

To the Pooling Administrator,

AT&T requested three specific thousands-blocks in order to accommodate the needs of its customer, an Office Supply company. NeuStar denied AT&T's request because AT&T had not met the months-to-exhaust requirement. AT&T requested a waiver from the Department.

Based on confidential and proprietary information submitted to the Department as part of its waiver request, AT&T has demonstrated that it cannot accommodate its customer's request with its existing inventory, and has demonstrated that this inability does not result from AT&T having utilized its numbering resources in an imprudent manner.

Therefore, the Department directs NeuStar to assign AT&T three thousands-blocks in the Brockton rate center. The customer indicates that it can use any NPA-NXX, and requires blocks in the following ranges:

1000-1999; 5000-5999; and 8000-8999.
