



Historic Parkways Initiative
Memorial Drive Demonstration Project
Phase II

This project is the second phase of DCR's planned rehabilitation and restoration of Memorial Drive located between the BU Boathouse and the Longfellow Bridge. The project includes the construction of a multi-use bike path, riverbank stabilization, and landscape and other improvements to the expanded parkland, involving the installation of new shade shelters, benches, railings, trees, plantings, and historical;y-appropriate lighting. This project also includes the installation of new roadway drainage components to alleviate roadway flooding and improve stormwater quality.

TWO WEEK LOOK-AHEAD

May 29, 2016 – June 12, 2016

The following activities will be occurring over the next two weeks.

Memorial Drive (Vassar Street– Wadsworth Street)

- Continue stripping topsoil, regrading, and replacing loam in landscape areas located between Vassar Street and Fowler Street
- Continue excavation, rough grading, and placing of gravel borrow along the stabilized aggregate path located between Vassar Street and Audrey Street
- Begin excavation, rough grading, and placing of gravel borrow along the multi-use path located between Endicott Street and Wadsworth Street.

Construction Work Schedule/Hours: Monday – Friday 6 AM to 4 PM

Pedestrians may use the existing sidewalks and pathways.

One travel lane in each direction will be maintained through the work area on Memorial Drive. On-street parking will be prohibited in the work area.

Access to properties will be limited at times during the work shift, but restored at the end of the work shift
