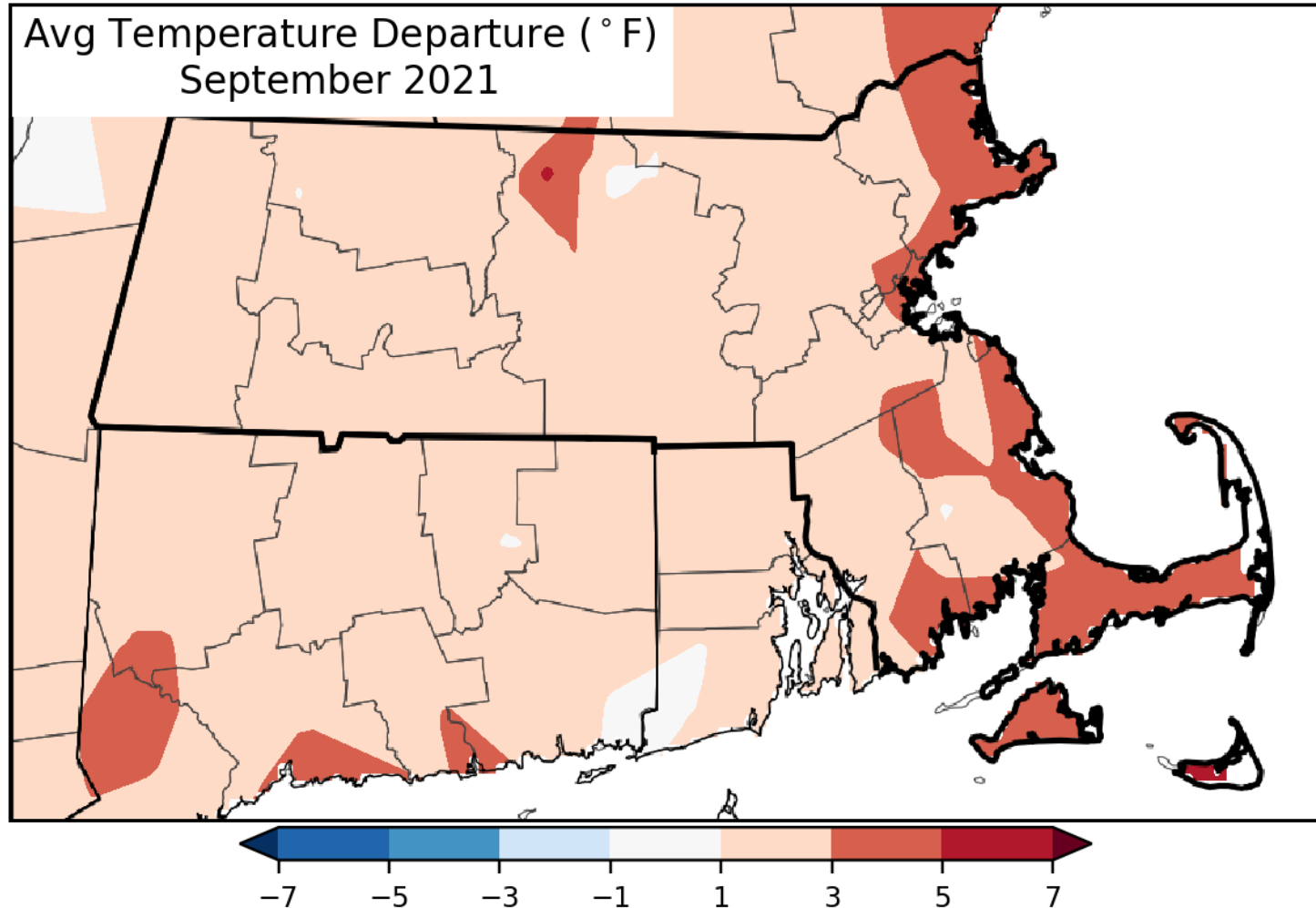
# September 2021 Precipitation



# Cape Cod and the Islands: