## **Notice of Data Breach**

Dear Valued Resident:

The City of Columbus (the "City") was the victim of a cybersecurity incident that may affect the security of your personal information. This letter will provide you with information about the incident, steps we are taking in response, and steps you may take to guard against identity theft and fraud, should you feel it is appropriate to do so.

What Happened? On July 18, 2024, the City discovered that it had experienced a cybersecurity incident in which a foreign cyber threat actor (the "TA") attempted to disrupt the City's IT infrastructure in a possible effort to deploy ransomware, and solicit a ransom payment from the City (the "Incident"). The City's continuing investigation of the Incident determined that the TA gained unauthorized access to the City's technology infrastructure, allowing the TA to access certain personal information. The Incident was discovered expeditiously, cyber security experts were retained, and security measures were implemented to contain the Incident. Despite these efforts, data purported to have been obtained from the City was posted on the dark web.

What Information Was Involved? The information involved in the Incident may have included your personal information, such as your first and last name, date of birth, address, bank account information, driver's license(s), Social Security number, and other identifying information concerning you and/or your interactions with the City. To date, the City is unaware of any actual or attempted misuse of your personal information for identity theft or fraud as a result of this Incident.

What Are We Doing? As soon as we learned of this situation, the City's Department of Technology quickly identified the threat and took action to block unauthorized users from accessing the City's systems and launched an investigation. The City engaged cyber security experts to investigate and resolve the Incident. The City is also working with law enforcement to bring those behind this Incident to justice. The City's investigation of the Incident is ongoing. The City is working with cyber security experts to implement measures to prevent unauthorized access to the City's IT systems in the future.

What Actions You Can Take? As always, we recommend that you be on the alert for suspicious activity related to your financial accounts and credit reports. We encourage you to regularly monitor your statements and records to ensure there are no transactions or other activities that you did not initiate or authorize. You should report any suspicious activity to the appropriate service provider. If you observe unusual activity on any debit/credit card, or you believe your personal bank account shows signs of compromise, we advise you to close out those accounts and request new cards and account credentials.



Additionally, you should report incidents of suspected identity theft to your local law enforcement, the Federal Trade Commission (the "FTC"), and your state attorney general. To file a complaint with the FTC, go to IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-ID-THEFT (1 (877) 438-4338). Complaints filed with the FTC will be added to the FTC's Identity Theft Data Clearinghouse, which is a database made available to law enforcement agencies. Information on how to contact your state attorney general can be found in Appendix A to this letter.

Please take advantage of additional free resources on identity theft. We recommend that you review the tips provided by the FTC's Consumer Information website, a valuable resource with helpful tips on how to protect your information. Additionally, under the Fair Credit Reporting Act, you have the right to know what is in your file and receive notification if information in your file has been used against you in applying for credit or other transactions. In addition, all consumers are entitled to one free disclosure every 12 months upon request from each nationwide credit bureau and from nationwide specialty consumer reporting agencies. If you are a resident of the State of Massachusetts, please be aware that under Massachusetts law, you have the right to obtain any police report filed in regard to this incident. If you are the victim of identity theft, you also have the right to file a police report and obtain a copy of it.

## Placing a Security Freeze

Any consumer may place a free security freeze on his or her credit report by: (i) requesting one in writing by certified mail to the consumer reporting agency, (ii) calling the agency directly, or (iii) submitting a form online directly to the agency. A security freeze prohibits a credit reporting agency from releasing any information from a consumer's credit report without written authorization. However, please be aware that placing a security freeze on your credit report may delay, interfere with, or prevent the timely approval of any requests you make for new loans, credit, mortgages, employment, housing or other services. We recommend that you work collaboratively with potential lenders, employers and service providers to ensure that you are protecting both your information and the approval status of your applicable request.

In order to place a security freeze on your credit reports, you must contact each of the three major consumer reporting agencies: Equifax (www.equifax.com); Experian (www.experian.com); and TransUnion (www.transunion.com), at the addresses below:

The credit reporting agencies have a certain number of days after receiving your request to place a security freeze on your credit report, so we recommend placing the freeze as soon as you possibly can. The credit bureaus must also send written confirmation to you, and may provide you with a unique personal identification number (PIN) or password, or both, that can be used by you to authorize the removal or lifting of the security freeze.

# Lifting or Suspending a Security Freeze

To temporarily lift or suspend the security freeze, you must call, make a request online, or send a request via electronic media to the credit reporting agencies and include proper identification (name, address, and social security number) and the PIN number (if provided) or password provided to you when you placed the security freeze. Please note, your state may not allow this action to be completed. You should always check your state's laws on credit freezing before placing a freeze on your credit report.

# Removing a Security Freeze

To remove the security freeze, you can either submit the request online, or send a written request to each of the three credit bureaus by mail, secure electronic method, or via their online form, and include proper identification (name, address, and social security number) and the PIN number (if provided) or password provided to you when you placed the security freeze.

# **Credit Monitoring**

Although we do not have any evidence that your personal information has been misused for identity theft or fraud, out of an abundance of caution, the City is providing Experian IdentityWorks<sup>SM</sup> credit monitoring services for **24 months** at no cost to you.

If you believe there was fraudulent use of your information as a result of this Incident, and would like to discuss how you may be able to resolve those issues, please reach out to an Experian agent. If, after discussing your situation with an agent, it is determined that identity restoration support is needed then an Experian Identity Restoration agent is available to work with you to investigate and resolve each incident of fraud that occurred from the date of the Incident (including, as appropriate, helping you with contacting credit grantors to dispute charges and close accounts; assisting you in placing a freeze on your credit file with the three major credit bureaus; and assisting you with contacting government agencies to help restore your identity to its proper condition).

Please note that Identity Restoration is available to you for **24 months** from the date of this letter and does not require any action on your part at this time. The Terms and Conditions for this offer are located at www.ExperianIDWorks.com/restoration.
