We are writing to formally notify you of a security incident involving your personal information. We value your privacy and sincerely apologize for this error.

What Happened?

On 1/15/26, due to an administrative error, your Form W-2 was inadvertently sent to another employee of Promedical. We have since contacted that individual, who has confirmed in writing that the information has been deleted and was not further disseminated.

What Information Was Involved?

The document contained your name, address, Social Security number, and earnings information for the 2025 tax year.

What We Are Doing

To help protect your identity, we are offering you **24 months of credit monitoring services** at no cost to you through a provider of your choice. Please purchase your selected provider and plan and submit the cost to Promedical for reimbursement.

Steps You Can Take

Under Massachusetts law, you have the right to obtain any police report filed in regard to this incident. If you are the victim of identity theft, you also have the right to file a police report and obtain a copy of it.

You also have the right to place a **security freeze** on your credit report. A security freeze prohibits a credit reporting agency from releasing any information from a consumer's credit report without written authorization. Please be aware that placing a security freeze on your credit report may delay, interfere with, or prevent the timely approval of any requests you make for new loans, credit, mortgages, or other services.

There is **no fee** to place, lift, or remove a security freeze. To place a freeze, contact the three major credit bureaus:
