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## 2025 Annual Return and Revenue Statement Filing Reminder Notice

Issued: February 27, 2026

The deadline for Massachusetts telecommunications service providers (“TSPs”) to file their calendar year 2025 Annual Return and Revenue Statement is **March 31, 2026**. All TSPs registered with the Massachusetts Department of Telecommunications and Cable (“Department”) **must file an Annual Return and Revenue Statement reporting their intrastate telecommunications operating revenues for the previous calendar year, ending December 31<sup>st</sup>**, pursuant to G.L. c. 159, § 32 and G.L. c. 166, § 11. TSPs failing to file by the March 31<sup>st</sup> deadline may be subject to per diem statutory forfeitures and other enforcement action including, but not limited to, cancellation of the company’s authority to provide telecommunications services in the state. *See* G.L. c. 166, § 12.

All TSPs other than Independent Payphone Providers (“IPPs”) (e.g., laundromats, variety stores) must complete the multi-page form entitled *Annual Return and Revenue Statement*. Incumbent carriers must also complete the four attachments to the multi-page form: (a) Statement of Income for Year, (b) Balance Sheet, (c) Analysis of Telephone Plant, and (d) Station and Grade of Service Data. IPPs must complete the one-page form entitled *IPP Revenue Statement*. **The Department will not accept inaccurate or incomplete filings; forms must be completed in their entirety.**

If a company has not generated intrastate revenues for the reporting period, the company is directed to file a *written statement* in lieu of an annual return or revenue statement and must include a signature of a company officer. The statement must include the reporting calendar year 2025, the company’s federal identification number, exact registered name, all doing business as (“DBA”) names, and principal address. If a company is no longer doing business in the state or has ceased operations, the company should also file a *Certificate of Withdrawal*. TSPs may file by emailing all required forms as an attachment to [dte.filing@mass.gov](mailto:dte.filing@mass.gov) or submit an original completed form to the address below. TSPs are required to **submit to the address below a \$5.00 filing fee check**, indicating the filing company’s name and made payable to the “Commonwealth of Massachusetts,” regardless of filing method.
