

NOTICE OF DATA BREACH

To whom it may concern:

We are writing to inform you of a data breach that has occurred at COSTADELSOL ENTERPRISES, LLC, a Florida limited liability company, doing business as CBI INTERNATIONAL (“CDS”), that may have involved your personal information. We take the privacy and security of your information seriously, and we want to provide you with details about the breach, the actions we have taken, and the steps you can take to protect yourself.

What Happened?

On Wednesday, January 22, CDS suffered a cyberattack that may have compromised the integrity and security of its data and applications. As a containment measure, the servers were shut down to prevent the spread of the attack and the possible total encryption of CDS's information. This incident occurred despite having adequate security tools and controls, as the attackers managed to breach the security perimeter through a VPN. The hackers accessed CDS's physical servers located in Miami. A third-party specializing in forensic analysis was engaged to examine the affected servers. Until the forensic report is obtained, the full extent of the attack cannot be confirmed.

What Information Was Involved?

The following categories of personal information may have been compromised:

- Social Security Numbers
- Bank Account Numbers
- Taxpayer Identification Numbers
- Email Addresses
- Physical Addresses

What We Are Doing

We have taken the following steps to restore the security and confidentiality of the affected information:

- Isolated affected systems to prevent further unauthorized access.
- Notified law enforcement and regulatory authorities as required.
- Activated the company's IT Disaster Recovery Plan.
- Engaged forensic specialists to conduct a comprehensive investigation to determine the extent of the data compromise.
- Implemented enhanced security measures, including software patches, firewall updates, and Multi-Factor Authentication for remote access.
- Updated employee login credentials.
- Began work on infrastructure improvements to ensure a stable post-attack environment.

What You Can Do

To help protect your personal information, we recommend taking the following steps immediately:

- Change your passwords for all online accounts, especially if you use the same password across multiple sites.
- Monitor your financial statements and report any suspicious activity to your bank or credit card provider.
- Obtain a free credit report from the three major credit bureaus (contact details below).
- Report any suspected identity theft to your local law enforcement agency and the Federal Trade Commission (FTC).
- Remain vigilant and review account statements and credit reports regularly for any unauthorized activity.

The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) recommends that you place a free fraud alert on your credit file. A fraud alert tells creditors to contact you before they open any new accounts or change your existing accounts. Contact any one of the three major credit bureaus. As soon as one credit bureau confirms your fraud alert, the others are notified to place fraud alerts. The initial fraud alert stays on your credit report for one year. You can renew it after one year.

Ask each credit bureau to send you a free credit report after it places a fraud alert on your file. Review your credit reports for accounts and inquiries you don't recognize. These can be signs of identity theft. If your personal information has been misused, visit the FTC's site at IdentityTheft.gov to report the identity theft and get recovery steps. Even if you do not find any suspicious activity on your initial credit reports, the FTC recommends that you check your credit reports periodically so you can spot problems and address them quickly.

You may also want to consider placing a free credit freeze. A credit freeze means potential creditors cannot get your credit report. That makes it less likely that an identity thief can open new accounts in your name. To place a freeze, contact each of the major credit bureaus. A freeze remains in place until you ask the credit bureau to temporarily lift it or remove it.
