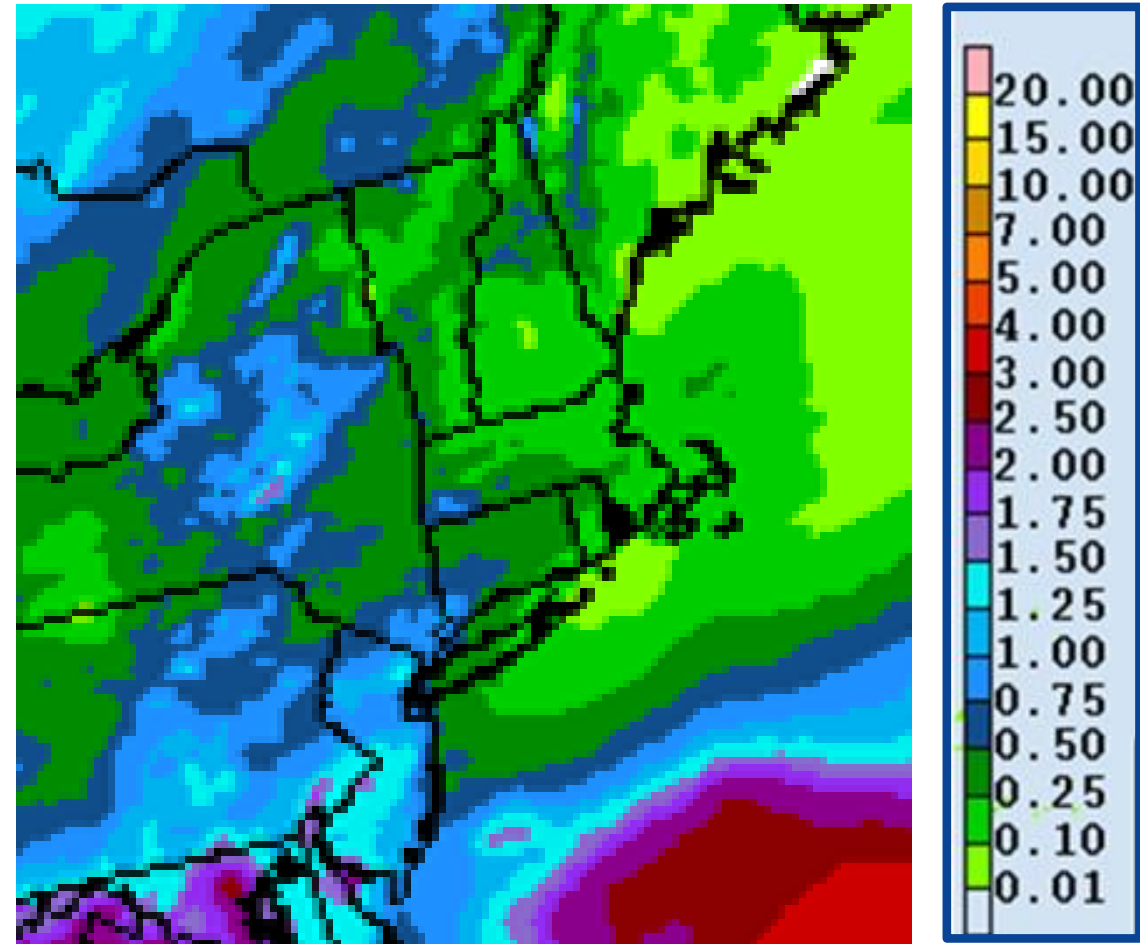
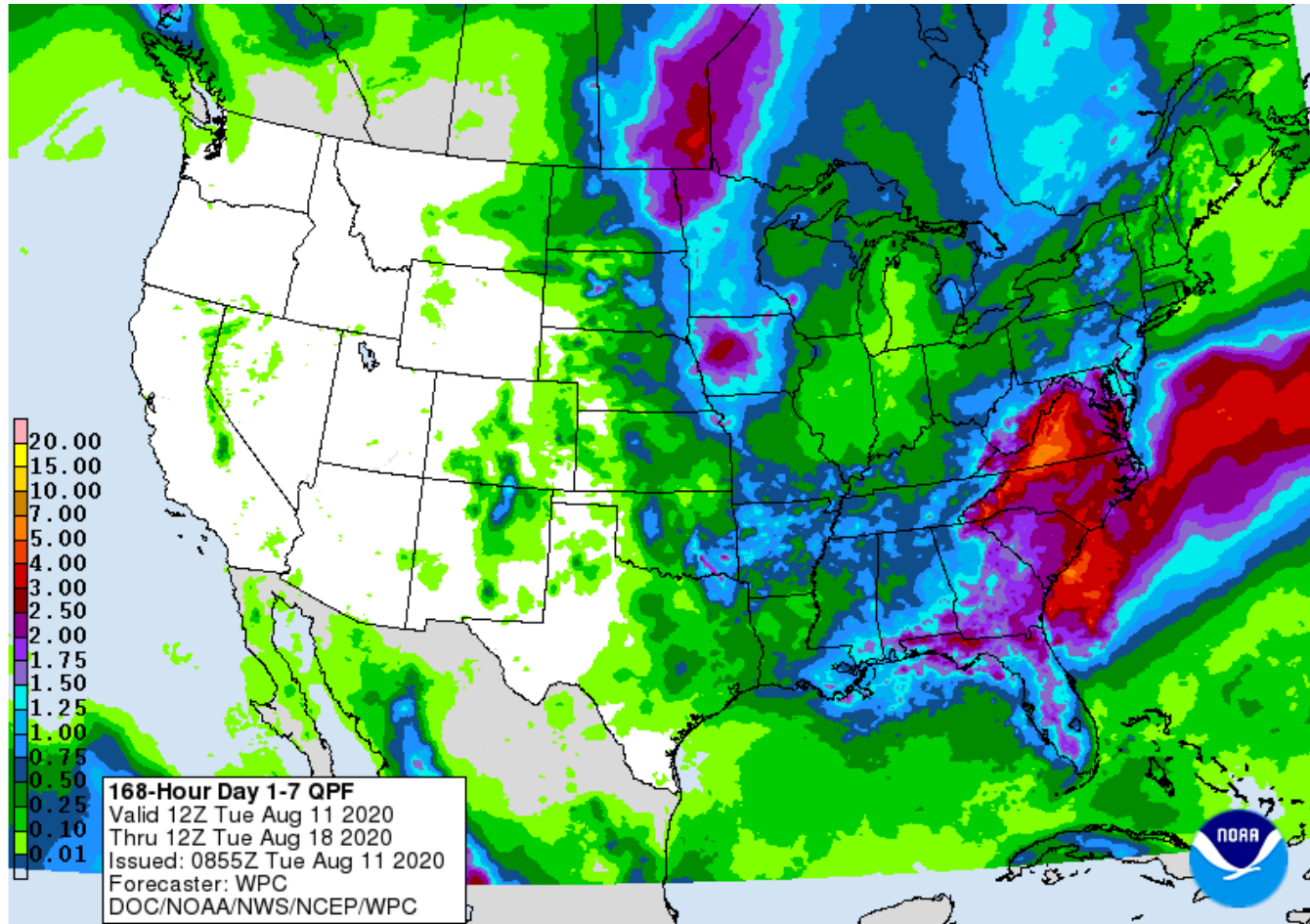
