February 2021 Precipitation

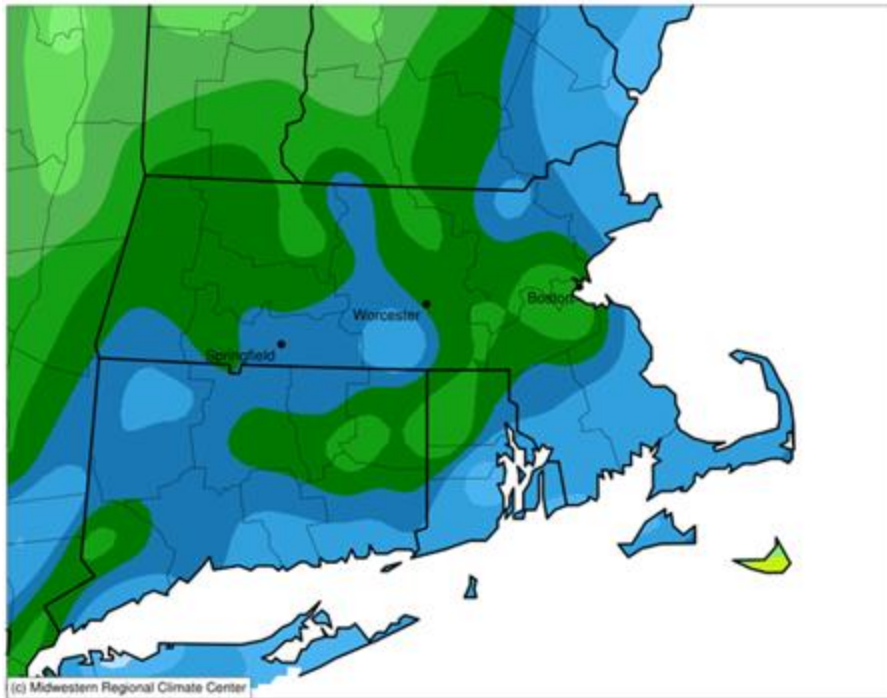


Feb 2021 and Dec-Feb Percent of Normal



