Revised Notice of Public Hearings with Extension of Written Comment Period

This Notice was previously published in the *Massachusetts Register* by the Massachusetts Secretary of State on October 14, 2022. Through this revised Notice, MassDEP is providing an extension of the written comment period until 5 p.m. on November 18, 2022.

Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to M.G.L. c. 30A, the MA Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) is proposing to amend the Water Resources Management Program Regulations (310 CMR 36.00) promulgated under the Massachusetts Water Management Act (M.G.L. c. 21G). The proposed amendments would add a condition to Water Management Registrations restricting nonessential outdoor water use by registrants during times of drought declared by the Secretary of Energy and Environmental Affairs. This will better align water use with the 2019 Massachusetts Drought Management Plan, and will ensure adequate water for public health, safety and economic stability and promote a balance of water use and natural resource protection during drought.