CoCoRaHS Rainfall

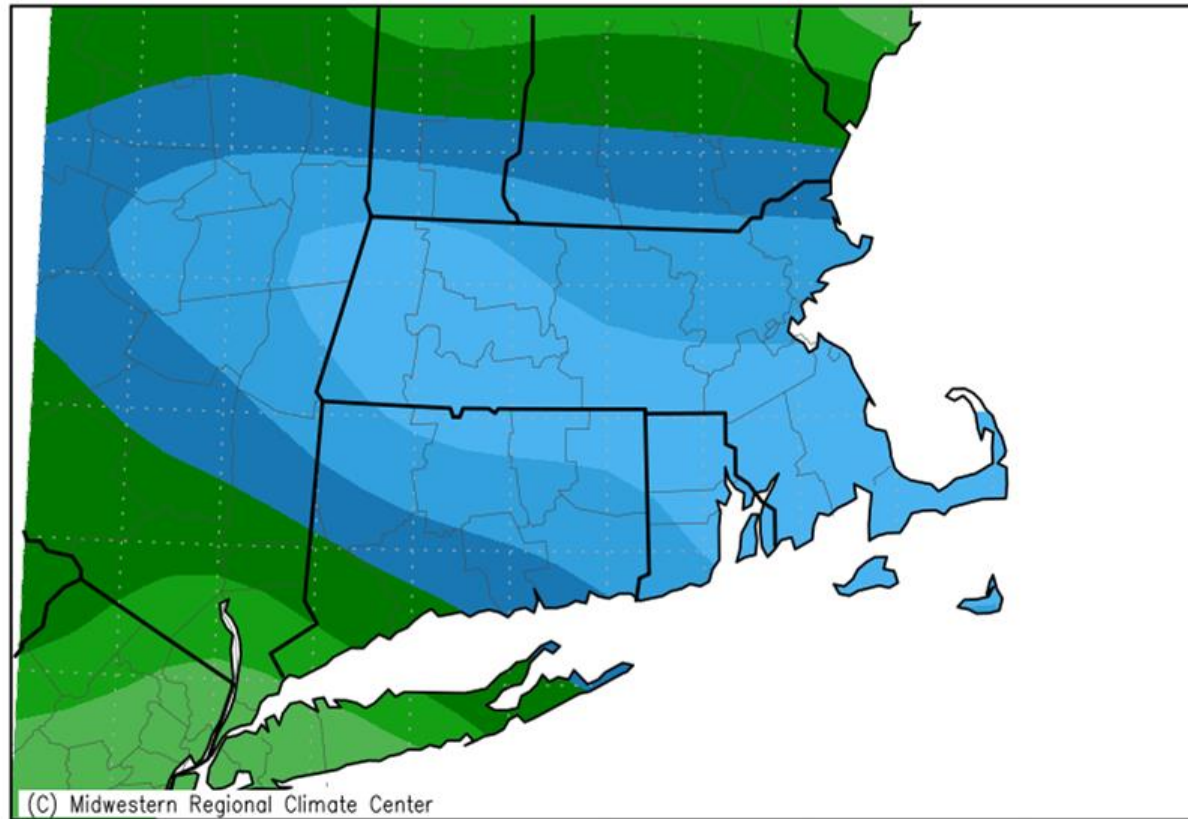


# Temperature Departure from Normal

