
Market Composition

- Wired broadband




Delivery of Voice, Data, and Video Service














Broadband Availability





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Education Super Highway (ESH)



- Digital Connection Initiative is a partnership between ESH and Massachusetts
- ESH provides team of expert consultants at no cost to work with interested districts for assistance with:
 - E-Rate, a federal program that provides technology discounts for schools and libraries
 - Digital Connections Grant, a program using state bonds to cover non-discount project costs under the E-Rate program
- Massachusetts is one of 11 states with a qualifying State Matching Program that will increase an applicant's federal discount rate for special construction

Local and State Government

Shift to small cell and distributed antenna wireless build out

- Pressure at FCC to revise attachment rules and reduce local barriers to wireless deployment
- Several state legislatures have debated revising attachment rules to reduce local barriers
- More antenna in the public rights of way
 - Increased number of attachment applications
 - Requests for attachments to state and municipal infrastructure and non-utility pole locations
- >Non-traditional attachments and equipment
 - Attachments vary greatly in size and may require additional equipment
