

May and June Commercial Horseshoe Crab Spawning Closures

To promote the conservation of horseshoe crabs, the Massachusetts Division of Marine Fisheries (*MarineFisheries*) will close the commercial horseshoe crab fishery to harvest during lunar spawning events in the months of May and June. These closures will occur over five day periods coinciding with each new and full moon. The closures begin at 12:00 AM two days prior to the new or full moon and are lifted at 11:59 PM two days after.
