Ladies & Gentlemen:

In accordance with Chapter 130, Section 74A of the Massachusetts General Laws, the Division of Marine Fisheries has determined that a portion of the East Branch of the Westport River shellfish growing area, Halfmoon Flat (BB4.21), no longer meets the established criteria for a status of "Open to Shellfishing" due to the transplant of contaminated quahogs from the Taunton River (Permit #186843). The status of this area will **be "Closed to Shellfishing" as of sunrise on Tuesday, April 22, 2025.** 

Therefore, the Division of Marine Fisheries has changed the status of the below defined area to "Closed to Shellfishing" to prohibit the taking of shellfish until subsequent determination by this office reveals that the shellfish are safe for human consumption.

Pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 130, Section 74A, 75, and 322 CMR 7.01 (7), digging, harvesting, or collecting and/or attempting to dig, harvest, collect or the possession of shellfish from the below defined area is prohibited.

## BB4.21 Halfmoon Flat

" The waters and flats of that portion of the East Branch southeast of a line drawn from the "NO SHELLFISHING" sign at the southern abutment of the Route 88 Bridge (41.51576°, -71.06698°) to the "NO SHELLFISHING" sign on the marsh at the eastern entrance to Horseneck Channel (41.51498°, -71.05469°)."
