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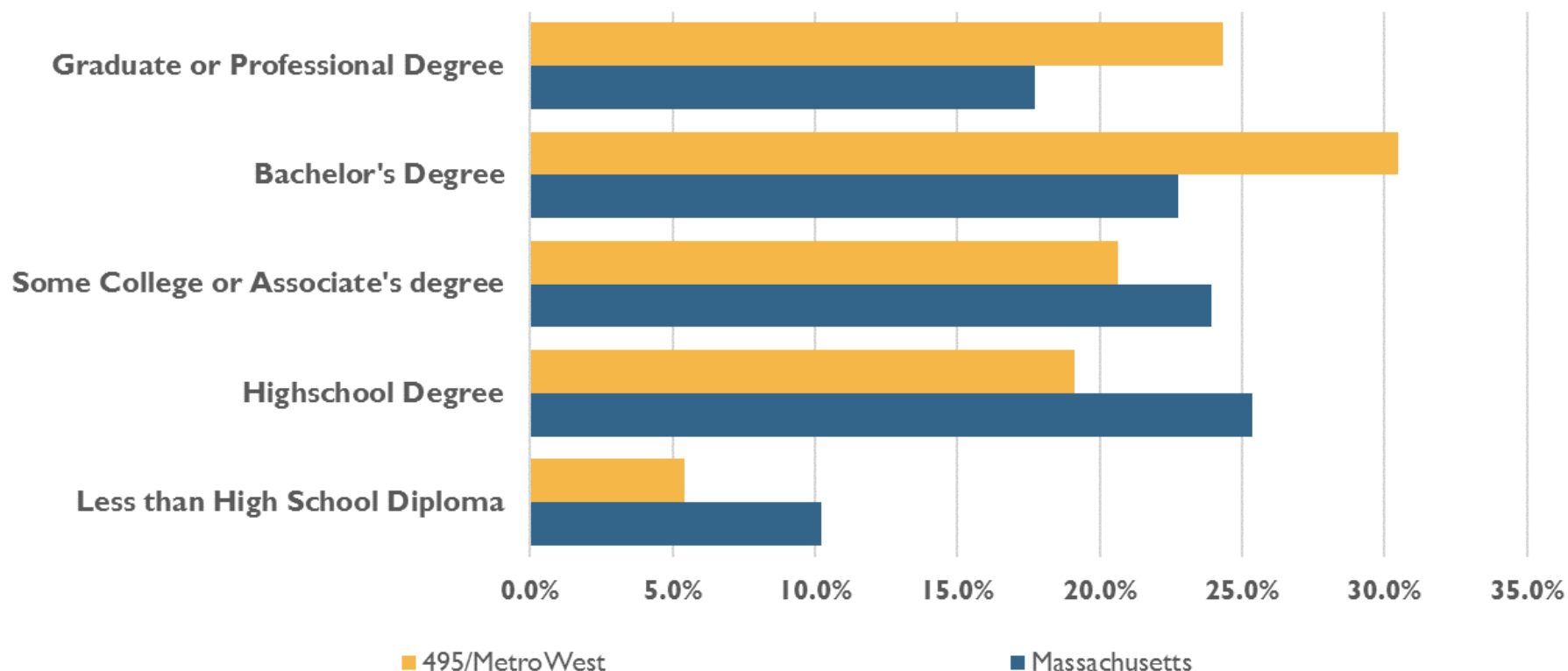
