## Re: D.T.E. 04-33: Verizon Massachusetts Arbitration

Dear Ms. Cottrell:

Sprint Communications Company L.P. ("Sprint") respectfully responds to Verizon New England Inc. d/b/a Verizon Massachusetts ("Verizon's") Motion to Hold Proceeding in Abeyance until June 15, 2004 ("Motion"). Sprint does not oppose Verizon's Motion, subject to the following conditions:

• The Department Should Rule on Sprint's Motion to Dismiss First. The Department should rule on Sprint's Motion to Dismiss dated March 15, 2004<sup>1</sup> prior to ruling on Verizon's Motion. Just as "[p]lacing the current proceeding into abeyance would help to ensure that parties will be able to devote their attention to commercial negotiations without the distraction of simultaneous

> litigation,"<sup>2</sup> dismissing the arbitration would accomplish the same objective. Thus, Verizon's Motion underscores the pre-maturity of Verizon's arbitration petition. If Verizon's arbitration is dismissed, Verizon's Motion will be moot because there would be no arbitration to hold in abeyance. Also, any ruling on Verizon's Motion should not prejudge Sprint's Motion to Dismiss. If the Department does not grant Sprint's Motion to Dismiss or grants it only as to Sprint, Sprint reserves the right to participate in the proceeding to protect its interests.

If Verizon's Arbitration is Not Dismissed, Verizon Should Maintain the UNE Platform Status Quo at Existing UNE Rates While the Arbitration is Pending. As a condition for holding this proceeding in abeyance, Verizon should be required to maintain the UNE Platform status quo at current rates not only while the proceeding is held in abevance but also while Verizon's arbitration is pending. The Public Utility Commission of Texas recently granted SBC's motion to hold arbitration of interconnection agreements in abevance based, in part, on SBC's assurances that UNEs will continue to be offered consistent with those agreements.<sup>3</sup> Verizon should be required to do the same thing in this proceeding with respect to its existing interconnection agreements at least until Verizon's arbitration is completed, if it is not dismissed before then.
