The state shall adapt the California Age Appropriate Design Code Bill (AB 2273) to protect youth online by design, improving privacy law as necessary. In addition, in public schools through higher education, the state shall require that online data collection be minimized to only that necessary, to prevent data loss and exploitation, including in data processing agreements and minimizing tech use where suitable or convenient. The state shall also remove the mandate in education standards and performance evaluations for public schools to use technology across curriculum from PreK up, and instead allow local school boards or relevant authority to decide with the local community how much screen time, what kind, and at what age with annual or biennial public hearings.
