¹ Information reported by HMOs as of the end of the second quarter of 2009 based upon the Massachusetts Division of Insurance's "Guidelines for Reporting Membership & Utilization Statistics - Version 5.0" that instructs HMOs to exclude members for whom the HMO did not bear any financial risk. Beginning January 1, 2004, membership reflects those persons enrolled only in closed network plans; so-called "dual certificate option" plan (POS) members and insured preferred provider plan members are not included in this report.

² Includes all members enrolled in the HMO in which reimbursement is provided pursuant to Title XIX of the Federal Social Security Act as defined in the Massachusetts Division of Insurance's "Guidelines for Reporting Membership & Utilization Statistics - Version 5.0."

⁴ Under Massachusetts law, Boston Medical Center Health Plan, Inc. was not required to be licensed until 2008, even though the carrier may have had members prior to that time. The 4th quarter 2008 membership report includes Boston Medicare Center Health Plan, Inc. for the first time.
