An Initiative Petition for a Law Relative to the establishment of an Indigenous Peoples Day.

Be it enacted by the People, and by their authority:

SECTION 1: Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 12V and inserting in place thereof the following section:—

Section 12V. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the second Monday in October as Indigenous Peoples Day and recommending that it be observed by the people, with appropriate exercises in the schools and otherwise, to celebrate the different indigenous peoples and cultures originating from all throughout the Americas, as well as their sovereign tribal nations.