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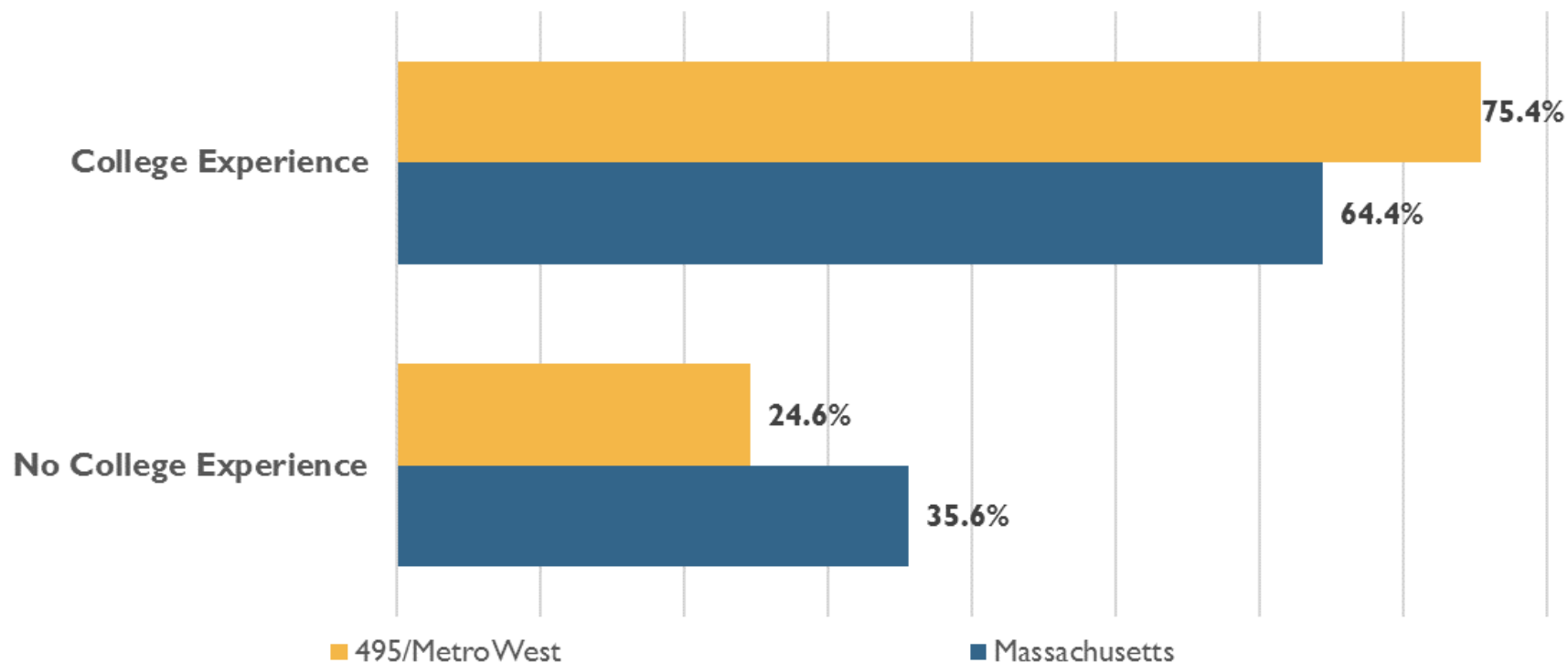

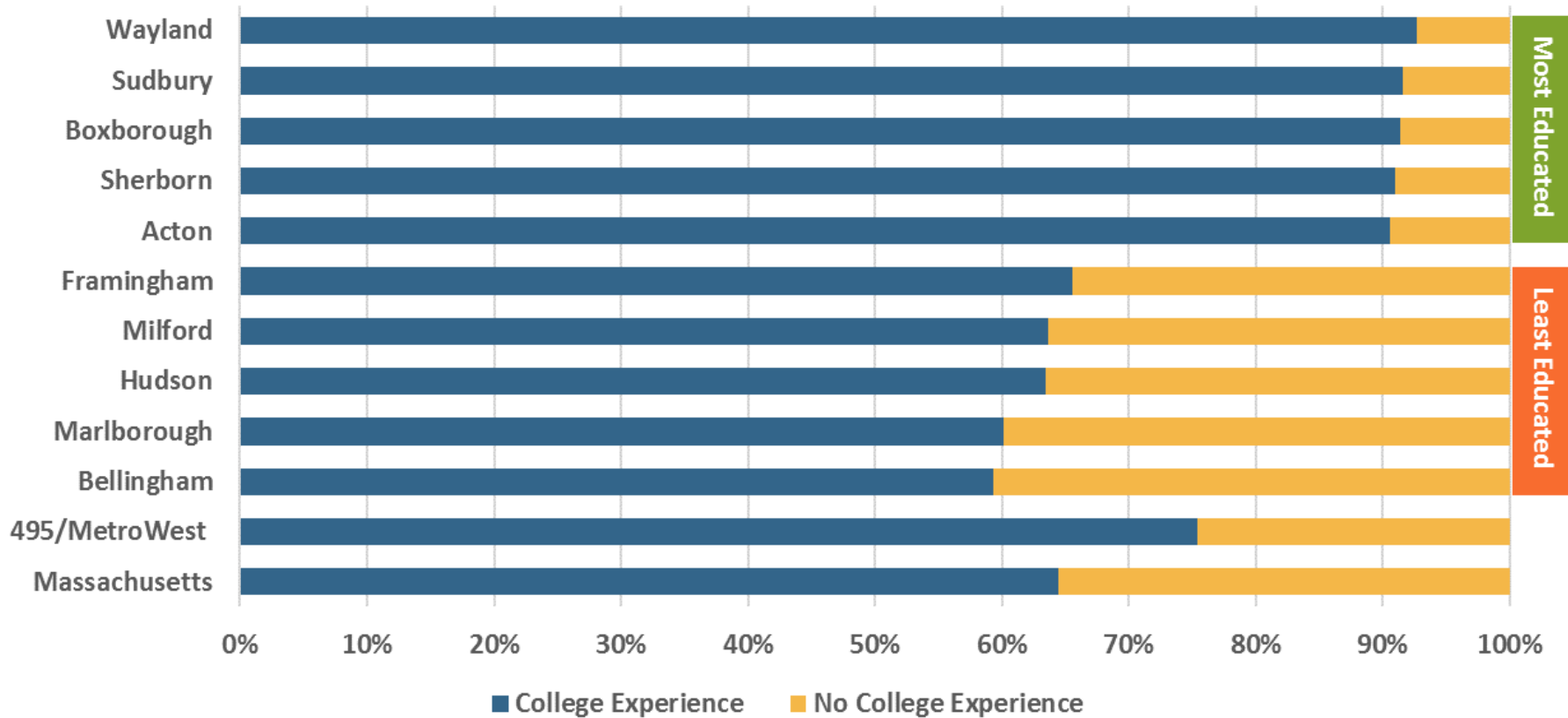


