<u>Instructions</u>: To participate in the 2023 Period II Summer Flounder Pilot Program that allows trawlers to possess and land consecutive days trip limits, you must actively maintain this trip-level catch logbook. A completed copy of your logbook for the 2023 season must be returned to DMF by November 15, 2023, at 5 PM or within 15-business days following September 30, 2023 or the close of the 2023 commercial summer flounder season, whichever occurs sooner.