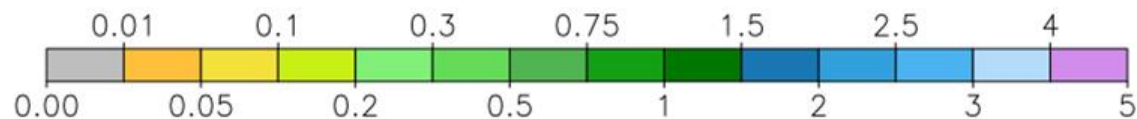


# October Month-to-Date Rainfall (Oct 1-5)

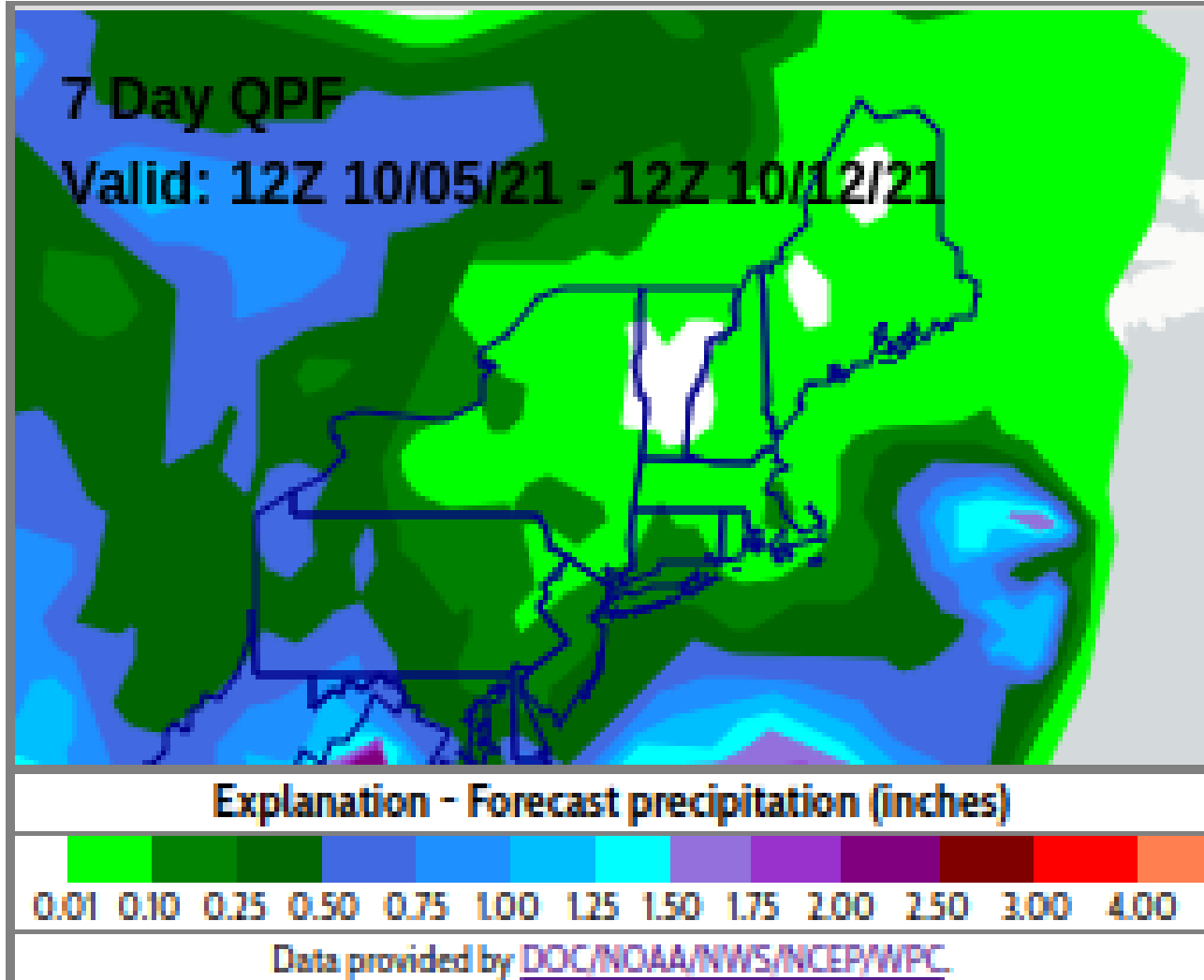