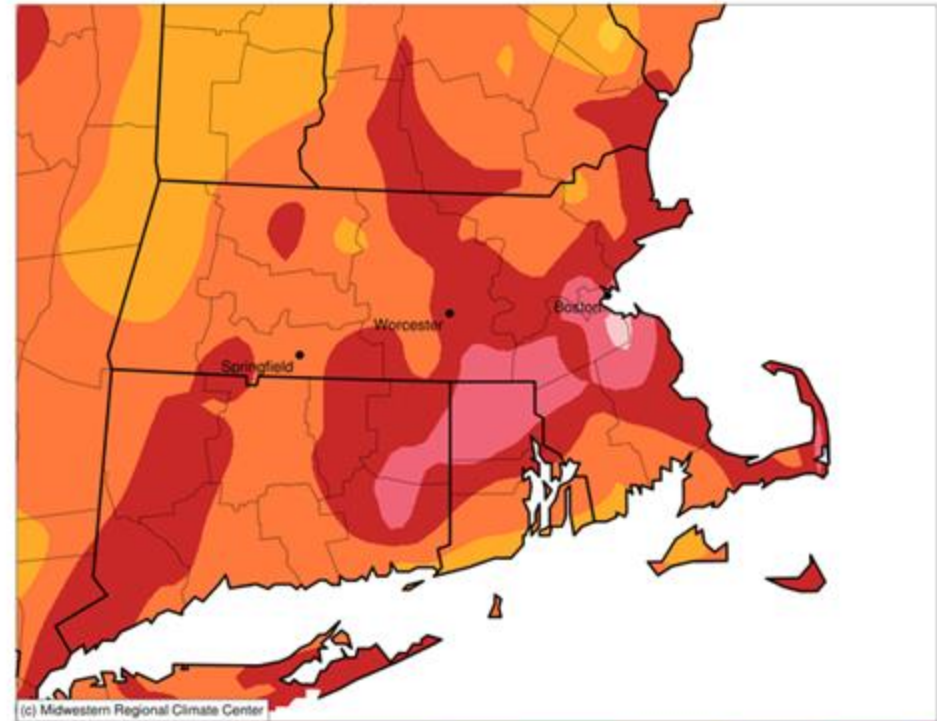
March Month-To-Date Precipitation

March 01, 2021 to March 10, 2021



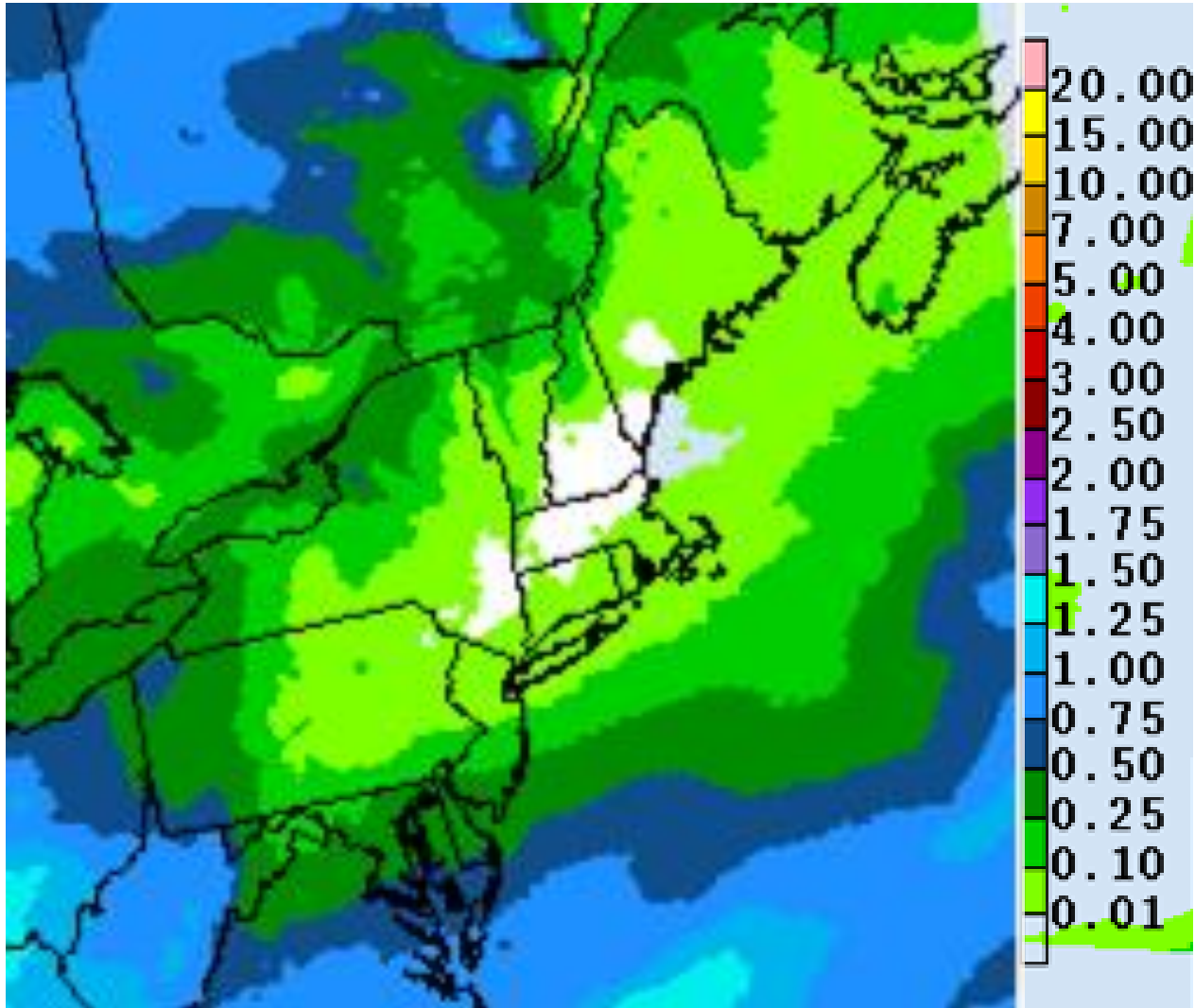

