### Notice of Public Hearing and Comment Period To Accept Comments on Recently Enacted Emergency Regulations

Under the provisions of M.G.L. c. 30A § 2 and pursuant to the authority found at M.G.L. c. 130 § 17A and 21, the Division of Marine Fisheries (*MarineFisheries*) and the Marine Fisheries Advisory Commission (MFC) have scheduled a public comment period and public hearing. *MarineFisheries* will only accept comment related to permanently codifying the recently enacted emergency regulations affecting recreational black sea bass, scup and fluke regulations (322 CMR 6.22 and 6.28), as described below:

#### 1. Recreational Fluke Regulations (322 CMR 6.22)

a. Decreased the minimum size for recreationally caught fluke to 16 inches.

#### 2. Recreational Scup Regulations (322 CMR 6.28)

- a. Decreased the minimum size for recreationally caught scup to 10 inches;
- b. Increased the daily per recreational angler bag limit to 30 scup; and
- c. Extended the for-hire bonus season to May 1 June 30.

#### 3. Recreational Black Sea Bass Regulations (322 CMR 6.28)

- a. Decreased the daily per recreational angler bag limit to 4 black sea bass; and
- b. Implemented a closed season fishery with higher bag limits for for-hire vessels.
