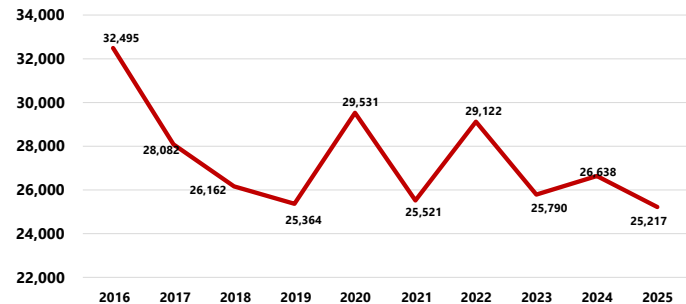

Overall Fires, 2016-2025



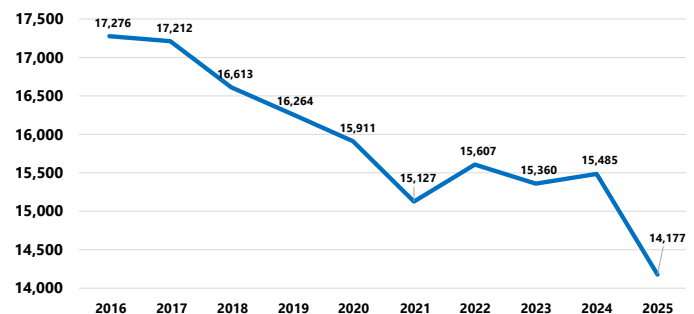

Structure Fires, 2016-2025



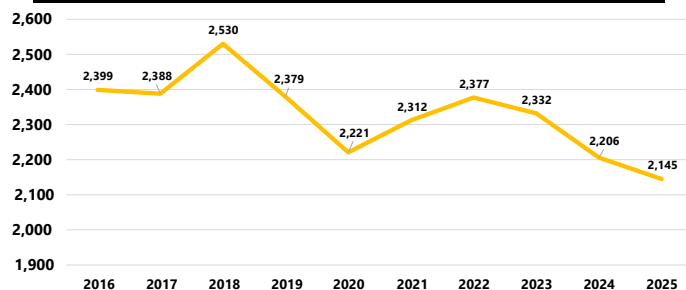

Vehicle Fires, 2016-2025



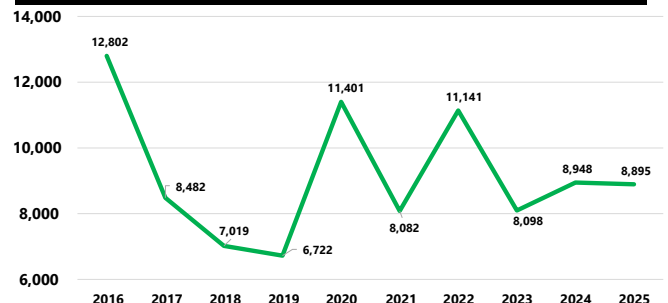

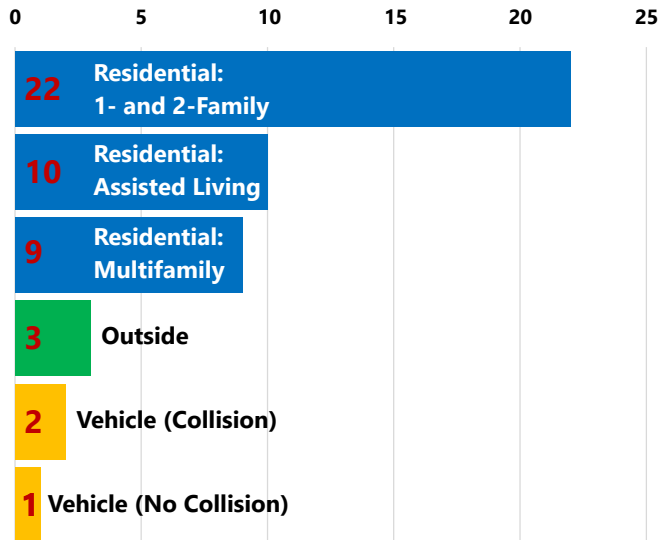




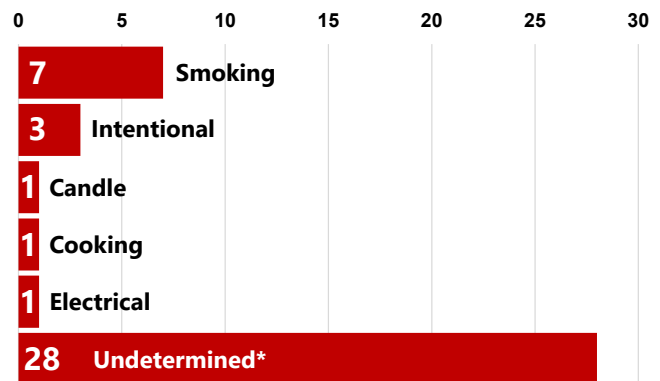
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2025 Fire Deaths by Property Use

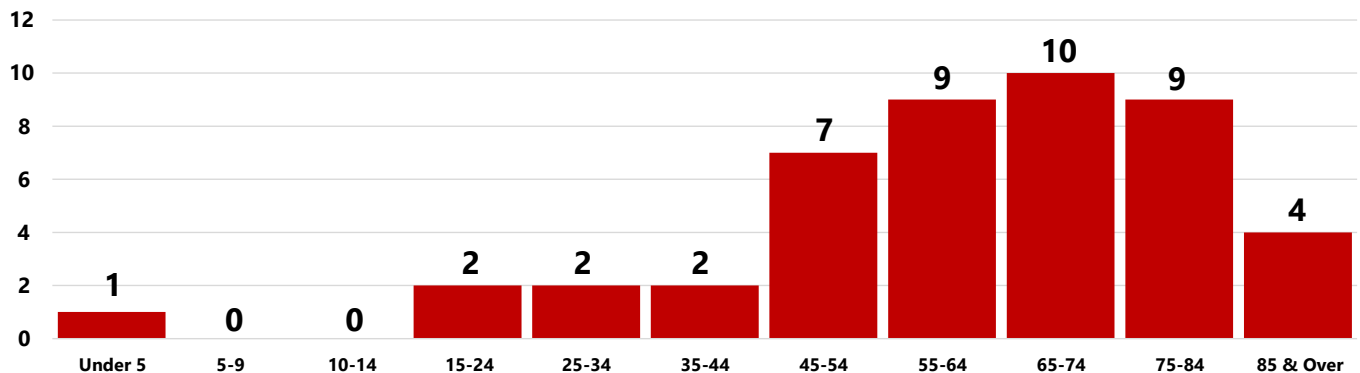


2025 Residential Fire Deaths by Cause

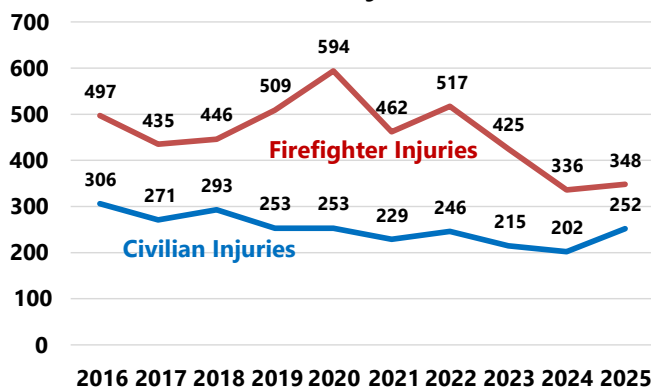
