By providing this notice, Life Choice Hospice of Southern Massachusetts, LLC dba Compassus – Southern Massachusetts (“Compassus – Southern Massachusetts”) does not waive any rights or defenses regarding the applicability of Massachusetts law, the applicability of the Massachusetts data event notification statute, or personal jurisdiction.

Nature of the Data Event

On November 13, 2025, Doctor Alliance, a third-party service provider to Compassus – Southern Massachusetts, became aware of an incident involving unauthorized access to certain documents available through the Doctor Alliance portal. This access extended from November 4 through November 17, 2025. On February 12, 2026, Doctor Alliance first notified Compassus – Southern Massachusetts of this event, its impact to patients, and continued to share information regarding the impacted individuals associated with Compassus – Southern Massachusetts until April 8, 2026. Since becoming aware of this event, Compassus – Southern Massachusetts has been working continuously to authenticate all impacted patient information received from Doctor Alliance, confirm impacted individuals’ address information, and prepare notice to impacted individuals.

Please note, this is a third-party event that wholly occurred at Doctor Alliance; this event did not involve any Compassus – Southern Massachusetts computer system or network.

The information that could have been subject to unauthorized access includes name, as well as Social Security number and medical information.

Notice to Massachusetts Residents

In compliance with HIPAA, on June 26, 2026, Compassus – Southern Massachusetts began providing written notice of this Doctor Alliance incident to approximately forty-five (45) Massachusetts residents. Written notice is being provided in substantially the same form as the letter attached here as *Exhibit A*.

Other Steps Taken and To Be Taken

Upon learning of the Doctor Alliance event, Compassus – Southern Massachusetts promptly took steps to further investigate the external event. As part of its ongoing commitment to the privacy of personal information in its care, Compassus – Southern Massachusetts is reviewing its existing policies and procedures and relating to information sharing with vendors.

Additionally, Compassus – Southern Massachusetts is providing impacted individuals with guidance on how to better protect against identity theft and fraud. Compassus – Southern Massachusetts is providing individuals with information on how to place a fraud alert and security freeze on one’s credit file, the contact details for the national consumer reporting agencies, information on how to obtain a free credit report, a reminder to remain vigilant for incidents of fraud and identity theft by reviewing account statements and monitoring free credit reports, and encouragement to contact the Federal Trade Commission, their state Attorney General, and law enforcement to report attempted or actual identity theft and fraud.

Compassus – Southern Massachusetts is providing written notice of this incident to relevant state regulators, as necessary. Compassus – Southern Massachusetts is also notifying the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services pursuant to the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA).

Please be advised that, pursuant to G.L. c. 93H § 3(b), Compassus – Southern Massachusetts maintains a written information security program (WISP) for the protection of personal information of residents of Massachusetts.