Average Temperature (°F): Departure from Mean
August 1, 2020 to August 10, 2020



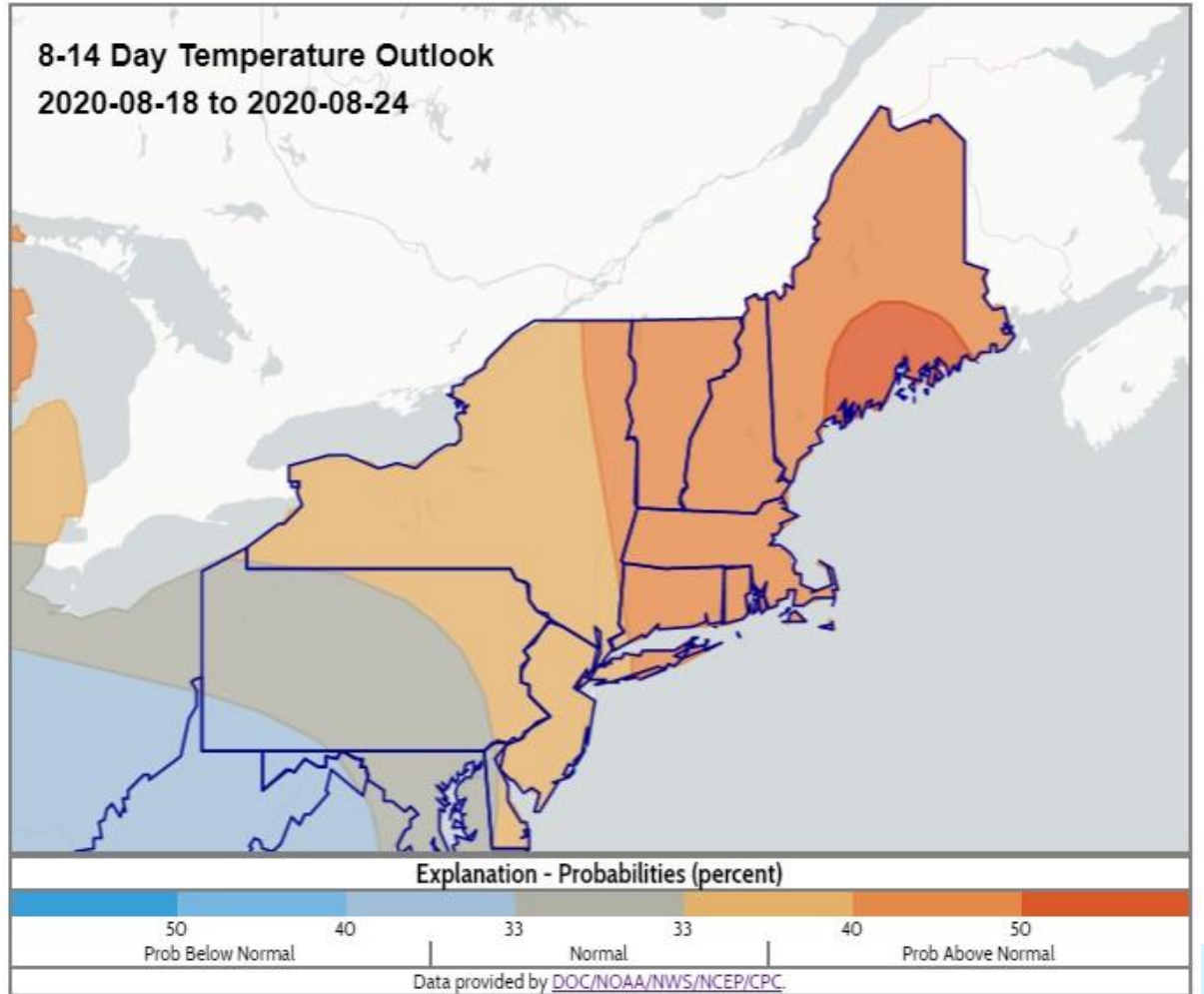
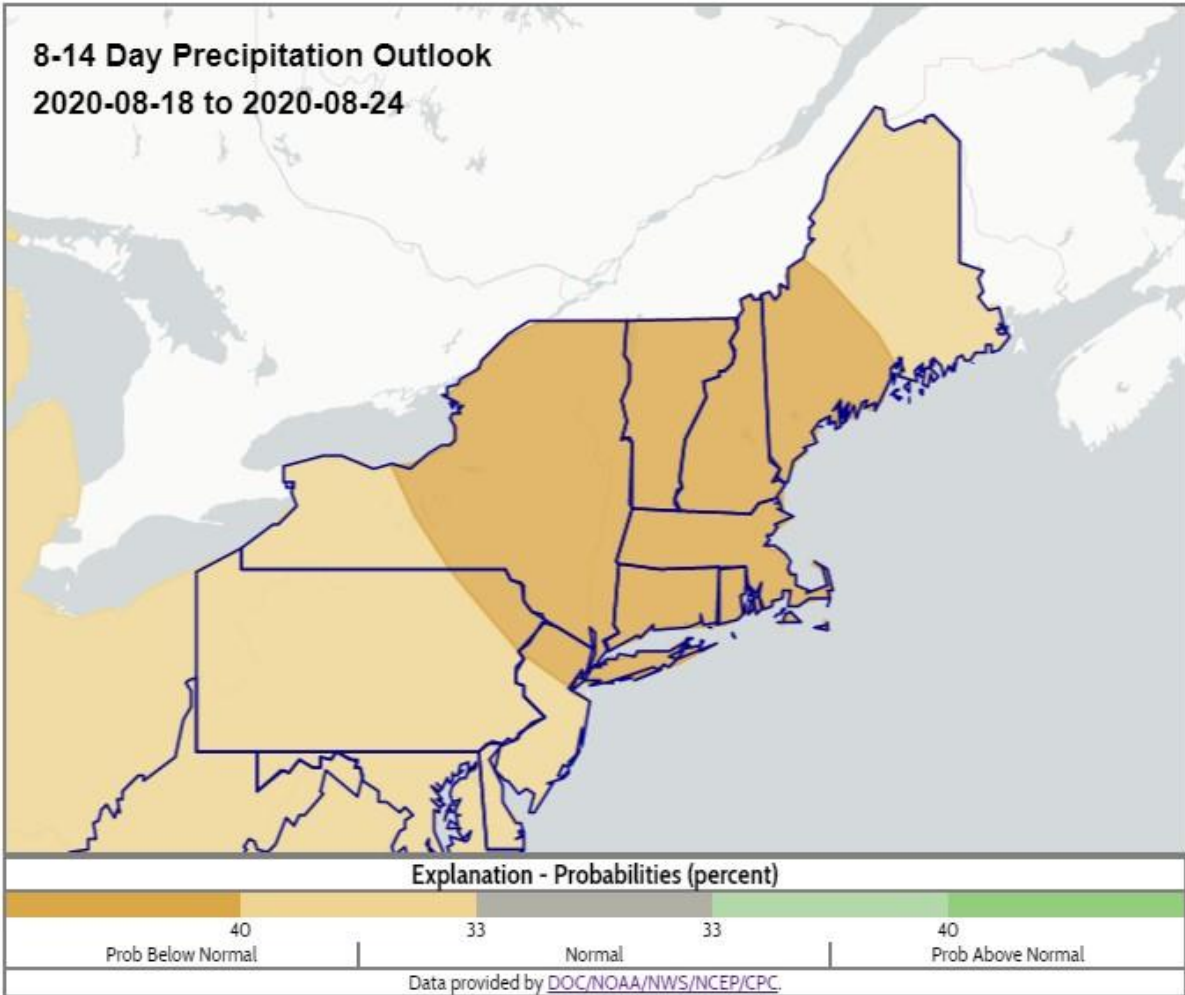

