

INITIATIVE PETITION FOR A LAW TO ALLOW LIFETIME DISQUALIFICATION WAIVER PROGRAM FOR CLASS D DRIVER'S LICENSE

Be it enacted by the People, and by their authority:

SECTION 1. Section 24 of chapter 90 of the Massachusetts General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph

For the implementation of a new lifetime disqualification waiver program. Persons who are currently subject to a lifetime suspension and/or disqualification or revocation for refusal to submit to a chemical or analysis of a person's breath or blood, convictions under Massachusetts general laws chapter 90 section 24, and other laws applicable, and/or multiple OUI convictions in Massachusetts and/or in other states, may be made eligible to end their lifetime disqualification/revocation and be made eligible for hardship licenses under mass state law if they have served no less than 10 yrs. Of their lifetime revocation/disqualification. The RMV may issue guidelines or promulgate regulations to administer this paragraph.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect as provided in Article 48 of the Amendments to the Massachusetts Constitution, as amended.

The undersigned qualified voters of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts have personally reviewed the final text of this initiative petition, fully subscribe to its contents, agree to be one of its original signers, and hereby submit this measure for approval by the people pursuant to Article 48 of the articles of amendment of the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, as amended by Article 74 of said articles of amendment.
