- Data is for occurrent deaths only; Massachusetts residents who died out-of-state are excluded from this analysis.
- Rates are crude rates and were not calculated on counts of less than six and where population data is unavailable. Rates based on counts less than 20 may be unstable.
- Population data used to calculate rates are based on 2020 population estimates (as a proxy for 2022) generated by the UMass Donahue Institute and the U.S. Census Bureau American Community Survey 2018-2022 five year estimates.
- Percents may not add to 100 due to rounding.
- ¹ Total violent deaths include 5 legal intervention deaths and 1 unintentional firearm death that are not included in the table.
- ² Undetermined manner is defined as evidence indicating one manner of death is no more compelling than the evidence indicating another manner of death
- ³ Sex is collected on the death certificate as male, female, unknown. There were no victims with "unknown" sex in the examined time period.