## College Experience, 2015



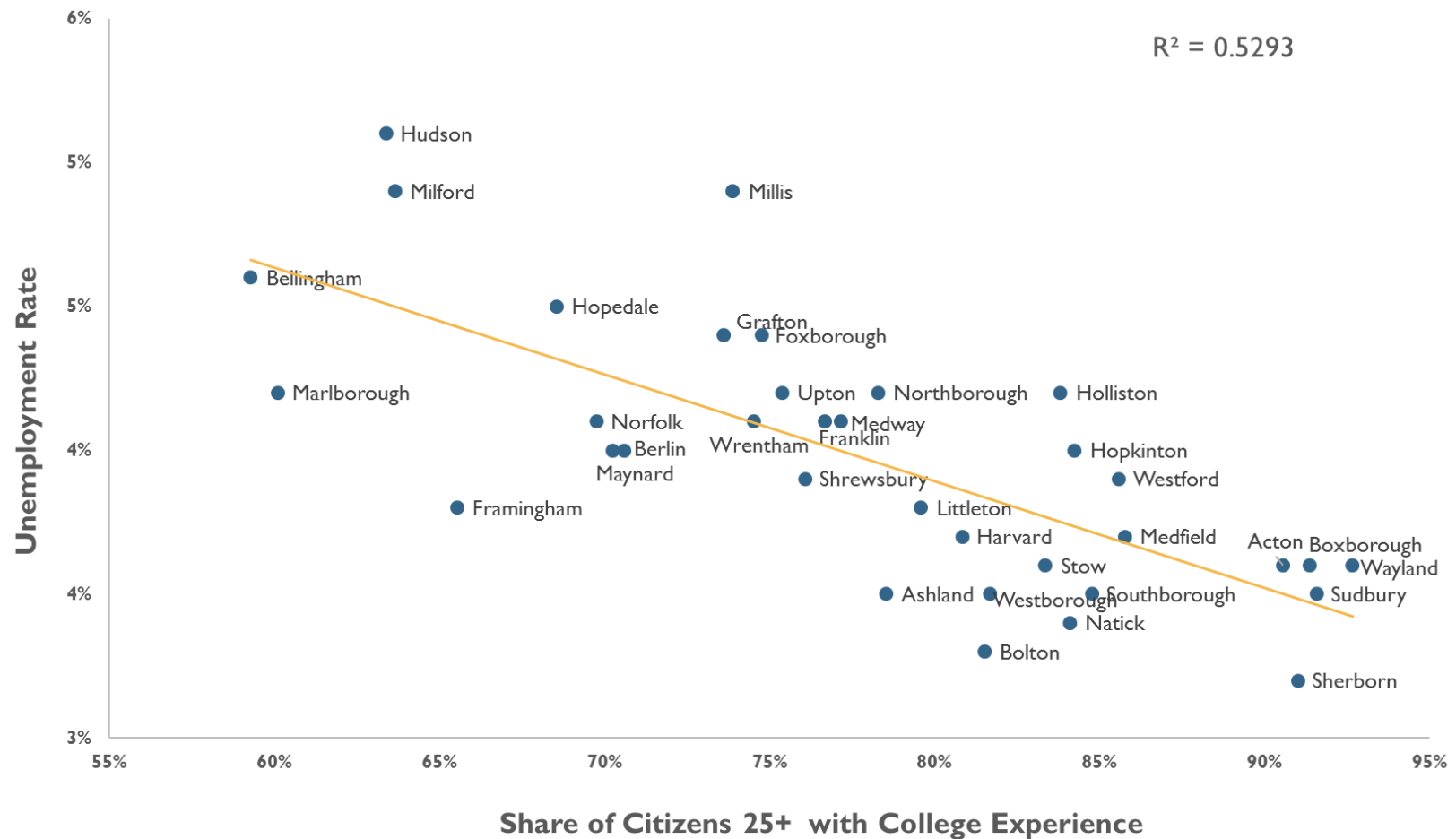


## College Experience By Community, 