The attached 2021 Annual Report of the Designer Selection Board is hereby provided in accordance with Chapter 7C, Section 56. This Annual Report lists all finalists selected by the Board during this period including a summary of the actions taken and a description of other relevant activities.

Twenty-four public meetings were held during this period. These meetings were held remotely via Zoom due to public meeting COVID restrictions and it is expected that they will continue to be held in this manner indefinitely.

The "Executive Narrative" outlines the Board's accomplishments, actions, and other developments which have had an impact on the conduct of our business. The office staff spent considerable time responding to questions from architects, engineers, and municipalities on designer selection procedures and specific inquiries on Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance (DCAMM) and charter school projects, past, present and future.

This Board's responsibility as the central administering body for selection of all designers for vertical building construction projects throughout the Commonwealth necessitated direct involvement in review and approval of the designer selection procedures for certain public agencies, including Mass. Convention Center Authority; Massport; Department of Housing and Community Development.

The Board had a busy and productive year. We trust our involvement in expediting the selection of designers will be beneficial to the Commonwealth in providing the necessary supplementary support needed for DCAMM's expanded workload.

The Board looks forward to continued cooperation and assistance in achieving the Commonwealth's goal of providing well designed public buildings at reasonable cost. Our efforts were eminently supported by the DSB office staff. The staff has always endeavored to provide a timely and effective response to the needs of the Board and have given the highest priority to expediting the processing of new requests for designer selection.

In compliance with the General Laws and past practices, this Report will be distributed to the State House library and various architectural and engineering organizations and be uploaded to the DSB website and Autocene and is available to the public. This document constitutes the Designer Selection Board's Fifty-First Annual Report.

## EXECUTIVE NARRATIVE

The Board had twenty-four (24) meetings scheduled in 2021. We acted on thirty (37) projects with 381 applications. In addition, there were five (5) projects that were carried over for action during our 2022 schedule.

The procedures employed to select finalists for each project were in accordance with Chapter 7C of the Massachusetts General Laws, and were tailored to maintaining the goals of the Board, namely to:

- (a) *ensure that the commonwealth receives the highest quality design services for all its building projects;*
- (b) *provide for increased confidence in the procedures followed in the procurement of design and design related services;*
- (c) *promote consistency in the methods of procurement of design and design related services;*
- (d) *foster effective broad-based participation in public work within the design professions; and*
- (e) *provide safeguards for the maintenance of the integrity of the system for the procurement of designers' services within the commonwealth.*

## DISTRIBUTION OF DESIGNER SELECTION ACTIVITY

During the 2021 calendar year, there was no one major area of concentration in the designer selection workload; rather, there was a variation of types of projects. (See Recommendations and Appointments)

## OTHER SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

### **I EXEMPTION FROM THE JURISDICTION OF THE DESIGNER SELECTION BOARD**

In accordance with Chapter 7C, Section 46 of the General Laws, this Board is authorized to approve Designer Selection Procedures for certain public agencies i.e. the Mass. Convention Center Authority; Massachusetts Port Authority; Department of Housing and Community Development. Upon approval of such procedures, the respective agency is empowered to perform its own designer selections for two years. If they do not meet with the Board's approval, (specified in writing) they are prohibited from selecting any Designer firms until they have the Board's approval.

During 2021 the Board reviewed Designer Selection Procedures for the following public agencies, with the dispositions shown:

A. Department of Housing & Community Development (DHCD)

On July 7, 2021, the Board voted to grant a two-year exemption to DHCD expiring on July 31, 2023.

### **II OTHER ISSUES**

A. Request for Extension of House Doctor Fee for Miller Dyer Spears, Massachusetts College of Art, DSB List #11-06, Item #1, Fee Extension: \$70,111

On March 31, 2021, the Board reviewed the above request from Massachusetts College of Art and voted to exercise its authority to approve the extension of fee for \$70,111 with Miller Dyer Spears.

- B. Request for Continuation of Design Services for Massachusetts Military Division House Doctor for DSB List #19-41, Project #32, Study & Design of Architectural Repairs, Renovations and Upgrades, Statewide for the following firms:

William Pevear Architects, Inc. for Camp Edwards Building 102, HVAC project, Continued Fee: \$125,000  
CSS Architects, Inc. for Braintree Armory, Roof Replacement, Continued Fee: \$125,000

On September 15, 2021, the Board reviewed the above request from Massachusetts Military Division and voted to exercise its authority to approve the continuation of design services with William Pevear and CSS Architects.

- C. Request of Design Services for Redirecting design work from 361 Belgrade Avenue to 69-71 Proctor Street, Roxbury. Advertised as DSB List #17-01, Item #3, RPCHS 2017, New Uncommon Roxbury Prep Charter High School Facility, Roxbury for Symmes Maini McKee Architects (SMMA)

On November 3, 2021, the Board reviewed the above request from New Uncommon Roxbury Prep Charter High School Facility and voted to exercise its authority to approve the extension of services with Symmes Maini McKee Architects (SMMA).

- D. Request of Extension of Design Fee for Massachusetts Military Division, DSB List #15-08, Item #3, Project #30, Study & Design of Mechanical, Electrical, Plumbing and Fire Protection Repairs and Renovations. Reference Project: Springfield Armory – Boiler Replacement. Extension of Fee: \$60,000 for Shekar and Associates, Inc.

On December 15, 2021, the Board reviewed the above request from Massachusetts Military Division and voted to exercise its authority to approve the extension of fee for \$60,000 with Shekar and Associates, Inc.

