

JUDICIAL YOUTH CORPS PAID SUMMER INTERNSHIP 2024

Description

The **Judicial Youth Corps (JYC)**, sponsored by the **Supreme Judicial Court of Massachusetts**, is an educational summer internship that teaches students about the Massachusetts court system and rule of law. Students work four days a week in one of the **Suffolk County courts** and spend one full day in law related educational sessions. Interns are taught and mentored by judges, lawyers, clerks, probation officers, and other court personnel who volunteer their time in educational sessions or as work supervisors. Students also can opt to participate in a mock trial in federal court in August.

Summer Session: Monday July 8 – Friday August 16, 2024

- Students will work in a courthouse four days a week, Monday through Thursday, with educational sessions on Fridays.
- Wage: \$15.00/hour, 25 hours/week
- Optional: students may choose to work an additional week, August 19th to August 23rd



Student Requirements

- **Must** be either a **Boston Public School student** or a **resident of Boston**
- Students in grades 10, 11, and 12 are eligible to apply
- Must be in good academic standing and have a good attendance record
- Students must have a social security number to work in the court system
- Must be available to work during the program dates for the Summer session