Accumulated Precipitation (in)

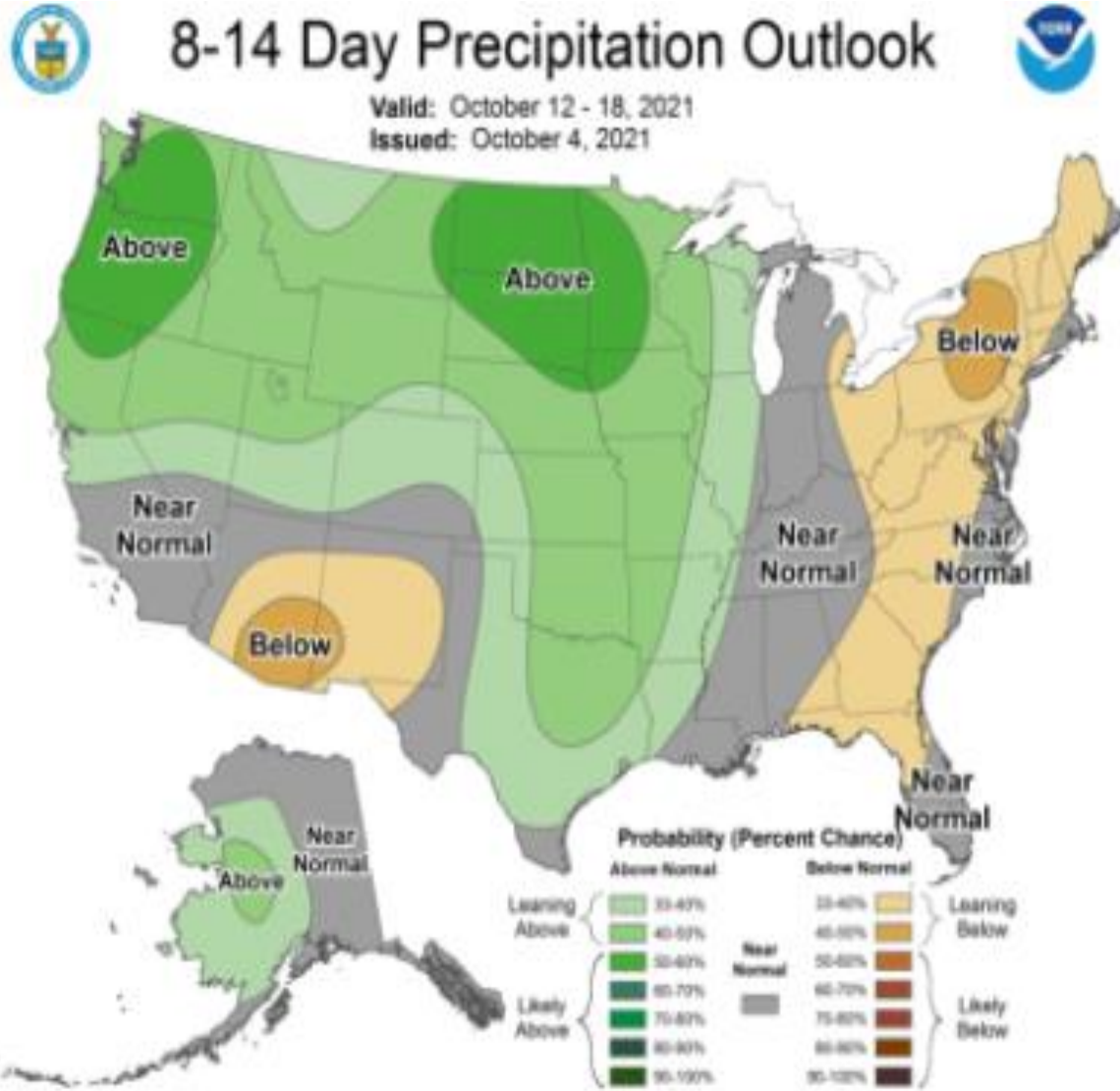