Rainfall Forecast through 8 am Tuesday Aug 18

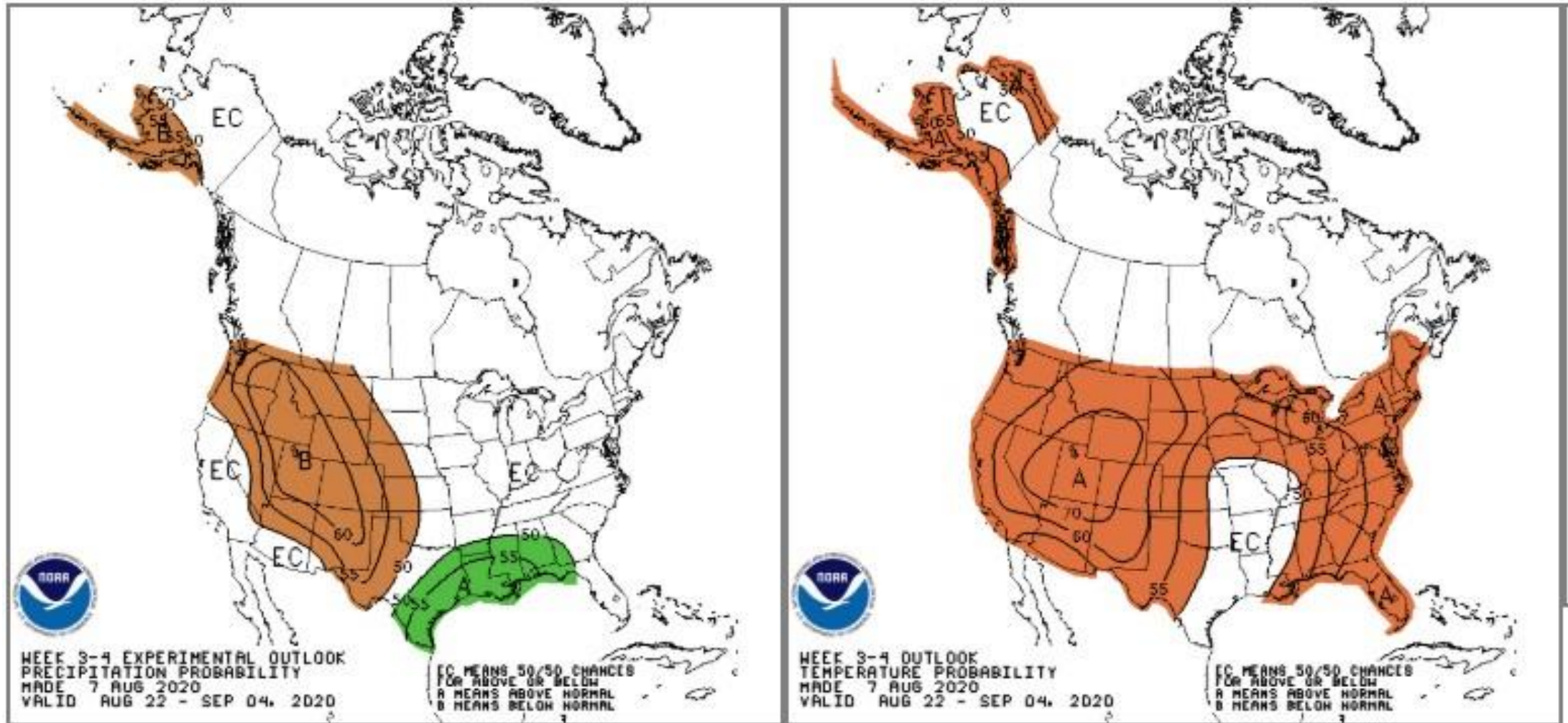