March 01, 2021 to March 10, 2021



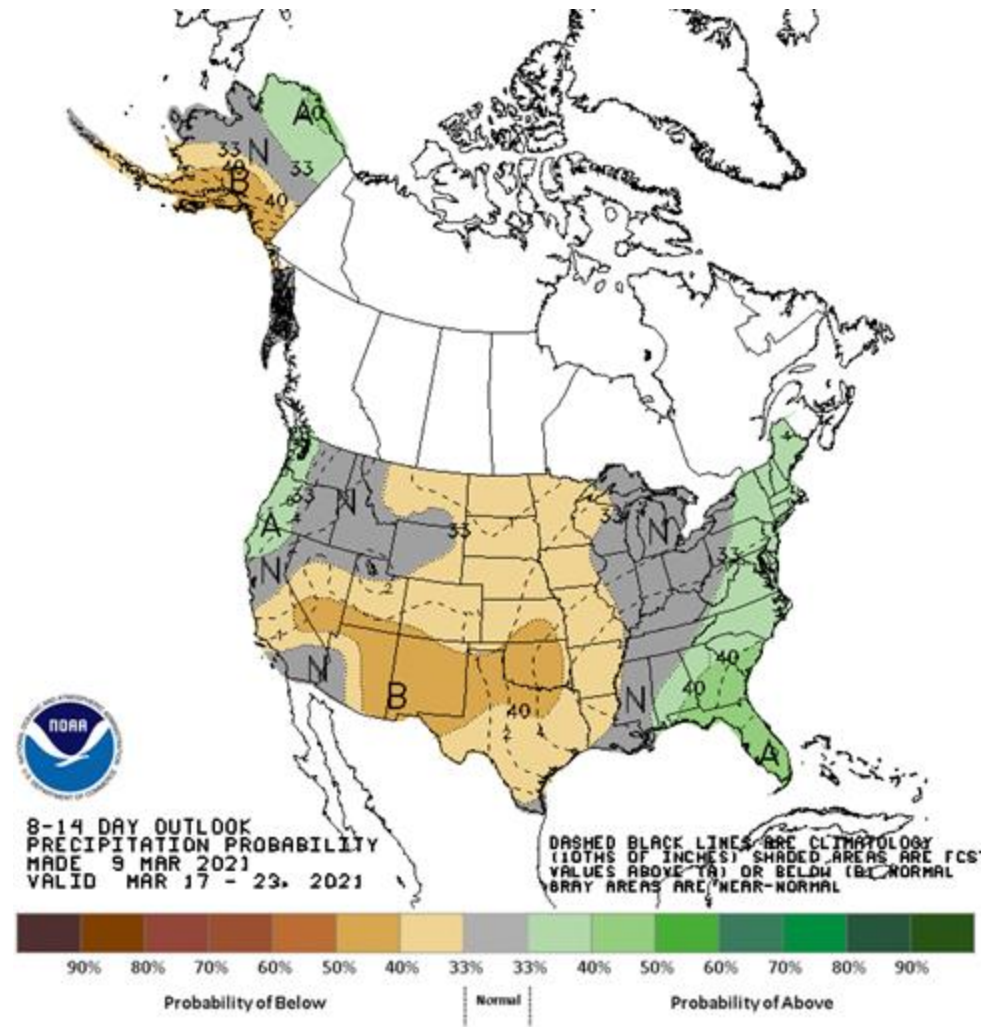
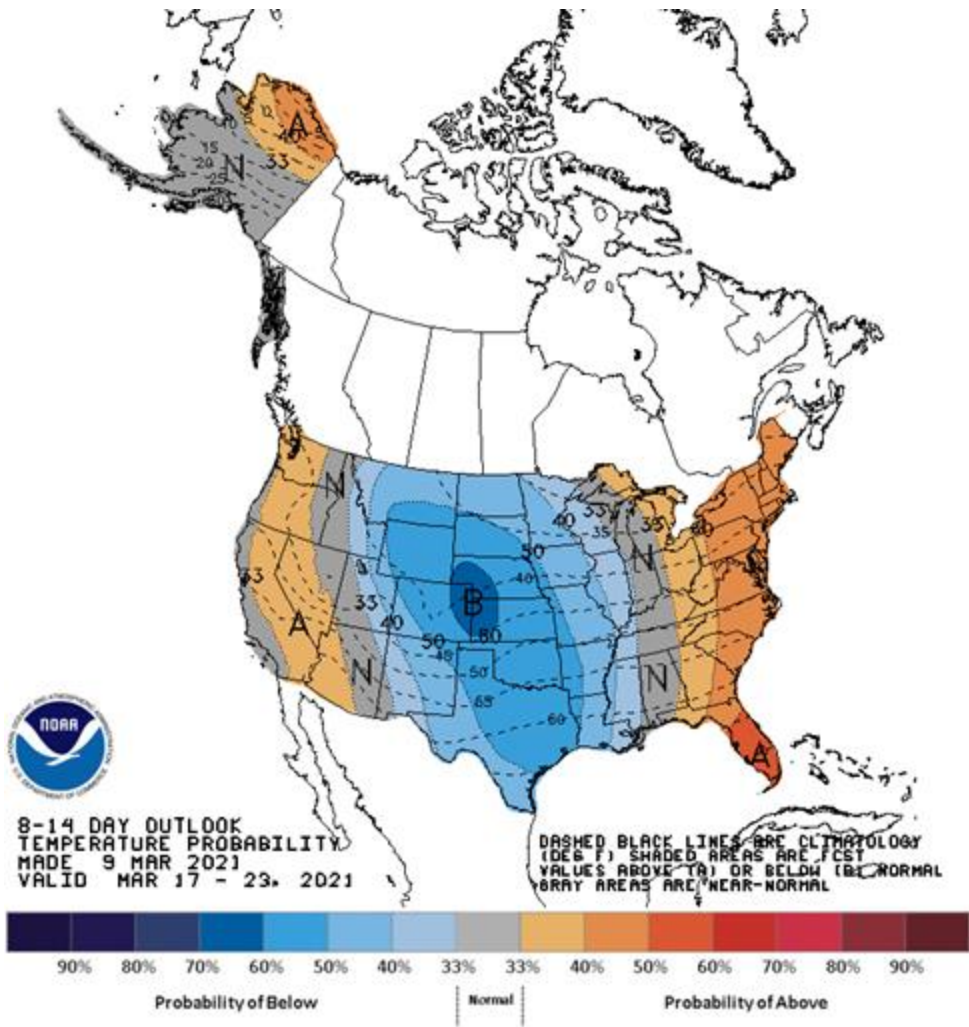

