INITIATIVE PETITION FOR A LAW

Be it enacted by the People, and by their authority:

An Act to eliminate legislative stipends

SECTION 1. Chapter 3 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 9B, as appearing in the 2022 Official Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following new section:-

SECTION 9B. No member of the senate or of the house of representatives shall receive any regular compensation in addition to the base compensation calculated pursuant to Article CXVIII of the Amendments to the Constitution.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January 6, 2027.