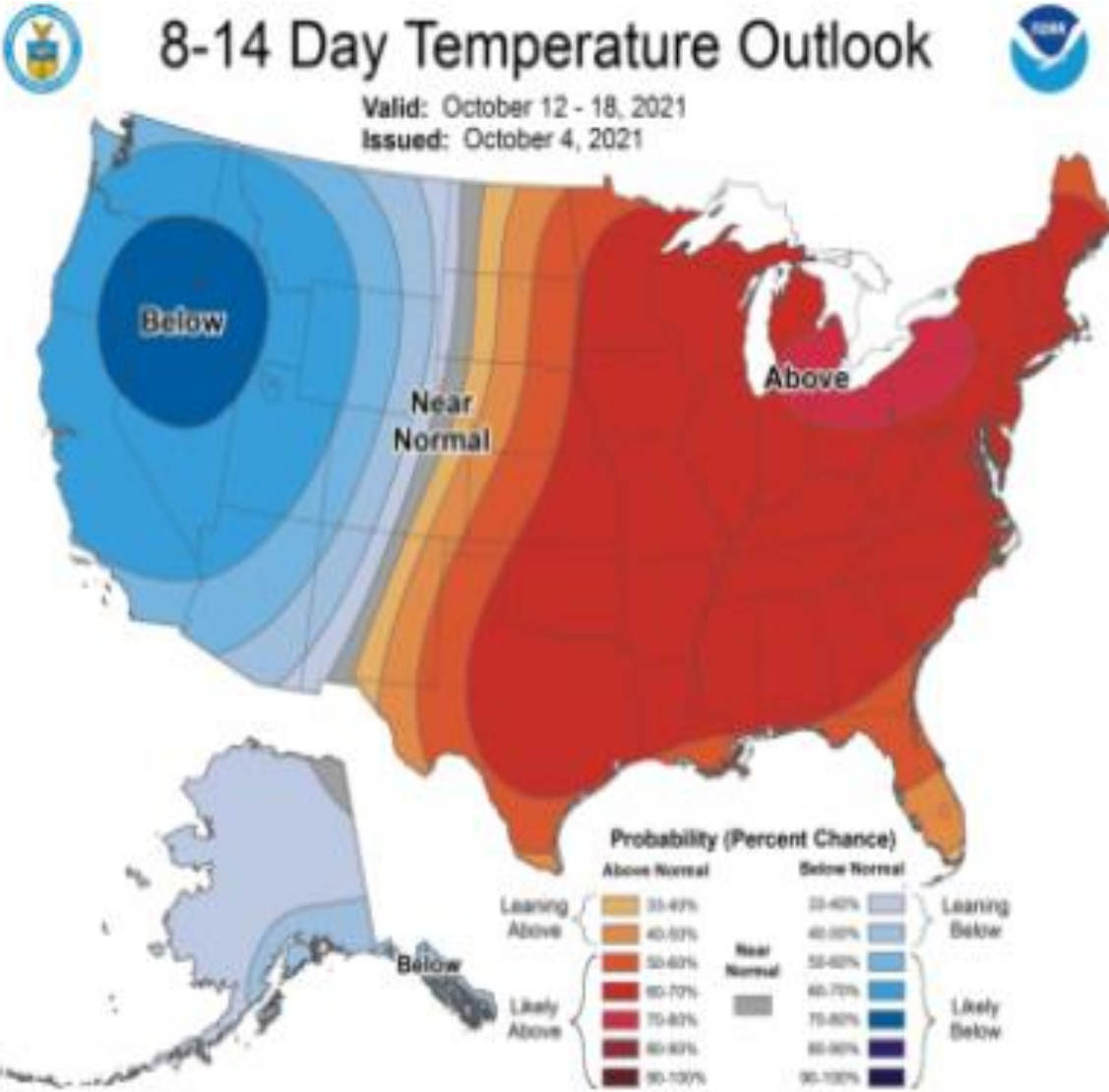


# Precipitation Forecast Through 8 AM Tue 10/12



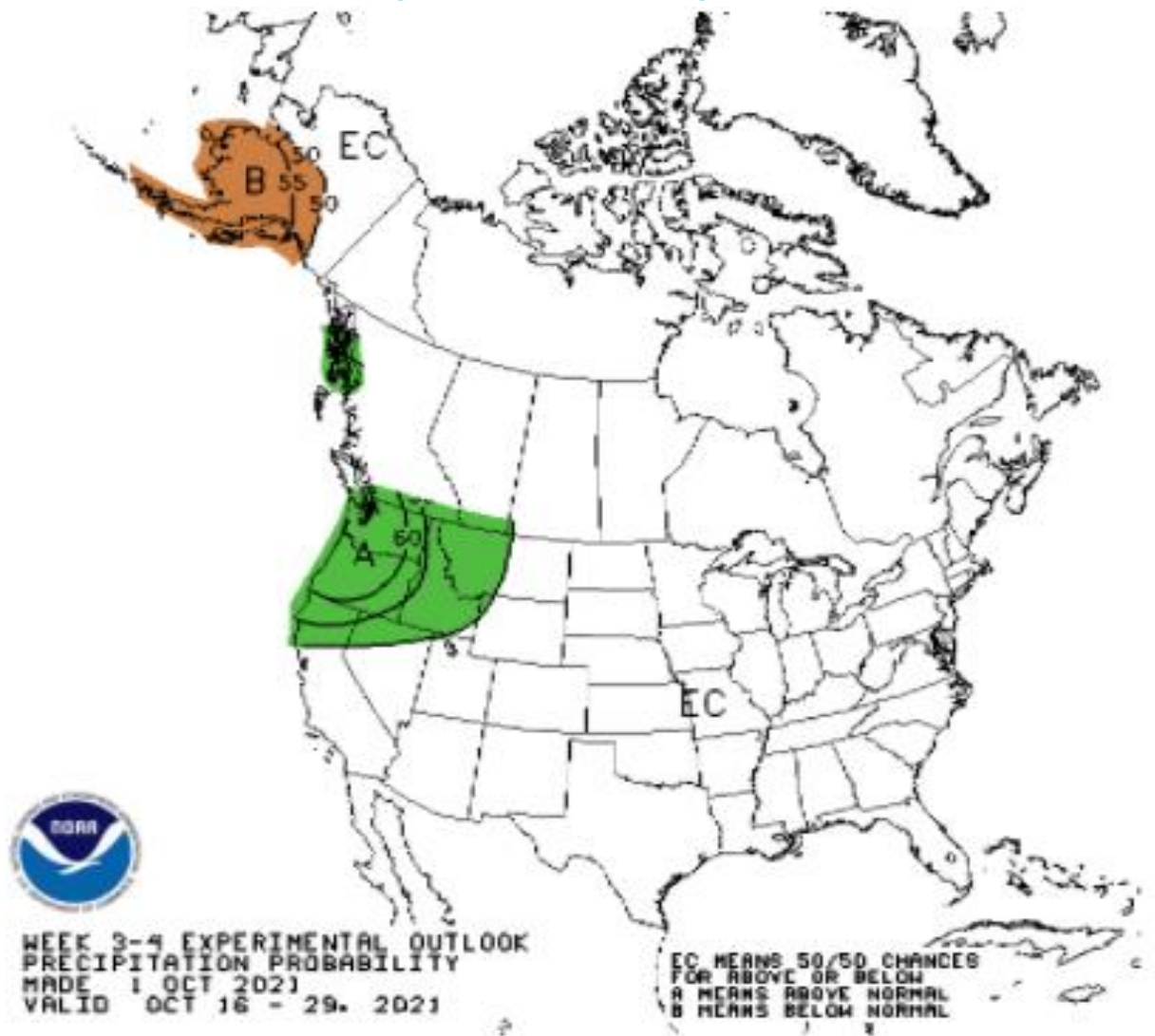