Precipitation Forecast Through 8 am Wed 3/17

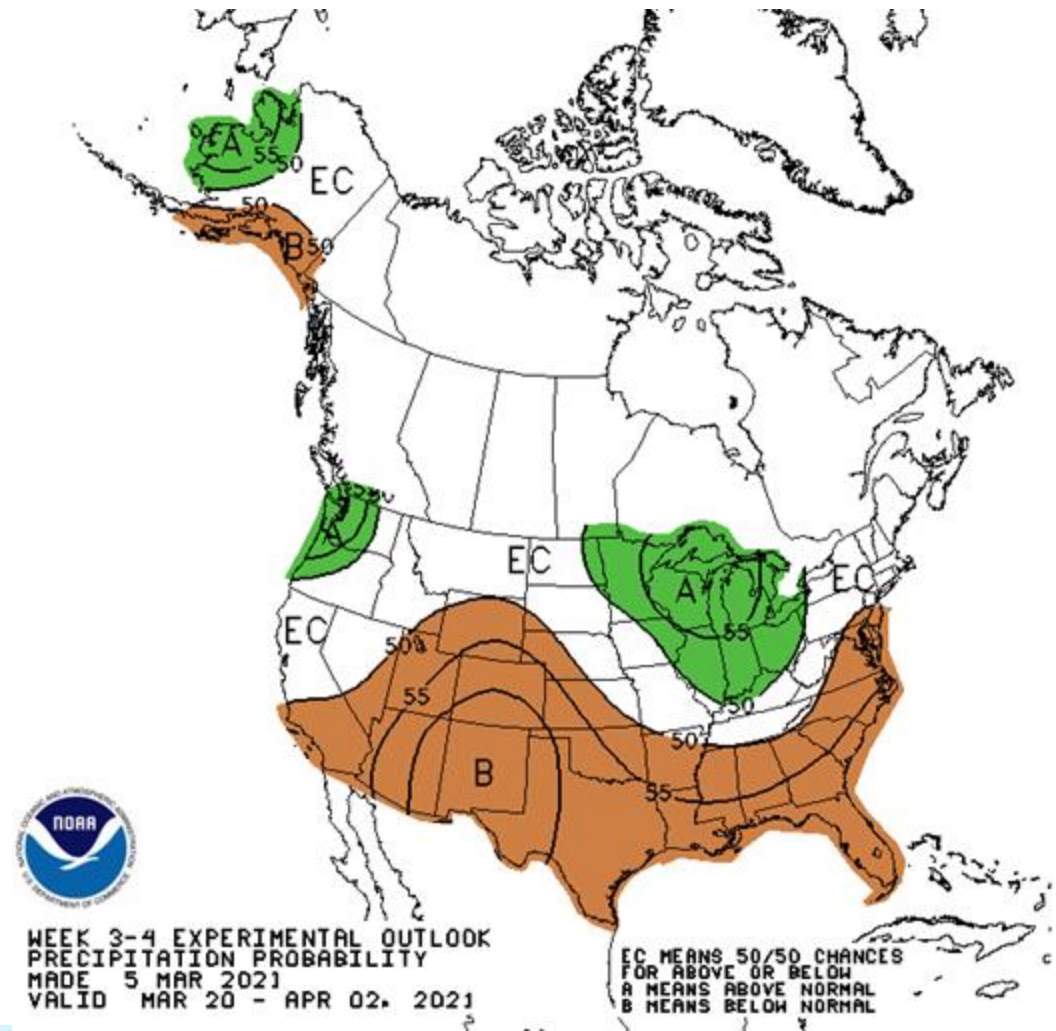
