



## **February 2021 Precipitation**











### Feb 2021 and Dec-Feb Percent of Normal










#### Accumulated Precipitation (in): Departure from 1981-2010 Normals








### Precipitation Forecast Through 8 am Wed 3/17




- Minimal chances for rain through early Wed morning


