

SUMMARY OF NO. 23-19

This proposed law would require a prospective voter to show his or her photo identification before being given a ballot at a polling place on Election Day. The photo identification would have to be issued by a branch of the United States Government, or by the state, or by a tribal authority recognized either by the United States or the state. Voters who do not present such identification would be permitted to vote if they execute an affidavit attesting to their identity, residence, and citizenship.

The proposed law would require a prospective voter who votes early by mail to include a copy of his or her photo identification in the inner envelope of his or her completed mail ballot package. Voters who do not present such identification would be permitted to vote if they execute an affidavit attesting to their identity, residence, and citizenship.