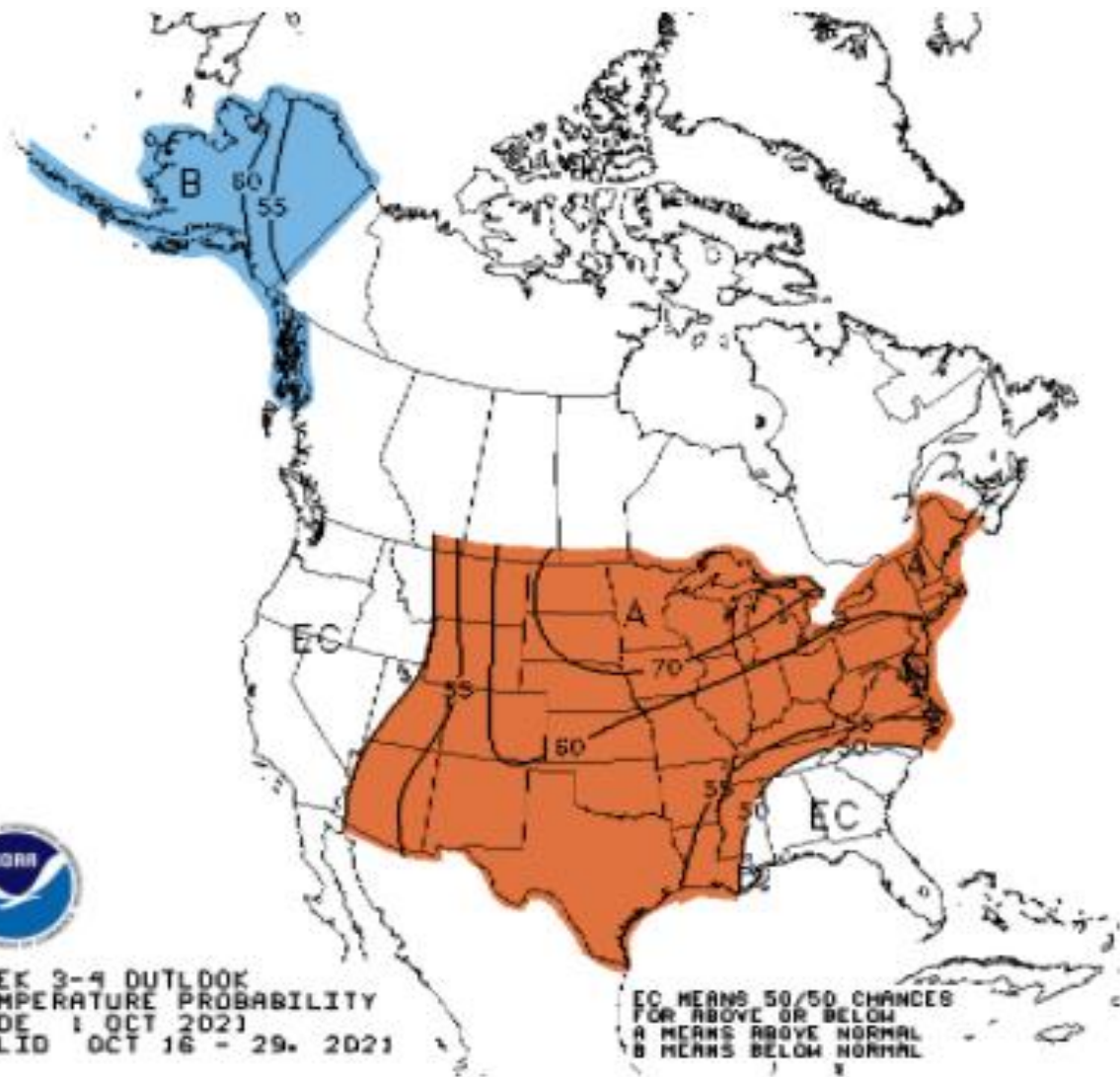
- Dry and quiet weather for the rest of the week.

