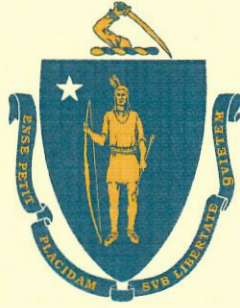


The Commonwealth of Massachusetts



A Proclamation

Whereas, Dig Safe System, Incorporated is a not-for-profit corporation, funded by its member utility companies, that protects the underground facilities of public utilities by collecting notices of digging from excavators, transmitting these notices to the utilities, and thereby enabling those utilities to locate and mark out their facilities prior to the excavation work; and

Whereas, Along with posing an overall threat to property, preventable damage to underground facilities, such as pipes, mains, cables and conduits, can cause injuries, fatalities, dangerous or costly leaks, fires and explosions; and

Whereas, By providing a toll-free number for the exchange of necessary information, the Dig Safe Center and its damage prevention program promote public safety, help avoid costly damage to underground utilities, and reduce the cost and time of notifications; and

Whereas, The "One-Call" system is a free service to contractors and homeowners that helps excavators comply with construction industry safety rules and regulations; and

Whereas, It is important that all Massachusetts residents are informed of safe digging practices and the toll-free number, 811,


Now, Therefore, I, Maura T. Healey, Governor of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, do hereby proclaim April 2026, to be,


SAFE DIGGING MONTH
