


Massachusetts Fires by Year

Structure Fires by Year




Structure fires have declined by more than 14% over the past 10 years.



Fire Deaths by Year



- 40 fatal fires killed 46 civilians 27 men and 19 women.
- There were no child fire deaths in either 2020 or 2021.
- No firefighters died in fire-related incidents.
- Fifty-two percent (52%) of fatal fire victims were older adults (over 65).
- Fire deaths increased by 5% from the 44 in 2020.
- Eighty percent (80%) of the civilian fire victims died in their homes.
- In 2021, smoking fires were the leading cause of residential fire deaths; smoking fires caused 10, or 29% of home fire deaths.
- One civilian died in an explosion.