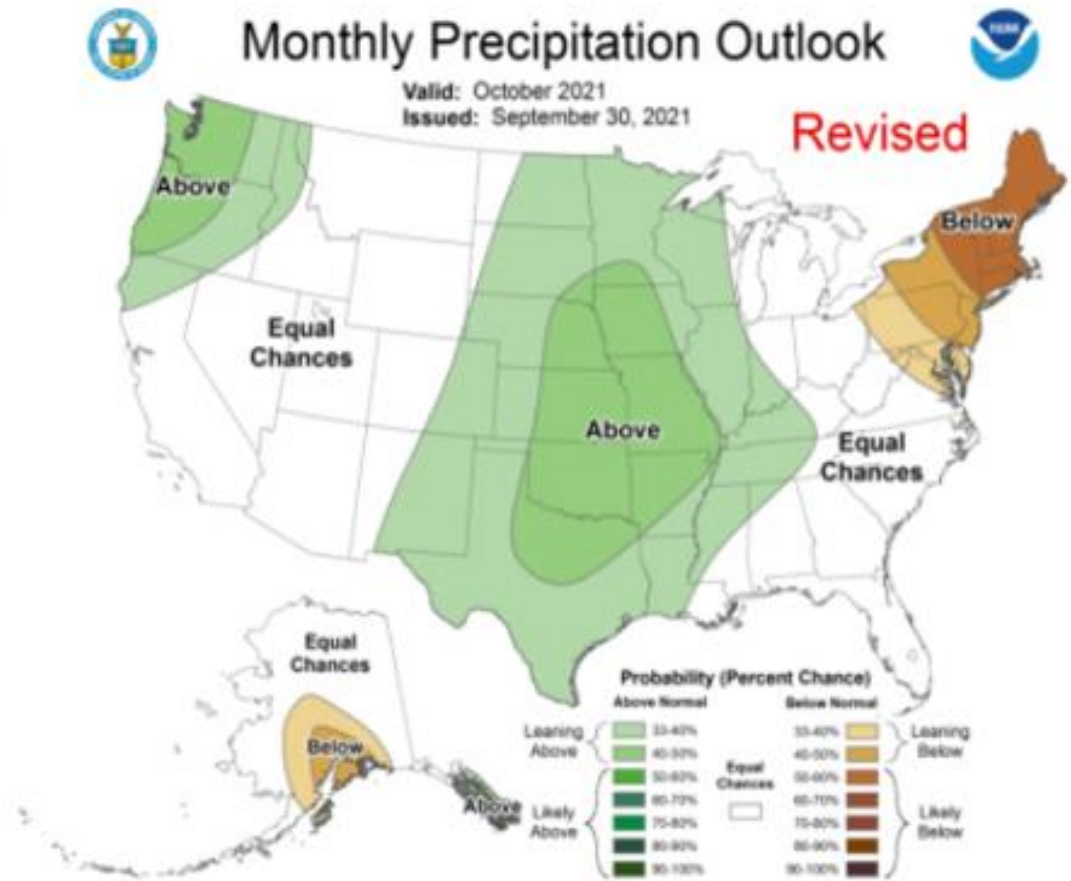
