Notice is hereby given that the Department of Agricultural Resources, under its authority pursuant to M.G.L. c. 62, §§ 6(o)(1) through (4); M.G.L. c. 63, § 38Z; and M.G.L. c. 94, § 16A and in accordance with M.G.L. c. 30A, will hold a public hearing on amendment of 330 CMR 29.00. As required by Sections 31 and 32 of Chapter 154, Acts of 2018, the Department is proposing to increase the maximum total annual value of the tax credit to all eligible taxpayers from the current \$4 million to \$6 million.
