PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP), under the authority of M.G.L. c. 21N §§ 3(b) and 3(d), M.G.L. c. 111, §§ 2C and 142A through 142M, and M.G.L. c. 21A, §§ 2, 8 and 16, will hold a public hearing in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 30A on an emergency regulation that amended 310 CMR 60.06, *CO₂ Emission Limits for State Fleet Passenger Vehicles*, to re-promulgate carbon dioxide (CO₂) emission limits without modification for years starting in 2021. The limits are applicable to passenger vehicles owned or leased by the Commonwealth's Executive Offices. The emergency regulation went into effect on December 21, 2020. In accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 30A, MassDEP is providing a public comment period on the emergency regulation, which may be modified after public hearing and public comment.
