The attached 2020 Annual Report of the Designer Selection Board is hereby provided in accordance with Chapter 7C, Section 56. This Annual Report lists all finalists selected by the Board during this period including a summary of the actions taken and a description of other relevant activities.

Twenty public meetings were held during this period, with several meetings postponed or cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The subject of these posted public meetings included the review of submitted projects, interviews with finalists, general informational interviews of interested design firms, and discussions and voting on updated board policies and procedures.

Most of these meetings were held remotely via Zoom due to public meeting COVID restrictions and it is expected that they will continue to be held in this manner indefinitely. The implementation of remote meetings has resulted in far better attendance of both board members and members of the public.

A great deal of time and effort was spent making tweaks and improvements to the new Autocene online portal and rolling out new features quarterly. With broad industry input and support, significant progress was made, and hundreds of new users took out credentials.

DCAMM continues to be a big part of the Autocene success and it would not be possible without the active support of you and Deputy Commissioner Liz Minnis and her team, so we really appreciate it. We are well on our way towards our goal to make this system an efficient

statewide platform for design work with all our operations searchable, viewable, and completed online.

In compliance with the General Laws and past practices, this Report will be distributed to the State House library and various architectural and engineering organizations and be uploaded to the DSB website and available to the public. #### **Annual Summary**

While the Designer Selection Board has always been an independent agency overseen by the Secretary of Administration and Finance, its HR services, budgeting, and legal services have come from DCAMM. During this year, the Designer Selection Board was elevated to its own full agency, with all services provided by Administration and Finance and the Executive Director reporting as an agency head to the Secretary. There are bi-monthly agency head meetings, occasionally with the Governor and Lt. Governor. The Executive Director is now required to provide weekly and quarterly reports to the Secretary, along with annual metrics that include progress reports.

The Board held twenty (20) public meetings in 2020, with several other meetings postponed or cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The subject of these posted public meetings included the review of submitted projects, interviews with finalists, general informational interviews of interested design firms, and discussions and voting on updated board policies and procedures. We acted on twenty (20) projects that included the public review of approximately 350 applications. In addition, there were three (3) projects that were carried over for action during our 2021 schedule. Details can be found below.

Most of these meetings were held remotely via Zoom Webinar due to public meeting COVID restrictions and it is expected that they will continue to be held in this manner indefinitely. The implementation of remote meetings has resulted in far better attendance of both board members and members of the public.

In addition to our public meetings, the Board had a productive year updating and streamlining its operations. Two member subcommittees were created and had regular public meetings: (1) Autocene Subcommittee to discuss and advise on system features and improvements; and (2) Criteria Subcommittee to discuss and advise on public notice project criteria standardization. Both are expected to be permanent committees.

Central to the work of staff and the subcommittees was making tweaks and improvements to the new Autocene online portal and rolling out new features quarterly. With broad industry input and support,

significant progress was made, and hundreds of new users took out credentials. We are well on our way towards our goal to make this system an efficient statewide platform for design work with all our operations searchable, viewable, and completed online.

We developed and approved a new shorter, five (5) section online application that is generated completely in Autocene. Board chair Alan Ricks took the lead here and created a clear, organized and modern application in Adobe InDesign that is far easier to read. Later we also began offering a Microsoft Word version. We also retired our onerous and outdated Master File Brochure with a simple online disclosure form that allows firms to make regular updates and only requires a one-click certification to maintain statutory eligibility. These steps have virtually eliminated the rampant errors found in our previous paper-based system that resulted in as many as 15% of applications rejected. While municipalities and some state agencies are still using our old sixteen (16) section application and master file brochure forms, we hope to transition them to the new system in the coming months and years.

DCAMM continues to be a big part of the Autocene success with Deputy Commissioner Liz Minnis and her team providing fantastic input and support. Together we developed an online application review process for all interested parties to review. We also updated and modernized the Public Notice form and procedures.

The office staff spent considerable time responding to questions from architects, engineers, and municipalities on designer selection procedures and the Autocene implementation. Staff held dozens of large and small group training sessions to educate users on the new system and how to improve their applications. As former clerical work is automated in the system, staff is transitioning more to a user support and system improvement role. Since everything is electronic, we are now able to expedite the publishing, review and selection of designers in a manner that should be beneficial to agencies throughout the Commonwealth. Agencies within Massachusetts and across the country have contacted us about using some of the features we have developed in Autocene.

The Department of Housing and Community Development has fully embraced the Autocene portal and has helped us greatly in coming up with ideas for improvements to the system. It is expected that Autocene will be fully integrated with their CapHub project management system and that the projects from their 240 housing authorities will be listed fall 2021.

#### **Notable Issues and Actions**

#### Agency Exemption from Jurisdiction

The Board's responsibility as the central administering body for selection of all designers for vertical building construction projects throughout the Commonwealth necessitates direct involvement in review and approval of the designer selection procedures for certain public agencies. During our July 8, 2020 public meeting, the Massachusetts Port Authority was granted a two-year exemption from MGL Chapter 7C, Provision 46. Similarly, the Massachusetts Convention Center Authority was granted a two-year exemption during our October 7, 2020 meeting. Other agencies that previously have requested exemptions such as Mass. Technology Collaborative and the Department of Housing and Community Development among others were either current with an exemption or stated that they have no projects so there was no need for an exemption.

Request for Emergency Selection – DSB List #20-19, #HLY2102, Soldiers Home Holyoke Long-Term Care Facility and Campus Framework. On November 4, 2020, the Board reviewed the above request from DCAMM for the Holyoke Soldiers Home and voted to exercise its authority to approve the emergency selection and voted to select the following firms to be interviewed by DCAMM: Payette, Perkins Eastman, SmithGroup. On November 24, 2020, DCAMM appointed Payette Associates, Inc. for the emergency services at Holyoke Soldiers' Home.

#### Membership

In accordance with the intent of the enabling legislation, the Designer Selection Board is a constantly self-renewing body. The Executive Director maintains a close working relationship with Boards and Commissions in the Office of the Governor in order to replace certain members of the Designer Selection Board. Local professional organizations such as ACEC-MA and AIA-MA provide valuable advice and assistance in new member recruitment. We had one resignation in 2020 and one new appointment. Resigning members are provided with a governor's citation and a personalize DCAMM photo book.