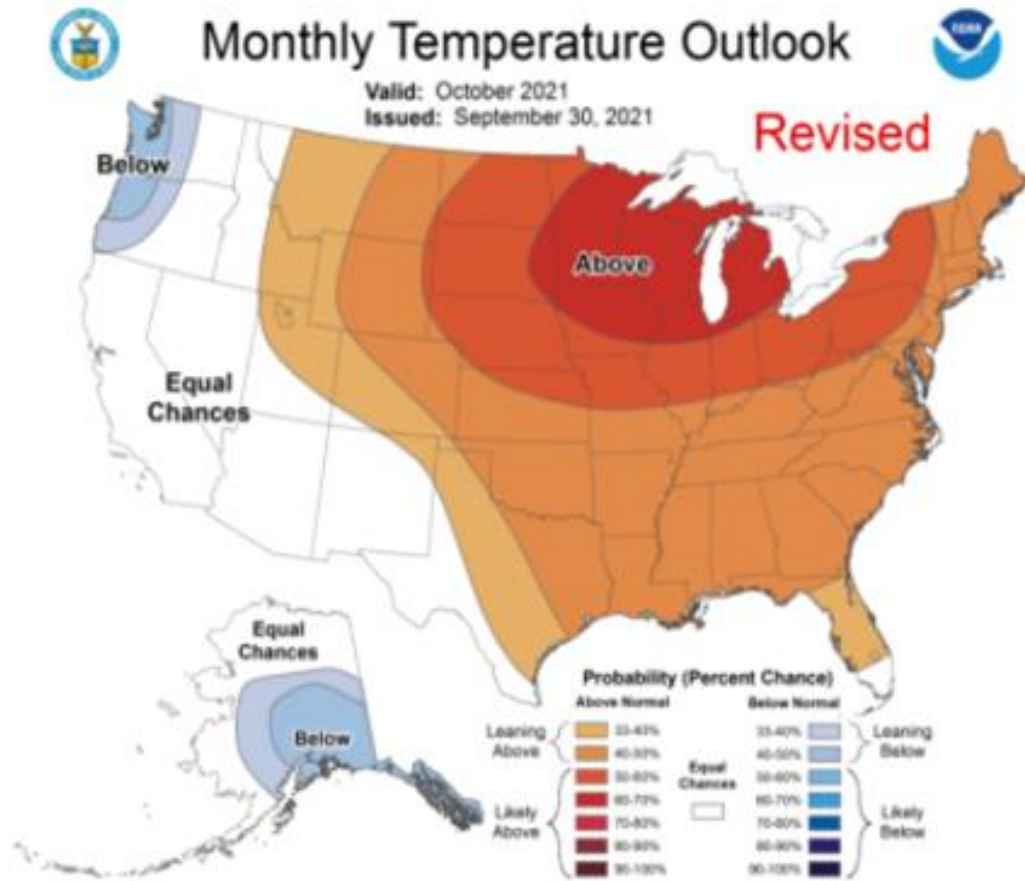

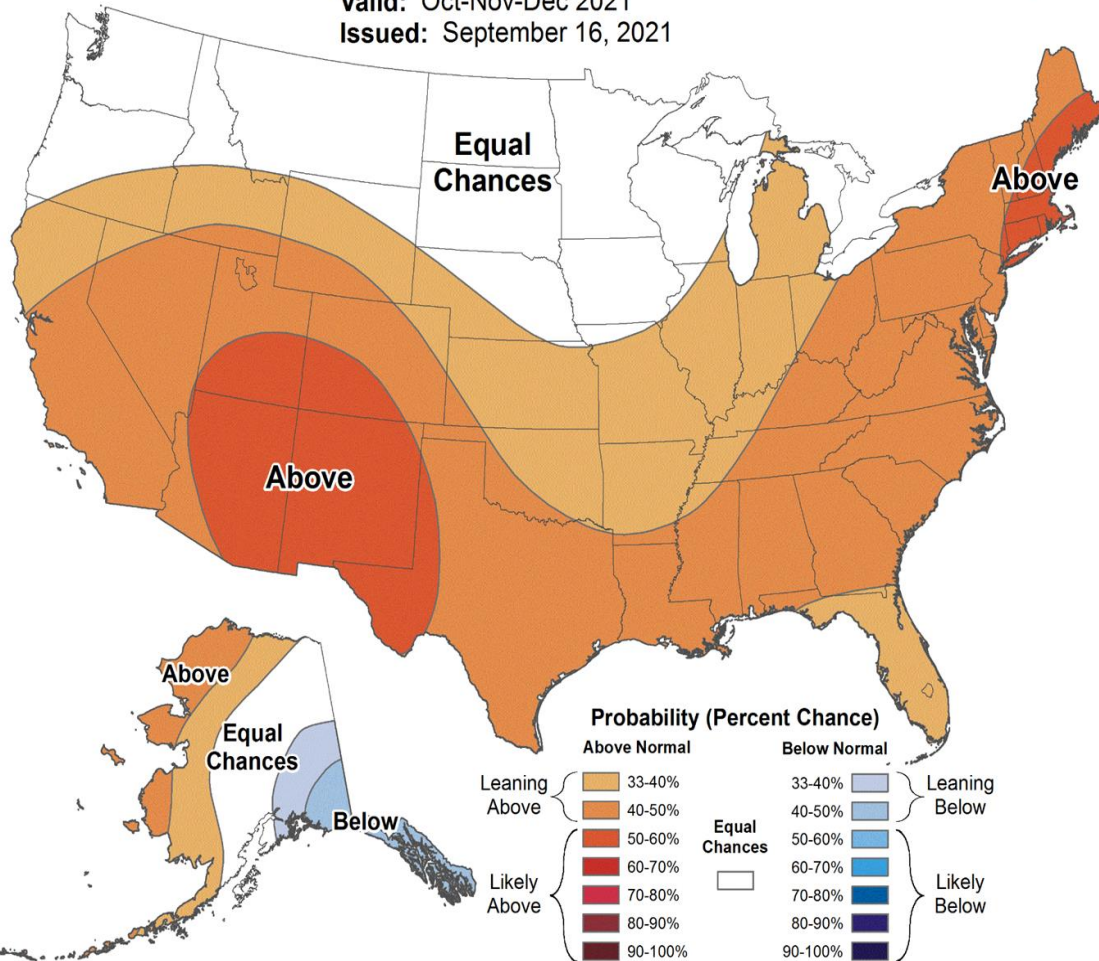
