RRC asked several questions and uncovered numerous unresolved issues regarding the proposal, including: psychological risks associated with asking individuals about their IQ, gender identity, and mental health diagnoses; psychological risks to guardians; psychological risk assessment; informed consent; guardian consent, verification, and documentation; consent procedures and scope; HIPAA and access to medical records; data privacy, access, use, and disposal; audio and visual recordings and disposal; participant selection; participant's capacity to participate; survey procedures; participant compensation; withdrawn assent and compensation; recruitment procedure; current participants and whether DDS clients are already being used as participants as the research has been ongoing since September 1, 2020.