2015



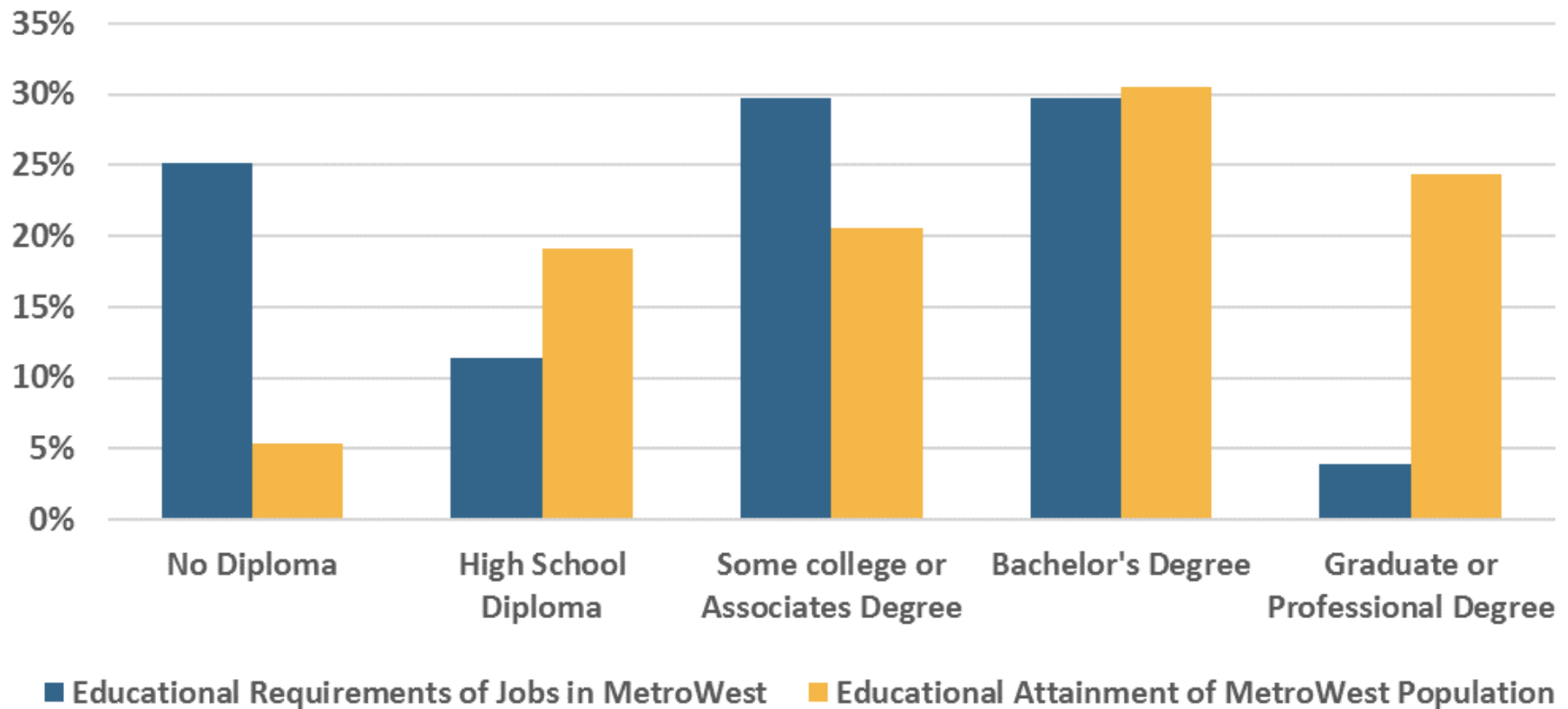


## College Experience and Unemployment Rate by Community, 2015