- E. Notification of Continued Services & Team Change for Saam Architecture, LLC  
**DSB List #16-15, Comprehensive Facilities Plan and Infrastructure Upgrades at the McCormack Building Boston**

### **III LEGAL MATTERS**

#### **Interpretations of Chapter Seven M.G.L.**

From time to time, the Board receives inquiries, by telephone, by mail and by email, asking for our interpretations of the laws governing designer selection procedures. The questions may come from city or town officials, members of designer selection bodies, or practicing architects and engineers.

The Designer Selection Board staff attempt to research the applicable laws, and particularly to find reasonably similar cases in the Board's files.

Up until a few years ago, the Bureau of Labor and Industries was available for answering such questions, but that practice has ceased. As a replacement, the Office of the Attorney General, Fair Labor & Business Practices has assumed an interpreter's role.

Another valuable source of information in these matters has been the Inspector General's Office.

(A) Eight (8) appointments by the Governor of which three (3) shall be Registered Architects, three (3) Registered Engineers and two (2) shall be representatives of the public who are not architects, designer, engineers, or public contractors

(B) One appointment by Design Professionals Government Affairs Council (The Engineering Center- TEC)

(C) One appointment by Massachusetts Chapter of the American Institute of Architects (MA AIA)

## **B. BOARD ACTIVITIES**

### **Board Business: January 6, 2021**

#### **Notes of Gratitude**

Alan wanted to the start the New Year with a shout out to the DSB staff for all their work implementing the Autocene platform and bringing the DSB into the digital era. Elise gave a shout out of gratitude to the architectural, engineering, DCAMM communities and other agencies that have worked with the Autocene team; their participation will make Autocene successful. Jessica gave a shout out to Ginny for going into the office during quarantine while others were able to safely stay home. Ilyas wanted to thank Roberto and Claire for all their help to him as a newcomer to the Board.

#### **Public Comments**

Alan would like to test drive public comments after the Board reviews the applications at this meeting. Jessica wants this item discussed by the full Board before public comment is allowed at meetings. Rebecca stated that the transparency of this Board is extremely important and making any decisions outside of public meetings that does not engage the full Board is not transparent. This item will be discussed by the full Board at the next meeting on January 20, 2021.

#### **Reverse Order of Application**

The Board agrees to reverse the order of reviewing the applications at the next meeting. The Board will review applications in reverse order at every other meeting.

## **Board Business: January 20, 2021**

### **Public Comments**

There would be a window of time during which we would invite public to comment. This would be moderated by the DSB staff and the public would send a chat message to be elevated to comment and be limited to one minute.

Some of the concerns by the members:

- This would go much smoother when we go back to in-person meetings and not on Zoom.
- Public comment could be done offline by sending a letter or contacting the Chair. This seems like it would cause more problems by allowing public comment.
- Is there a limit to the comments; there could be 25+ people that want to comment. This could end up being a very long meeting.
- It is very interesting and helpful for the public to have a voice during a public meeting. The Chair would be able to disallow any derogatory or judgmental comments about a firm. The Chair must moderate the public comments.
- It is important to recognize that a Board or Committee need not have any comment on any public comment nor does a Board or Committee need to answer any question that is raised by any public comment.
- For the first trial of public comments we will put 15 mins with one minute per person on the agenda and revisit again and make sure that it is productive.
- Will the comments be allowed before the review or after review of applications?
- There will be two test drives, one meeting to do before review and the other test to do after review (before vote). This will be tested at the meeting of the Westfield State University House Doctor reviews.

### **Farewell to Virginia Greiman**

The Board thanked Ginny for the many years that she has served as a public member to the DSB. Ginny was presented with a citation from the Governor and a donation was made in her name to the New England Center Home for Veterans. ## **Board Business: February 3, 2021**

### **Public Comments**

There were no public comments at this meeting. Through Autocene, Bill will reach out to the registered firms for their interest in the public comment opportunity.

### **Informational Interview Discussion**

The Board agreed to begin scheduling informational interview when the agenda permits. The Board agreed to place these interviews at the beginning of future DSB meetings with one project deliberation. These interviews will be 25-minutes (15-minute presentation with 10-minute Q&A).



## **Sub-committee Updates**

Autocene subcommittee has not met for several weeks. The one remaining item for Board discussion is the “team lead” category, whether it should be the individual responsible for the application or the responsible licensed professional who signs the contract and is responsible for the project. Elise proposed to change “team lead” to “team contact” so that entry will no longer require a licensed professional but would identify the person to be contacted regarding questions for the application. The Board agreed to this proposal and Autocene will make a change from “Team Lead” to “Team Contact” in the application.

The Evaluation, Analytics and Project Criteria subcommittee held its last meeting on September 22, 2020. Alan suggested this subcommittee meet to brainstorm ideas of analytics that could be developed leveraging the Autocene database and come back to the full Board with some ideas. It will be important for the Autocene group to figure out how to automate what is proposed. The successful application elements for use as an evaluation criteria. David would like to see a better description of work anticipated in the RFP, especially in “House Doctor” projects; this is a way to have more smaller firms involved. A subcommittee meeting will be scheduled to discuss these items.

## **Voting in Autocene**

The Board will not be submitting their votes into Autocene. The members will continue with the roll call vote and Claire and Roberto will record the vote into the Autocene portal.

The Board unanimously agreed that firms would be disqualified if they are missing mandated statutory requirements listed in Chapter 7C Section 48, such as meeting MA Ownership Requirements and not being Massachusetts registered in the disciplines when required for a project. If a firm is missing information that is not statutorily mandated the Board will discuss the issues and each member will consider that information when voting.