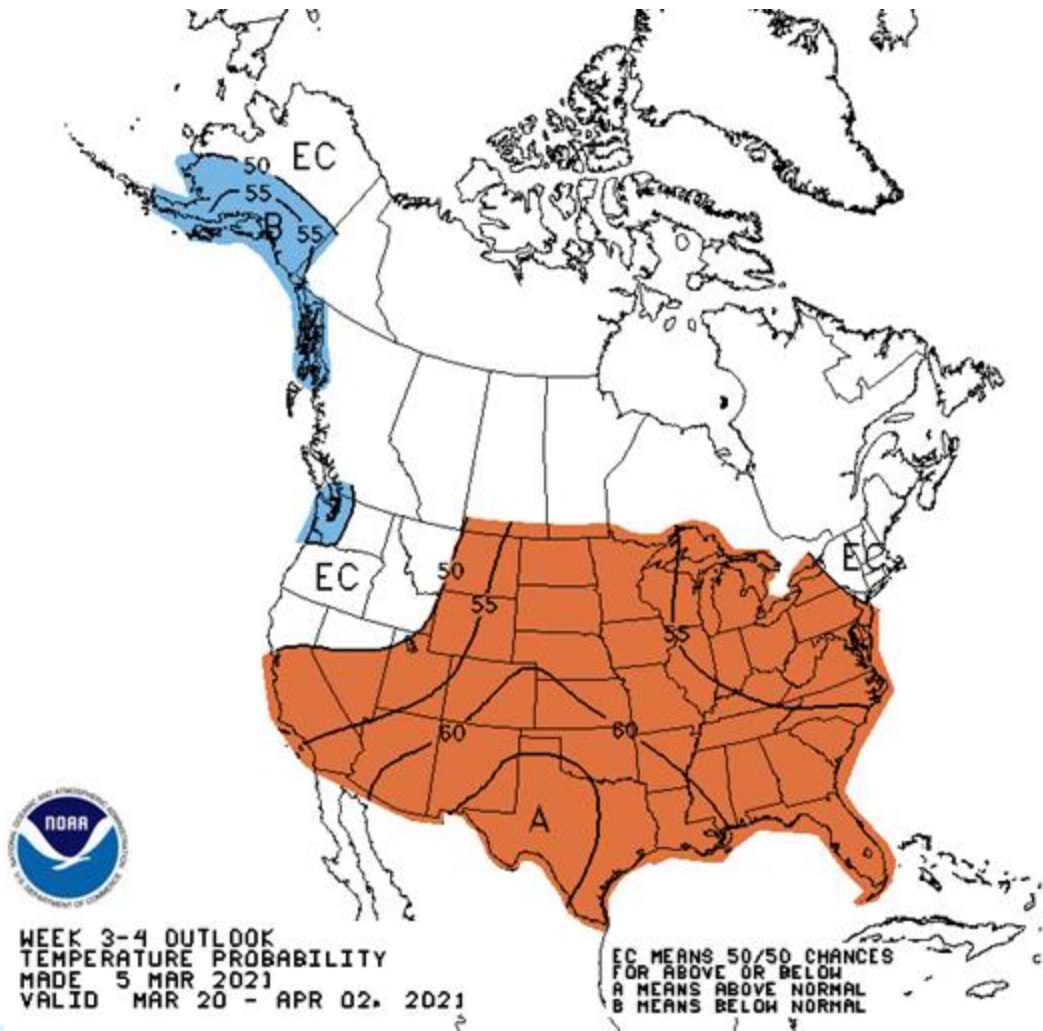


- Minimal chances for rain through early Wed morning
