

# **EXHIBIT 1**

This notice will be supplemented with any new significant facts learned subsequent to its submission. By providing this notice, A&D does not waive any rights or defenses regarding the applicability of Massachusetts law, the applicability of the Massachusetts data event notification statute, or personal jurisdiction.

### **Nature of the Data Event**

A&D learned of suspicious activity on certain systems in its environment. In response, A&D immediately took steps to secure the network and initiated an investigation into the nature and scope of the event with the assistance of third-party computer forensic specialists. As a result of the investigation, A&D determined that their environment was subject to unauthorized access between November 24, 2024, and December 2, 2024 during which certain information was copied and taken. A&D then engaged a third party to conduct a comprehensive and time-consuming review of the information at risk in order to identify the type of information contained therein, and to whom the information relates. On January 29, 2026, the review was completed and identified that information pertaining to certain individuals was involved. Since then, A&D has been performing additional work to review and verify the affected information as well as locate address information in order to provide notice to affected individuals.

The information subject to unauthorized access for the Massachusetts resident includes name and Social Security number.

### **Notice to Massachusetts Resident**

On March 16, 2026, A&D provided written notice of this incident to one (1) Massachusetts resident. Written notice is being provided in substantially the same form as the letter attached here as *Exhibit A*.

### **Other Steps Taken and To Be Taken**

Upon discovering the event, A&D moved quickly to investigate and respond to the incident, assess the security of A&D systems, and identify potentially affected individuals. A&D is also working to implement additional safeguards and training to its employees. A&D is providing access to credit monitoring services for twenty-four (24) months, through Cyberscout, to individuals whose personal information was potentially affected by this incident, at no cost to these individuals.

Additionally, A&D is providing impacted individuals with guidance on how to better protect against identity theft and fraud. A&D is providing individuals with information on how to place a fraud alert and security freeze on one's credit file, the contact details for the national consumer reporting agencies, information on how to obtain a free credit report, a reminder to remain vigilant for incidents of fraud and identity theft by reviewing account statements and monitoring free credit reports, and encouragement to contact the Federal Trade Commission, their state Attorney General, and law enforcement to report attempted or actual identity theft and fraud. A&D is providing written notice of this incident to relevant regulators, as necessary.

Please be advised that, pursuant to G.L. c. 93H § 3(b), A&D maintains a written information security program (WISP) for the protection of personal information of residents of Massachusetts.
