2023 Horseshoe Crab Lunar Spawning Closure Dates

While the Division of Marine Fisheries is anticipating going out to public hearing this spring on a suite of measures affecting horseshoe crab management and conservation, the existing lunar spawning closures will remain in effect this spring. To promote the conservation of horseshoe crabs, the harvest of horseshoe crabs by any person—including all commercial fishers—is prohibited during five-day closures coinciding with each new and full moon occurring between April 16 and June 30. The closure periods begin at 12:00AM (midnight) two days prior to each new or full moon and end at 11:59PM two-days after each new or full moon. The exact closure dates for 2023 are captured in the calendar below. A full text copy of the regulations relevant to horseshoe crabs is available at 322 CMR 6.34.
